### PARKS AND RESERVES ACT, 1895-1955.

Department of Lands and Surveys, Perth, 7th December, 1960.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, under the provisions of the Parks and Reserves Act, 1895-1955, has been pleased to approve of the amendments in the manner mentioned in the schedule hereunder of the by-laws made by the Rottnest Island Board, for the control and management of "A" Reserve 16713, Rottnest Island, and published in the Government Gazette on the 8th day of December, 1933, and amended by notices published in the Government Gazette on the 30th day of July, 1937, the 1st day of April, 1938, the 19th day of September, 1952, and the 23rd day of December, 1955.

#### Schedule.

The abovementioned by-laws are amended by adding a new by-law as follows:—

Beds, Bedding and Equipment.

4A. A person shall not remove any bed, bedding, furniture or equipment being the property of the Rottnest Island Board from any premises erected on "A" Class Reserve No. 16713 or from any portion of that reserve without the consent of an officer or employee of the Rottnest Island Board.

The above amendment was duly made by the Rottnest Island Board in accordance with the provisions of the Parks and Reserves Act, 1895-1955, and duly passed by resolution at a meeting of the Board held on the 11th day of November, 1960.

#### ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919-1959.

HIS Excellency the Governor, under the provisions of section 203 of the road Districts Act, 1919-1959 and Regulation 37 of the Second Schedule to that Act, and acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the uniform general by-laws set out in the Schedule hereto and prescribes that such by-laws shall have the force of law in each and every road district for the time being constituted under the said Act.

#### Schedule.

#### Uniform General By-laws.

The uniform general by-laws published in the *Government Gazette* on the 29th June, 1951, are amended by substituting for by-law 1 the following by-law:—

- 1. (1) The minimum height from floor to ceiling of a habitable room shall be not less than eight feet, except in the case of a room in a dwelling the external walls of which are of wood, in which case the minimum height shall be not less than nine feet.
- (2) Where a habitable room of less than nine feet in height from floor to ceiling is contained in a building having a roof pitch of less than fifteen degrees, the topmost ceiling of that building shall be insulated by a material having a surface to surface conductance (c) of not less than 0.13.
