AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 22nd day of December, 1960, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Road Districts Act, 1919.

Wyndham Road Board.

Declaration of Membership and Fixing of Election Date.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 866/60.

WHEREAS by notice in the Government Gazette of the 11th January, 1918, the number of members comprising the Wyndham Road Board was declared to be seven; and whereas upon the holding of an election to elect a new board in consequence of an order published in the Government Gazette of the 15th June, 1945, and actually held on the 14th July, 1945, five members were elected to the Wyndham Road Board; and whereas it appears that a reduction of members to five was intended but the necessary action by the Governor was not completed; and whereas the Board has continued to function with five members since the 14th July, 1945, but is now desirous that the number of members should be restored to seven: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the Road Districts Act, 1919, doth hereby—

- declare that the number of members of which the Wyndham Road Board is to comprise shall on and from the 15th day of April, 1961, be seven members;
- (2) declare and direct that an election shall be held on the 15th day of April, 1961, to elect two additional **m**embers to the Board.

Wagin Municipal District and Wagin Road District.

Union of Districts, Dissolution of a Ward, Increase in Membership and Fixing of Election Dates.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G.D. 3347/52.

WHEREAS the Wagin Municipal District is constituted as a municipality under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906, under the name of Wagin Municipal Council; and whereas the Wagin Road District is constituted as such under the Road Districts Act, 1919; and whereas the Wagin Municipal Council has submitted a petition to His Excellency the Governor praying that the district may be dissolved and included in the Wagin Road District; and whereas it is desirable that the prayer of the petition should be granted and all necessary adjustments made; and whereas this necessitates an alteration in the wards and the number of members of the Wagin Road Board: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting under the powers conferred by the Road Districts Act, 1919, doth hereby—

- unite the Wagin Municipal District with the Wagin Road District as from the 15th day of April, 1961, under the name of Wagin Road District;
- (2) constitute the area formerly comprising the Wagin Municipal District as the Town Ward of the Wagin Road District;
- (3) abolish the North Ward of the Wagin Road District;
- (4) transfer to the North-West Ward of the Wagin Road District that portion of the district which was formerly the North Ward;

- (5) declare that the number of members of which the Wagin Road Board consists shall remain at nine until the 15th day of April, 1961, and on and after that day shall be thirteen members;
- (6) determine that until the 15th day of April, ward shall remain unaltered with the exception of the North-West Ward, the membership of which shall be increased to three and the membership of the North Ward abolished; and further declare that as from the 15th day of April, 1961, the number of members for each ward shall be as follows:-

Town Ward—five members; North-West Ward—two members; North-East Ward—two members; South-West Ward—two members; South-East Ward—two members;

- (7) direct that the members for the Town Ward shall retire from office on the 15th day of April, 1961;
- (8) direct that the present member for the North Ward shall be an additional mem-ber for the North-West Ward until the 15th day of April, 1961, on which day all Wart the the start of members representing the Ward shall retire from office; North-West
- (9) declare and direct that a new election to and two members for the Town Ward and two members for the North-West Ward shall be held on the 15th day of April, 1961;
- (10) direct that the members representing the remaining wards shall continue in office until they retire or otherwise vacate their office in accordance with the provisions of the said Act:
- (11) order that the owners or occupiers of rateable land whose names show on the roll of the Wagin Municipal Council on the 15th day of April, 1961, shall on and from that day be admitted as electors of the Town Ward of the Wagin Road District for the balance of the year.
