IN pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Fauna Protection Act, 1950-1954, I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare Grey Kangaroos, known scientifically as *Macropus ocydromus*, not protected for a period of five years from 1st July, 1962, throughout all that portion of the State as defined in the schedule hereto.

Schedule.

All that portion of the State of Western Australia lying north and east of a line starting at the shore of the Indian Ocean at the 31st parallel

of south latitude and extending east to the 118th meridian, thence south to the 34th parallel of south latitude and thence east to the shore of the Southern Ocean.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 14 of the Fauna Protection Act, 1950-1954, that, except to the extent which the Governor declares by Proclamation pursuant to the provisions of that section, all fauna is wholly protected throughout the whole of the State of Western Australia at all times and that the Governor may from time to time declare that any of the fauna is not protected; and whereas it is further enacted by that section that the Governor may from time to time, by Proclamation, vary the provisions and operation of a Proclamation promulgated pursuant to the power conferred upon him by that section by cancelling those provisions and that operation wholly or in part and substituting other provisions and their operation for those so cancelled; and whereas by a Proclamation dated the 11th June, 1958, the Governor declared, *inter alia*, that the reptilian fauna described in the schedule to that Proclamation not protected; and whereas it is now deemed advisable that all the fauna, described in the schedule to this Proclamation be

not protected: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and pursuant to the powers conferred upon me by the Act, do hereby—

- (a) cancel the Proclamation dated the 11th June, 1958;
- (b) declare that the fauna described in the schedule to this Proclamation shall be not protected.

Constitution Act, 1899.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.R. 571/60.

WHEREAS the enactment contained in section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1899, by which the appointment of all public officers under the Government of the State is vested in the Governor in Council does not apply to minor appointments which, by Order in Council, are vested in Heads of Departments or other officers or persons within the State; and whereas it is desirable that the appointment of foremen and all other persons employed at a daily rate of wage on works under the control of the Commissioner of Main Roads should be vested in the officer whose name is set out in the attached schedule: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby vests in the officer named in the attached schedule and any person or persons appointed to temporarily act in their place, the appointment of foremen and all persons employed on such works at a daily rate of wages.

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and
Drainage Act, 1909-1960.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 577811/62.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1960, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter

mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Water Supply.
Shire of Perth.

The construction of a brick pumping station complete with all valves and apparatus, together with a 21-inch diameter mild steel and reinforced concrete rising main with all necessary valves, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 8707.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 13th day of July, 1962.

Camballin Irrigation District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 1048/61.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 28a of the Rights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914-1954, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, constitute any defined part of the State an Irrigation District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute the whole of the said area defined in the schedule hereunder, to be an Irrigation District and to assign the name of "Camballin Irrigation District" thereto.

WHEREAS the Council of the town of Cottesloe is desirous, under the by-law making power conferred by section 193 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1961, of making by-laws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in the sea adjoining though outside its district for a distance of two hundred (200) yards from low water mark at ordinary spring tides; and whereas it is enacted by subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of that section, that such by-laws may be made only pursuant to an order made under subsection (8) of section 190 of the Act; and whereas it is enacted by the subsection last mentioned, that where in the opinion of the Governor a by-law making power conferred by the Act on a council should be extended to an area which is outside the district, the Governor may by order declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the power the area is to be regarded as being within the district and that the council may exercise the power in respect of the area as if in fact it were within the district; and whereas the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that the said by-law making power should be extended to the said area outside the district of the said Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, pursuant to the powers conferred by subsection (8) of section 190 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1961, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the said by-law making power an area which is outside the district of the town of Cottesloe, namely the area which adjoins that district and extends for a distance of two hundred (200) yards seaward from low water mark at ordinary spring tides is to be regarded as being within the district of the town of Cottesloe and that the Council of the town of Cottesloe may make by-laws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in respect of that area as if in fact it were within the municipal district of the town of Cottesloe.

Between Federated Clerks' Union of Australia Industrial Union of Workers, W.A. Branch, Applicant, and the Honourable Minister in Charge of the Harbour and Lights Department, Respondent.

WHEREAS an industrial dispute existed between the abovenamed parties; and whereas the said dispute was referred into Court for the purpose of hearing and determination; and whereas the parties subsequently met and conferred and have arrived at agreement on all matters in difference; and whereas the parties have this day appeared before the Court by their respective representatives and requested the Court to make the said agreement an Award of the Court: Now, therefore, the Court pursuant to section 65 of the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1961, and all other powers therein enabling it hereby declares the memorandum hereunder written to have the same effect as and be deemed an Award of the Court:—

Memorandum of Agreement.

(Note.—Wherever the word "Award" occurs herein it shall be taken to mean and include "Agreement.")

1.—Title.

This Award shall be known as the "Harbour and Light Department Wharfingers, Assistant Wharfingers and Clerks Award of 1962" and shall replace Industrial Agreement No. 4 of 1953 as amended by Industrial Agreement No. 13 of 1955, Industrial Agreement No. 20 of 1956, and Industrial Agreement No. 13 of 1959.

3.—Area and Scope.

This Award shall apply to all workers engaged as wharfingers, assistant wharfingers, officers in charge goods sheds and or clerks at the ports under the control of the Harbour and Light Department in Western Australia. The area of this Award shall be the whole of the premises controlled by, vested in, or for the time being occupied by the Harbour and Light Department at ports in Western Australia.

4.—Definitions.

"Minister" shall mean the Minister in Charge of Harbour and Light Department.

"Department" shall mean the Harbour and Light Department.

"Union" shall mean the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia Industrial Union of Workers W.A. Branch.

"Wharfinger" shall mean and include any worker employed as officer in charge of a port in the case of North-West ports, or in charge of a berth or jetty and transit sheds in the case of other outports under the control of the Department.

"Assistant Wharfinger" shall mean and include any worker employed as assistant officer in charge of a port in the case of North-West ports, or as assistant officer in charge of a berth or jetty and transit sheds in the case of other outports under the control of the Department,

"Clerk" shall mean and include any worker who is employed in a clerical capacity on a full time basis in any office, shed, berth or jetty at any port under the control of the Department.

"Manager" shall mean the Manager of the Harbour and Light Department.

5.—Hours of Duty.

(a) The maximum number of hours to constitute a week's work shall not exceed forty (40) and shall be worked as mutually agreed upon by the Manager and the Union.

(b) (i) The Manager may require any worker to work reasonable overtime at overtime rates, and such worker shall work overtime in accordance with such requirement.

(ii) The Union or worker or workers covered by this Award shall not in any way, whether directly or indirectly, be party to or concerned in any ban, limitation or restriction upon the working of overtime in accordance with the requirements of this subclause.

(c) The lunch hour shall be taken between the hours of 12 noon and 2 p.m. One full hour to be allowed for lunch.

6.—Overtime.

Overtime shall mean all time worked outside the ordinary hours of duty and shall be paid for as follows:—

- (a) Week Days.—All time worked in excess of eight (8) hours per day—time and a half.
- (b) Saturdays.—Where forty (40) hours' work for the week has been completed excess time worked on Saturday shall be paid for at the rate of time and a half. Provided that time worked on Saturday which is necessary to complete the ordinary working week of forty (40) hours shall be paid for at the rate of ordinary time.
- (c) Sundays.—All work performed on Sundays shall be paid for at the rate of time and a half.
- (d) Public Holidays.—All work performed on public holidays as prescribed in clause 9 hereof shall be paid for at the rate of time and a half.
- (e) A worker recalled for duty after his normal finishing time, or on a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday shall be paid at the appropriate overtime rate for a minimum period of two hours.

7.—Basic Wage, Basic Rate and Rates of Pay.

(a) Basic Wage.—The basic wage hereinafter referred to shall be as determined from time to time by the Court of Arbitration of Western Australia but at the date of operation of this Award was:—

(v) The Manager shall classify positions covered by this subclause within the range provided.			

8.—Higher Duties.

Where a worker is called to relieve another worker, for a period exceeding one week, in a position classified on a margin higher than the margin of the worker relieving, such worker shall be paid the minimum margin applicable to the position in which he is relieving.

9.—Public Holidays.

The following days, or the days observed in lieu thereof, shall be observed as holidays and be paid for, namely, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Foundation Day, Sovereign's Birthday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

10.—Annual Leave.

(a) Each worker shall be granted leave of absence on full pay for three (3) weeks in each year, same to be accumulated and taken every two years.

(b) If any Award holiday falls within a worker's period of annual leave and is observed on a day which in the case of that worker would have been an ordinary working day, there shall be added to that period, one day, being an ordinary working day for each such holiday observed as aforesaid.

(c) Where the period of service is less than twelve (12) months the worker shall be entitled to holiday pay in proportion as the period of service is to the full period of twelve months.

11.—Long Service Leave.

(a) A worker who has completed 10 years' continuous service shall be entitled to three calendar months' long service leave on full pay or six calendar months on half pay.

(b) For each subsequent period of seven years' continuous service a worker shall be entitled to an additional three calendar months' long service leave on full pay or six calendar months on half pay.

(c) Continuous service shall not include the period during which a worker is on long service leave or any period exceeding two weeks a worker is absent on leave without pay or any service a worker may have had before reaching the age of 18 years.

(d) A worker who resigns or is dismissed shall not be entitled to long service leave or payment for long service leave other than the leave that had actually accrued to him prior to the date on which he resigned or the date of the offence for which he was dismissed.

(e) Any public holidays occurring during the period in which a worker is on long service leave will be treated as part of the long service leave, and extra days in lieu thereof shall not be granted.

(f) Long service leave shall be taken as it falls due at the convenience of the Department, but the employer may approve the accumulation of long service leave not exceeding six months in any particular case.

(g) A lump sum payment for long service leave accrued in accordance with this clause and for pro rata long service leave shall be made in the following cases:—

- (i) To a worker who retires at, or over the age of 60 years, or who is retired on the grounds of ill health, provided that no payment shall be made for pro rata long service leave unless the worker has completed not less than 12 months' continuous service.

(ii) To a worker who is retired for any other cause provided that no payment shall be made for pro rata long service leave unless the worker had completed not less than three years' continuous service before the date of his retirement.

(iii) To the widow of the worker or to such other person as may be approved by the employer in the event of the death of a worker: Provided that no payment shall be made for pro rata long service leave unless the worker had completed not less than 12 months' continuous service prior to the date of his death.

(h) The calculation of the amounts due for long service leave accrued and for pro rata long service leave shall be made at the permanent classified rate of salary of a worker at the time of retirement, resignation or death, whichever applies. No such payment shall exceed the equivalent of 12 months' salary.

12.—Sick Leave.

A worker shall be entitled to payment of wages for any absence from his employment on the ground of personal ill-health for one-sixth (1/6th) of a week's pay per month during each year of service. Any absence through such ill-health, except as hereinafter provided, shall be limited to two (2) weeks' wages in each calendar year: Provided that a worker with at least two (2) years' of service who produces to his employer a medical certificate that absence from his employment on the ground of personal ill-health necessitates a longer absence than the period allowed shall be entitled to the equivalent of four (4) weeks' wages in each calendar year.

Payment hereunder may be adjusted at the end of each calendar year, or at the time the worker leaves the service of the employer, in the event of the worker being entitled by service subsequent to the sickness to a greater allowance than that made at the time the sickness occurred.

No worker shall be entitled to the benefits of this clause unless he produces proof satisfactory to his employer or his representative of sickness, but the employer shall not be entitled to a medical certificate unless the absence is for three (3) consecutive working days or more. No payment will be made for any absence due to the workers own fault, neglect or misconduct.

This clause shall not apply where the worker is entitled to compensation under the Workers' Compensation Act.

13.—Engagement.

The engagement of any worker shall be terminated by one month's notice on either side, excepting that a worker, being guilty of gross misconduct or neglect of duty may be instantly dismissed or suspended and shall not be entitled to any such notice or payment in lieu.

14.—Preference of Employment.

All workers shall be members of the Union: Provided that any worker who at the time of engagement is not a member of such Union shall become a member thereof within fourteen (14) days of such engagement, and provided also, that the Union shall not refuse to accept as a member any such worker who is eligible, and applies in the manner prescribed, under the rules of the Union to become a member thereof.

15.—District Allowance.

District allowance shall be paid in accordance with district allowances operating under the Government Construction and Maintenance Award No. 35 of 1952 or any amendment thereof, or any Award which supersedes such Award.

16.—Time and Wages Record.

Records shall be kept by the Department showing the name of each worker under this Award, the nature of the work performed, the hours worked each day, and the amount of wages received each pay. The said record shall be open to the inspection of an accredited representative of the Union during working hours,

17.—Accrued Rights.

No privileges or concessions at present enjoyed by the workers shall, unless expressly provided herein, be varied or cancelled solely by reason of the provisions of this Award.

18.—Term.

The term of this Award shall be for a period of three (3) years from the date hereof.

19.—Variations of Rates of Pay.

The various rates of pay prescribed by this Award shall be varied automatically to conform with any variations which may be made from time to time in the equivalent salary rates applying to officers employed under the Public Service Act, 1904-1956. Any such variations shall apply from the date that the variations have effect in respect of officers employed under the Public Service Act, 1904-1956.
