# Main Roads Act, 1930-1959. Declaration of Controlled Access Road. PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 28A of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1952, it is provided that where the Commissioner is of opinion that a controlled access road should be provided and should be entered and departed from at specified places only, he shall make a recommendation to the Governor accordingly and that, if of opinion that the recommendation should be given effect, the Governor may, by Proclamation, proclaim the controlled access road and the places only at which the controlled access road and the places only at which the controlled access road and ye entered or departed from; and whereas the Commissioner is of opinion that a controlled access road should be provided as hereinafter described and has made a recommendation to the Governor accordingly; and whereas I, the Governor of the said State, am of opinion that such recommendation should be given effect: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby proclaim that the parcels of land coloured green in Plan P.W.D., W.A. No. 39403 (L.T.O. Plans 7730, 7731 and 7732), and which together are more particularly described in schedule hereunder shall be a Controlled Access Road.

Constitution Act, 1889. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1889, provides, inter alia, that the Governor in Council may vest in heads of departments, or other officers or persons within the State, power to make minor appointments; and whereas it is desirable that power of appointment of persons employed at a weekly rate of wage in or about institutions and establishments and country offices of the Department of Native Welfare and in or about mobile welfare clinics and mobile works units provided by the said Department, should be vested in Frank Ellis Gare, the Commissioner of Native Welfare, and Francis William George Andersen, the Deputy Commissioner of Native Welfare: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby vests in the said Frank Ellis Gare and Francis William George Andersen, and any person appointed to act temporarily in their place, for so long as the said Frank Ellis Gare and Francis William George Andersen hold the offices aforesaid or until this power be sooner revoked, the power of appointment of persons employed at a weekly rate of wage in or about such institutions and establishments and country offices, and in or about such mobile welfare clinics and mobile works units and doth hereby revoke the previous vestment of Stanley Guise Middleton.

#### Companies Act, 1943-1961. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted (inter alia) by subsection (2) of section 28 of the Companies Act, 1943-1961 (hereinafter in this Order called "the Act") that, except with the consent of the Governor signified by order published in the Government Gazette, no company shall be registered by a name which includes the word "Imperial"; and whereas it is provided in paragraph (b) of the proviso to subsection (7) of that section that where a company formed or incorporated outside Western Australia to which Part XI of the Act applies has (after complying with the requirements of Part XI under its original name) changed, in the country of its incorporation, its name to a name which includes any word or words prohibited, either generally or in the circumstances of the particular case, by Division 5 of Part II of the Act, the Governor, if of opinion that it would be inequitable or unreasonable to refuse to allow the new name to be entered in the register in place of the former name, may authorise the Registrar to enter the new name in the register and the Registrar shall enter the new name in the register accordingly; and whereas a company by the name of Yorkshire Fittings (Australia) Pty. Limited, being a company incorporated outside Western Australia, namely in the State of New South Wales, to which Part XI of the Act applies has (after complying with the requirements of that Part under that name) changed in the country of its incorporation its name to the name of Yorshire Imperial (Australia) Pty. Limited and is seeking to have that new name entered in the register in place of its former name; and whereas the Governor is of opinion that it would be inequitable or unreasonable to refuse to allow the name of Yorkshire Imperial (Australia) Pty Limited to be entered in the register in place of the former name Yorkshire Fittings (Australia) Pty. Limited: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of the proviso to subsection (7) of section 28 of the Act, doth hereby authorise the Registrar to enter the name of Yorkshire Imperial (Australia) Pty. Limited in the register in place of the former name Yorkshire Fittings (Australia) Pty. Limited.

#### Companies Act, 1943-1961. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 28 of the Companies Act, 1943-1961, that except with the consent of the Governor signified by order published in the Government Gazette no company shall be registered by a name which, interalia, includes the word "Commonwealth"; and whereas it is provided in subsection (4) of that section, inter alia, that the consent of the Governor referred to in subsection (2) of that section shall not be granted to a company, whether incorporated in this State or elsewhere, if, in the opinion of the Governor, the use of such name by such com-pany would imply or be likely to convey the impression that such company is wholly or partly authorised or supported by or connected with Her Majesty's Government in any part of Her Majesty's Dominions; and whereas it is provided, inter alia, in proviso (a) to subsection (7) of that section that where in the opinion of the Governor (on being satisfied that it would be inequitable or unreasonable to require a company incorporated outside Western Australia to which Part XI of that Act applies to change its name before complying with the requirements of that Part) it is in the circumstances of the particular case expedient, the Governor may authorise the Registrar to accept for filing the documents and particulars specified in subsection (1) of section 329 of that Act; and whereas registration under Part XI of the Act of a company incorporated in the State of Queensland by the name of Commonwealth Engineering (Qld.) Pty. Ltd. was refused by the Registrar on the ground that that name included the word "Commonwealth"; and whereas His Excellency the Governor is satisfied that the use by that Company of the name including the word "Commonwealth" would not imply or be likely to convey the impression that the company is wholly or partly authorised or supported by or connected with Her Majesty's Government in any part of Her Majesty's Dominions. Now therefore His Excel-Majesty's Dominions; Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council in exercise of the powers conferred by proviso (a) to subsection (7) of section 28 of the Companies Act, 1943-1961, and having been satisfied that it would be inequitable or unreasonable to require that company to change its name before complying with the requirements of Part XI of that Act, and being of the opinion that the circumstances of the case render it expedient, doth hereby authorise the Registrar of Companies to accept for filing from Common-wealth Engineering (Qld.) Pty. Ltd. the documents and particulars specified in subsection (1) of section 329 of the Act.

#### Land Act, 1933-1960. ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1960, it is, inter alia, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corres. 1702/12.—That reserve No. 14186 (Wyalkatchem Lot 51) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to the Western Australian Fire Brigades Board Incorporated in trust for "Fire Brigade Purposes."

Corres. 2237/60.—That reserve 26244 (Wellington Location 4903) should, subject as aforesaid be granted in fee simple to the State Electricity Commission of Western Australia to be held in trust for the purpose of a "Power Station Site."

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the abovementioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the aforesaid body to be held in trust for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

Land Act, 1933-1960. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 3638/61.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1960, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 26240 (Melbourne Location 3863) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Dandaragan in trust for the purpose of Recreation (Golf Links): Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Dandaragan in trust for Recreation (Golf Links) with power to the said Shire of Dandaragan, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease.

The transport by a farmer in his own vehicle between his farm in the Dale-Wandering Area and the Metropolitan Area of primary produce produced on such farm, and of supplies and requisites for use in production thereon.

For the purposes of this exemption, "Dale-Wandering Area" means the area bounded on the north by a line running due west from the Beverley Railway Station; on the east by a line ten miles from, and on the west side of, the Great Southern Railway; on the south by a line ten miles from, and on the north side of, the Bowelling-Narrogin railway; and on the west by the Albany Highway southwards to the seventy-five mile post thereon and thence due south. "Metropolitan Area" means the area within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

#### 25. Nyabing-Pingrup Area.

The transport by a farmer in his own vehicle—

- (a) between Albany, Gnowangerup or Nyabing and his farm in that portion of the Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup situated east of a line running due north and south through a point five miles east of the Nyabing railway station; and
- (b) within such portion of the Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup;

of primary produce produced on such farm and of supplies and requisites for use in production thereon.

#### 26. Borden-Jerramongup Area.

The transport, by a farmer in his own vehicle—

- (a) between his farm in the Borden-Jerramongup Area and Gnowangerup or Albany; and
- (b) within such area;

of primary produce produced on such farm and of supplies and requisites for use in production thereon.

For the purposes of this exemption, "Borden-Jerramongup Area" means the area bounded by the arc of a circle having its centre at Gnowangerup and a radius of ten miles and extending from a point due south of Gnowangerup to a point due east of Gnowangerup; thence due north from such lastmentioned point to the boundary of the Shire of Gnowangerup; thence eastwards and southwards along such boundary to a point due east of a point ten miles south of Ongerup; thence due west to such lastmentioned point; thence along a line ten miles to the south of, and parallel to, the Gnowangerup-Ongerup Railway to the starting point.

#### 27. South Stirling Area.

The transport by a farmer in his own vehicle—

#### 28. Esperance Area.

The transport of goods by road between any two places within that portion of the Shire of Esperance situated south of a line running due east and west through a point forty miles north of the post office at Esperance

#### 29. Badgingarra Area.

The transport by a farmer in his own vehicle—

- (a) between his farm in the Badgingarra Area and the Metropolitan Area; and
- (b) within the Badgingarra Area;

of primary produce produced on such farm and of supplies and requisites for use in production thereon.

For the purposes of this exemption, "Badgingarra Area" means the area bounded as follows:—

On the east by a line from the northeast corner of Victoria Location 10328 along the eastern boundaries of locations 10328, 10329, 10330, 10331, 10332 and 10334, the southern boundaries of locations 10334 and 10333, the eastern boundary of locations 10142, the southern boundaries of locations 10142 and 10141, part of the eastern and the southern boundary of Melbourne Location 3702, the northern, western and part of the southern boundary of location 2063, the western and southern boundary of location 2064, the westernmost and southern boundaries of locations 3399, 2153, 3699, and 3714, the eastern and a southern boundary of location 3715, the eastern boundary of location 3715, the eastern boundaries of locations 3803, 3804 and 3805.

On the south by a line from the southeast corner of Melbourne Location 3805, along the southern and south-western boundaries thereof, thence to the southeast corner of location 3808 and thence due west to the seashore.

On the west by the seashore.

On the north by a line commencing at the north-east corner of Victoria Location 10328 and running along the northern boundaries of locations 10328, 10323, 10319, 10335 and 9999; the eastern boundaries of locations 10367 and 9276; the northernmost boundary of location 9276 and thence due west to the seashore.

"Metropolitan Area" means the area within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

#### 30. Kwinana Area.

The transport of goods by road between any place in the Metropolitan Area and any place in the area coloured green on the plan referred to in section 3 of the Industrial Development (Kwinana Area) Act, 1952.

For the purposes of this exemption "Metropolitan Area" means the area within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

#### 31. General Transport by Farmers.

The transport of livestock, poultry, fruit, vegetables, dairy produce or other perishable commodities or wheat, oats, barley or rye for sale, or, in the case of livestock, for sale

or agistment, irrespective of quantity or value, from the place where they are produced to any other place in a vehicle owned by the producer thereof and on the return journey the carriage of requisites for the domestic use of such producer or for use by him in the production of the commodities herein named.

#### 32. Fertiliser Distribution.

The transport of fertiliser from the place where it is manufactured to any place within a radius of fifty miles from such place of manufacture.

#### 33. Bags for Fertiliser.

The transport by a primary producer in his own vehicle of empty bags from his own farm to a fertiliser works for subsequent use in supplying the fertiliser requirements of such farm.

#### 34. Clover Seed for Grading.

The transport of clover seed in a vehicle owned by the producer thereof from the place of production to any other place and return in the course of procuring the grading and/or cleaning of such seed for the purpose of its subsequent use at such place of production.

## 35. Transport of Fodder and Machinery Between Farms.

The transport by a farmer in his own vehicle of grain and fodder produced by him and of his farm machinery from one farming property owned or leased by him to another such property for use in his farming activities thereon.

#### 36. Farm Machinery for Repairs.

The transport by a farmer in his own venicle of his own farm machinery in the course of procuring the repair of such machinery.

#### 37. Firewood Produced on Farms.

The transport from any farming property to any other place of firewood, including mallee roots, produced on such property.

### 38. Firewood Carried Outside South-West Land Division.

The transport of firewood within the area outside the South-West Land Division of Western Australia.

# 39. Fruit and Vegetables Within 40 miles from G.P.O.

The transport of fruit and vegetables within a radius of forty miles from the General Post Office, Perth, between the place of production and any place within the Metropolitan Area, and the carriage on the return journey of supplies purchased by primary producers for their own use in the course of production of fruit and vegetables, but not supplies intended for sale.

For the purposes of this exemption, "Metropolitan Area" means the area within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

#### 40. Shearing Plant.

The transport of shearing plant to or from any shearing shed by a shearing contractor in his own vehicle in the course of his business.

#### 41. Livestock.

The transport of livestock.

#### 42. Bricks from Cardup and Byford.

The transport of bricks from brick kilns situated at Cardup and Byford to any place within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

#### 43. Tradesmen's Tools.

The transport by any tradesman in his own vehicle of hand tools required by him in carrying on his occupation as a tradesman.

44. Survey Equipment.

The transport of survey instruments, equipment and materials to a survey site and return.

45. Coal and Coke.

The transport of coal and coke for domestic use.

46. School Children and Supervisors.

The transport of school children and supervisors in any passenger vehicle which operates pursuant to a contract with the Department of Education of Western Australia for the carriage of school children, while such vehicle is so operating or is operating at the request of the Department of Education on routes where, or at times when, there is no regular transport service which could cater satisfactorily for such transport.

47. Fishing Gear.

The transport by a licensed fisherman in his own vehicle of his nets, boats and other fishing gear and requisites to and from estuaries and beaches.

48. Airline Passengers and Baggage.

The transport of the passengers of an airline operator and their baggage between an airport and the nearest town in a vehicle owned by such airline operator, or chartered by such operator for that purpose.

 Emergency Transport of Airline Passengers and Freight.

The transport by road of passengers, baggage and freight by or on behalf of an airline operator for the purpose of completing a journey frustrated by aircraft failure, adverse weather conditions or other circumstances beyond the control of the operator of the aircraft.

50. Aerial Spraying, Crop-dusting, etc.

The transport by air of equipment and materials solely in the course of aerial spraying, crop-dusting, seed sowing, fertiliser distribution, photography, geophysical surveying, dog batting, whale and fish spotting and "flying doctor" medical services.
