WHEREAS it is enacted by section 235A of the Health Act, 1911-1960, that the Governor, having received a certificate given by the Commissioner of Public Health that any quantity of food is in the opinion of the Commissioner injurious or dangerous to health, and being satisfied that there are reasonable grounds for the Commissioner's opinion, may declare that the quantity of food is dangerous; and whereas the Acting Commissioner has given to the Governor a certificate that the quantity of food described in the schedule hereto is, in his opinion, dangerous to health: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the

advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that the quantity of food described in the Schedule hereto is dangerous.

Traffic Act, 1919-1960.  
Donnybrook Shire Council.  
ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Police T.O. 58/459.

HIS Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order under section 49 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1960, namely, that the Donnybrook Shire Council is hereby empowered to make by-laws in pursuance of—

- (1) clause (a) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, prescribing the rules to be observed in respect to any vehicle being driven or used on roads;
- (2) clause (y) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, providing for the placing, erection or installation on roads or footpaths of traffic signs, lights and directions for the control and direction of traffic, both vehicular and pedestrian and including the driving of animals, for the marking on roads or footpaths of signs for the control and direction of the traffic and for the regulation and prohibition of the traffic in relation to the signs, lights and directions;
- (3) clause (zd) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, appointing stands and parking places for different classes of vehicles and regulate the use thereof;

- (4) clauses (zl) and (zm) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, prohibiting or restricting the parking of vehicles, or vehicles of a specified class or classes in all roads or in specified roads, or specified parts of roads, at all times or at specified times, and prescribing a penalty for any breach thereof;
- (5) clause (c) of paragraph (vii) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act prescribing the maximum weight which may be taken across any bridge or culvert,

subject to the condition that no such by-law shall be valid and effectual unless it has, prior to notification of its making being published in the *Government Gazette*, been submitted to and approved by the Governor.

Corr. No. 1452/58.—That Reserve No. 26089 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Ashburton in trust for Municipal Purposes.

Corr. No. 1321/61.—That Reserve No. 26090 should vest in and be held by the Minister for Works in trust for the purpose of a School Quarters Site.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 34 of the Land Act, 1933-1960, it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, without issuing any deed or grant, to place any reserve under the control of any municipality, road board, or other person or persons, as a board of management, and to empower such board to make, repeal, and alter by-laws for the control and management of such reserves, and prescribe fees for depasturing thereon or other use thereof, and for other purposes, such by-laws to be approved by the Governor and published in the *Government Gazette*; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corr. No. 3869/59.—That Reserve No. 26079 for the purpose of Gravel should be placed under the control of the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale as a Board of Management.

Corr. No. 3868/59.—That Reserve No. 26080 for the purpose of Gravel should be placed under the control of the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale as a Board of Management.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby place the beforementioned

reserves under the control of the abovementioned bodies as Boards of Management, and doth empower such boards to make, repeal, or alter by-laws for the control and management of the said reserves; for prescribing fees for depasturing thereon or other use thereof; for directing the manner in which such fees shall be imposed, paid, collected and disposed of, and to impose penalties not exceeding in any case £5 for any breach thereof and £2 a day for a continuing breach, but not more than £20 in the aggregate.

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1960.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1960, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied

with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor-in-Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Reticulation Area No. 23.

Extension from No. 9 Intercepting Sewer to New Town Hall Site, Chevron Hilton Hotel Site and Terrace Main Sewer.

A 15-inch diameter pipe sewer with manholes and all other apparatus connected therewith, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 8620.

Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1960.  
Great Southern Towns Country Water Area.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 140/58.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 8 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1960, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, extend the boundaries of a Country Water Area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby extend the boundaries of the Great Southern Towns Country Water Area by adding thereto the area as defined in the schedule hereunder.

#### Schedule.

Extension of the Great Southern Towns Country Water Area.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on a northern boundary of Kojonup Townsite situate at the south-western corner of Kojonup Location 7 and extending easterly along that townsite boundary to the north-eastern corner of Kojonup Town Lot 218 and onwards to a line situate 300 feet from and parallel to the eastern boundary of that lot; thence southerly along that line to a line parallel to and 300 feet north-westerly from the south-eastern side of Kojonup Road (road number 285); thence generally north-easterly along that line to its intersection with the western boundary of location 1072; thence northerly along that boundary and onwards along the western and north-western boundaries of location 1388 to a south-western side of the Great Southern Highway; thence south-easterly along that side to the western-most western corner of Katanning Townsite; thence south-easterly, south-westerly and southerly along the boundary of that townsite to a line parallel to and 300 feet south-easterly from the south-eastern side of Kojonup Road (Road number 285) aforesaid; thence generally south-westerly along that line to a line situate 300 feet easterly from and parallel to the western boundary of location 3074; thence southerly along that line to the southern boundary of that location; thence westerly along that boundary to the south-western corner of that location, a point on the Kojonup Townsite boundary aforesaid; thence westerly, southerly and again westerly along that townsite boundary to the eastern side of Albany Highway (road number 6963); thence generally south-easterly along that side to a point situate east of the easternmost corner of location 8; thence west to that corner; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of that location to the south-eastern side of a one chain road passing along the north-western boundary of lot 6 of location 8 as shown on L.T.O.
