WHEREAS it is enacted by section 2 of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act Amendment Act, 1960, that the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation, and that it shall not be necessary to proclaim that the whole Act shall commence on one day, but the several sections of the Act may be proclaimed to come into operation on such days as are respectively proclaimed; and whereas it is desired that only those sections of the Act as are specified in this Proclamation shall come into operation: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix the day on which this Proclamation is published in the *Government Gazette* as the day on which all the sections, with the exception of sections 3, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15, of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act Amendment Act, 1960, shall come into operation.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 22nd day of December, 1960, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1959.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsection (2) of section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1959, that for the purposes of the Act the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, constitute as a fire district any portion of a district of a local authority which after the coming into operation of the Fire Brigades Act Amendment Act, 1959, is not a fire district, assign a name to a fire district, and include the name of a fire district in Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby—

- (a) constitute that portion of the Road District of Mount Magnet more particularly described in the schedule hereunder a fire district;
- (b) assign the name of Mount Magnet Fire District to that district; and
- (c) include in column one of Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act "Mount Magnet Fire District" and in column two opposite Mount Magnet Fire District, "Road District of Mount Barker."

Schedule.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point situate about 128 chains south and about 70 chains east of Trigonometrical Station K5 and extending 97 degrees 35 minutes, about 89 chains; thence 187 degrees 35 minutes, about 82 chains; thence 277 degrees 35 minutes, about 89 chains and thence 7 degrees 35 minutes about 82 chains to the starting point. (Public Plan Mount Magnet Townsite.)

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G.D. 842/52.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection 1 (b) (iii) and (iv) of section 480 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906, that a council may, with the approval of the Governor, expend out of the ordinary revenue of the municipality any sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate 10 per cent. of such ordinary revenue for providing all forms of tourist propaganda both within the district and elsewhere in connection with or in relation to any tourist resort within the district of the council, and in subsidising ambulance services; and whereas the Municipality of Bunbury is desirous of expending the sum of £500 from its ordinary revenue for tourist propaganda purposes and £200 in subsidising the St. John Ambulance Association: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the power vested in him in the said section of the said Act, doth hereby authorise the Municipality of Bunbury to expend from its ordinary revenue the sum of £500 for tourist propaganda purposes, and the sum of £200 for subsidising the St. John Ambulance Association.

Severance and Annexation of Land.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 6 of the Interstate Maintenance Recovery Act, 1959-1960, that where in any State other than this State an Act is in force containing provisions substantially similar to or corresponding with those contained in, or for carrying out objects substantially similar to or corresponding with the objects of Part III, Part IV or Part V of that Act, the Governor may, by Proclamation published in the *Gazette*, declare that that Part shall extend to and be in force as regards that State; and whereas Acts containing provisions substantially similar to or corresponding with those contained in, or for carrying out objects substantially similar to or corresponding with the objects of Part III and Part IV of the said Act are respectively in force in the States of New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia, Queensland and Tasmania, and of Part V of the said Act in the States of New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare that Part III and Part IV of the said Act shall extend to and be in force as regards the States of New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia, Queensland and Tasmania, and that Part V of the said Act shall extend to and be in force as regards the States of New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia.
