#### HEALTH ACT, 1911-1959.

Department of Public Health, Perth, 7th July, 1960.

P.H.D. 1164/52, Ex. Co. No. 1287.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting under the provisions of the Health Act, 1911-1959, has been pleased to amend the Piggeries Regulations, 1952, made under the Act and published in the Government Gazette on the 31st day of December, 1952, and amended by notice published in the Government Gazette on the 17th day of September, 1954.

The abovementioned regulations, published in the Government Gazette on the 31st December, 1952, and duly amended by notice published in the Government Gazette on the 17th September, 1954, are further amended as follows:—

- 1. The schedule to the regulations is amended by adding at the end of the item "Kalgoorlie" under the heading "Parts of Road Districts," the following:—
  - (iv) Commencing at the north-west corner of intersection of Great Eastern Highway and Gateacre Street, thence in a north-westerly direction along Gateacre Street, for a distance of 20 chains to the Perth-Kalgoorlie Railway Line, thence approximately at right angles to Gateacre Street, in a south-westerly direction and parallel to the railway line for a distance of 54 chains to the suburban area boundary and eastern alignment of reserve 8814, thence approximately at right angles in a south-easterly direction and parallel to the suburban area boundary and contiguous with reserve 8814 for a distance of 30 chains to the Great Eastern Highway; thence at right angles and parallel to, and on northern side of the Great Eastern Highway for a distance of 52 chains in a north-easterly direction to point of commencement.

## OPTOMETRISTS ACT, 1940-1957.

Optometrists Registration Board—Resolution.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Optometrists Act, 1940-1957, the Optometrists Registration Board may, with the approval of the Governor, make rules in relation to the matters therein set out or any other matter which the Governor may declare to be a matter in respect of which rules may be made by the Board; and whereas rules cited as the Optometrists Registration Board Rules, 1941, were made under and for the purposes of the said Act and published in the Government Gazette on the 23rd May, 1941, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices published in the Government Gazette: Now, therefore, the Optometrists Registration Board doth amend the said rules in the manner set forth in the schedule hereunder.

That the Rules under the Optometrists Act, 1940-1957, be amended as follows:—

- 1. That Rule No. 30 under the heading of Registration of Optometrists—Part VI, be repealed and the following inserted in lieu thereof:—
  - 30. Persons who hold any of the following Certificates or Diplomas shall be recognised by the Board as persons qualified for registration in terms of the provisions of section 35 (1) (d) (ii) and (d) (iii), that is to say:—
    - (a) The—
      - (i) Fellowship Diploma of the British Optical Association, London.
      - (ii) Fellowship Diploma of the Worshipful Spectacle Makers' Company—London.
    - (b) Associate Diploma of the Sydney Technical College (Diploma of Optometry) or the Degree of Bachelor of Science (Optometrical Science) of the University of New South Wales.
    - (c) The Licentiate Diploma in Optometric Science of the Victorian College of Optometry—Melbourne.
    - (d) Certificates to practise optometry issued by the Board of Optical Registration constituted under the Opticians Act, 1920, as amended by subsequent Acts of the Parliament of South Australia, after the first day of January, 1960, to persons obtaining registration by reason of having satisfactorily completed the optometry course provided by the University of Adelaide for the said Board.
    - (e) A certificate of registration of the Board of Optometrical Registration of the State of New South Wales dated prior to 1st January, 1960.
    - (f) Certificates of Registration of the Opticians Registration Board of the State of Victoria dated prior to the first day of January, 1960.

### ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919.


TOWN PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 1928.

Armadale-Kelmscott Road Board—By-law Establishing Building Lines. L.G. 272/56.

THE Armadale-Kelmscott Road Board, under and by virtue of the powers conferred on it in that behalf by the Road Districts Act, 1919, the Second Schedule thereof, the Town Planning and Development Act, 1928, and all other powers enabling it, doth hereby make and publish the following by-laws:—

- (1) The building lines for the streets and portions thereof shown on the plan and schedule hereto shall be the line indicated as the dotted line on the said plan.
- (2) No person shall erect or cause to be erected any building or structure between the building line and the street on which the land abuts.

(3) Any person who shall commit a breach of these by-laws shall, upon conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds (£20).
