WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Lleutenant-General Sir Charles TO WIT, Henry Gairdner, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint Governor. LL.S.] By His Excellency Lleutenant-General Sir Charles Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Vic-torian Order, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Com-panion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by section 31 of the Land Act, 1933-1960, the Governor may, by Proclamation and subject to such conditions as may be expressed therein, classify as of Class "A" any lands of the Crown reserved to Her Majesty for any of the purposes specified in the said section; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the reserve described in the schedule hereto should be classified as of Class "A": Now therefore, I, the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclama-tion classify as of Class "A" the reserve described hereunder.

Reserve No. 24185 (Victoria Location 10364) containing 73 acres 3 roods 18 perches for the purpose of "Conservation of Flora." (Plan 156/80, B3.)
