WHEREAS by section 109 of the Land Act, 1933-1960, the Governor may resume, for any purpose as in the public interest he may think fit, any portion of land held as a Pastoral Lease; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the portion of Pastoral Lease 392/477 described in the schedule hereto should be resumed for the purpose of "Agricultural Settlement and Conservation of Fauna": Now, therefore I, Sir Charles Henry Gairdner, Governor as aforesaid, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation, resume portion of Pastoral Lease 392/477 for the purpose aforesaid.

Country Towns Sewerage Act, 1948-1954. Mount Barker Sewerage Area. ORDER IN COUNCIL.
