# Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960. PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960, that the Governor may on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the land described in the schedules hereunder be declared totalisator agency schedules hereunder be declared totalisator agency regions for those purposes: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Coun-cil, do hereby declare that the land described in the schedules hereunder shall be totalisator agency regions for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960, in the case of the land described in the First Schedule as from and m-cluding the 24th day of July, 1961; and, in the case of the land described in the Second Schedule, as from and including the 31st day of July. 1961. as from and including the 31st day of July, 1961.

# First Schedule.

(a) All that portion of land comprising the area bounded by lines starting in the City of Fremantle at the intersection of the western boundary of Carrington Street with the northern boundary of Stephen Street; thence along that northern boundary in a general westerly and west-south-westerly direction, across all streets meeting the same to the point of its intersection with the eastern boundary of Brennan Street; thence across Stephen

Street to the point of the intersection of its southern boundary with the eastern boundary of Brennan Street; thence along that boundary in a general southerly direction, to the point of its intersection with the north-eastern boundary of Wray Avenue; thence along that north-eastern wray Avenue; thence along that north-eastern boundary in a north-westerly direction across Brennan Street to the point of its junction with the southern boundary of Little Howard Street; thence across Little Howard Street to the point of the intersection of its northern boundary with the north-eastern boundary of South Terrace; thence across South Terrace to the point of the intersection of its could watcome bound of the intersection of its south-western boundary with the north-western boundary of Howard Street; thence along that north-western boundary in a south-westerly direction, to the point of its intersection with the north-eastern boundary of Marine Terrace; thence along an imaginary line in pro-longation of the north-western boundary of Howard Street in a south-westerly direction across Marine Terrace and the reserve of the railway between Frematle and Robb Jetty to the point where it meets the high-water mark of the Indian Ocean; thence along that high-water mark in a southerly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of Island Street; thence along that imaginary line in an easterly direction to the inat imaginary line in an easterly direction to the point where is merges with the said northern boun-dary of Island Street; thence along that northern boundary across the line of the railway last above mentioned and all streets meeting that boundary to the point of its junction with the eastern boun-dary of Naval Base Road; thence along that eastern boundary in a northerly direction to the point of its junction with the southern boundary of Clon-tarf Road; thence along that southern boundary tarf Road; thence along that southern boundary in a general easterly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the eastern boundary of Carrington Street; thence along that eastern boundary in a northerly direction to the point of its junction with the southern

boundary of Winterfold Road: thence along that southern boundary in an easterly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point where it merges with the south-western boundary of Old Stock Road; thence along that south-western boundary in a south-easterly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of Waverley Road; thence along that imaginary line in an easterly direction across Jeanette Road and conalong that southern boundary in an tinuing easterly direction across Doherty Road to the point of its junction with the western boundary of North Lake Road; thence along that western boundary in a general northerly direction across Waverley Road and Torquil Road to the point f its intersection with the southern boundary of South Street; thence along that southern boundary in a westerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its intersection with the western boundary of Carrington Street and thence along that western boundary in a northerly direc-tion across South Street and all other streets meeting the same to the starting point.

(b) All that portion of land comprising the area bounded by lines starting in the City of Nedlands at the point of the intersection of the northern boundary of Stirling Highway with the eastern boundary of Smyth Road; thence across Stirling Highway in a southerly direction to the point of the intersection of the southern boundary of that road with the western boundary of Webster Street; thence along that western boundary in the same direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its intersection with the northern boundary of Princess Road; thence along that northern boundary in a westerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the eastern boundary of Bay View Terrace; thence along that eastern boundary in a southerly direction across Princess Road and all other streets meeting that boundary, and thence along an imag-inary line in prolongation of that boundary in a southerly direction to the point of its intersection with the high water mark of the right bank of the Swan River; thence along an imaginary line in a south-easterly direction drawn directly across waters of the Swan River to meet the high water mark of the right bank of the Swan River directly south of Point Resolution; thence along that high water mark in a general easterly north-easterly and northerly direction to the point of its intersection with an imaginary line in prolongation southerly of the eastern boundary of Crawley Avenue; thence along that imaginary line in a northerly direction across Mounts Bay Road to the point of its junction with the northern boundary of that road; thence along that northern boundary in a westerly direction across Crawley Avenue and all streets meeting the same to the starting point.

(c) All that portion of land comprising the area bounded by lines starting in Nollamara at the point where the northern boundary of Balcatta Road joins the western boundary of Wanneroo Road; thence along that western boundary in a general northerly direction across all roads meeting the same to the point of its intersection with the northern boundary of Warrick Road; thence along that northern boundary in a westerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the eastern extremity of Ross Avenue; thence along an imaginary line in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of Warrick Road along Ross Avenue and across West Coast Highway and continuing to the point where it meets the high water mark of the Indian Ocean; thence along that high water mark in a southerly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of North Beach Road; thence along that imaginary line in an easterly direction to a point where it joins the northern boundary of North Beach Road and along that northern boun-dary in a general easterly direction across all streets meeting the same and across Duffy Road to the point of its merger with the northern boundary of Balcatta Road and thence along that boundary in an easterly direction across all streets meeting the same to the starting point.

#### Second Schedule.

All that portion of land comprising the area bounded by lines starting in Mount Lawley at the point where an imaginary line extending from the point of intersection of the south-western boundary of Park Street with the north-western boundary of Guildford Road, across Guildford Road at right angles thereto and across West Parade meets the western boundary of the railway reserve of the railway between Perth and Mount Lawley and extending thence along an imaginary line in an easterly direction across that railway reserve and across East Parade to the point where the southern boundary of Pakenham Street meets the eastern boundary of East Parade; thence in a north-easterly direction across Pakenham Street to the point where the north-western Pakenham boundary of Ebsworth Street meets the eastern boundary of East Parade; thence in a southeasterly direction across Ebsworth Street to the point where its south-eastern boundary meets the north-eastern boundary of Pakenham Street and extending along that north-eastern boundary in a south-easterly direction to the point where it meets the north-western boundary of Joel Terrace; thence extending in a south-easterly direction along an imaginary line in prolongation of the north-eastern boundary of Pakenham Street across Joel Terrace and to the point where that imaginary line meets the highwater mark of the right bank of the Swan River; thence along that high-water mark in a general easterly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation South-easterly of the south-western boundary of King William Street; thence along that imaginary line in a north-westerly direction across Pall Mall and continuing in the same direction along the south-western boundary of King William Street across all streets meeting the same and beneath the line of the railway between Perth and Bays-water to the point of its merger with the south-western boundary of Coode Street; thence along that south-western boundary in a north-westerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation north-easterly of the north-western boundary of Clement Street; thence along that imaginary line in a south-westerly direction across Lawrence Street to the point of its merger with the north-western boundary of Clement Street; thence along that north-western boundary of Clement Street, south-westerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the north-eastern boundary of Salisbury Street; thence along that north-eastern boundary in a north-westerly direction to the point of its junction with the south-eastern boundary of India Street; thence along that south-eastern boundary in a south-westerly direction across Salisbury Street to the point of its intersection with the south-western boundary of Wood Street; thence along that southwestern boundary in a north-easterly direction across India Street to the point of its junction with the south-eastern boundary of Walter Road; thence across Walter Road in a north-westerly direction to the point of the intersection of its north-western boundary with the south-western boundary of Harold Street; thence along the north-western boundary of Walter Road in a south-westerly direction to the point of its merger with the north-western boundary of learoyd Street; thence in the same direction along that northwestern boundary in a south-westerly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of Central Avenue; thence along that imaginary line in an easterly direction across Learoyd Street to the southern boundary of Central Avenue; thence along that southern boundary in a general easterly and south-easterly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its intersection with the south-eastern boundary of Hamer Parade; thence along that south-eastern boundary in a south-westerly direction across Fourth Avenue West to the point of its intersection with the southwestern boundary of that avenue; thence along that south-western boundary in a south-easterly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the south-eastern boundary of Railway Parade; thence along an

imaginary line in prolongation of the south-western boundary of Fourth Avenue West to the point where it meets the western boundary of the railway reserve hereinbefore in this schedule men-tioned and thence along that western boundary in a general south-westerly and southerly direction to the starting point.
