AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 20th day of December, 1962, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Land Act, 1933-1962.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 1667/18.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1962, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 17056 at Perenjori should vest in and be held by the Shire of Perenjori in trust for the purpose of Recreation and Show Ground: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Perenjori in trust for Recreation and Show Ground with power to the said Shire of Perenjori subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease.

Uniform General By-laws.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G.D. 234/62.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 433A of the Local Government Act, 1960-1962, that the Governor may (*inter alia*) make and publish in the

Government Gazette uniform general by-laws for all or any of the purposes for which by-laws may be made by a Council under Part XV of that Act and by order declare that all or any such uniform general by-laws as are specified in the order shall apply to the whole or any portion of a district so specified; and whereas the Construction of Television Masts and Antennae (Uniform General) By-laws were so made and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 29th November, 1962: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby order that the whole of the Construction of Television Masts and Antennae (Uniform General) By-laws so published shall apply to the whole of each and every district in the State.

Declaration of Townsite.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Suspension of Part XV.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G.D. 817/60.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 373 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that at the request of a council the Governor may by order from time to time suspend the operation of all or any of the provisions of Part XV of the Act in its district or any portion thereof to which they apply for such period as he thinks fit; and whereas by Order in Council issued on the 7th June, 1961, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 16th June, 1961, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator did suspend the operation of all the provisions of Part XV of the Local Government Act, 1960, in the respective districts of portions thereof specified in the second column of the schedule to the Order of the municipalities specified in the first column of that schedule for the period, in respect of each district or portion of a district, from and including the 1st day of July, 1961, until such time as an Order is made under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of that section applying all or any of the provisions of that Part to that district or portion of a district; and whereas it is deemed advisable and expedient to substitute for a particular portion of a municipal district specified in the said Order the portion of that municipal district hereinafter mentioned: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by the Local Government Act, 1960, doth hereby substitute for the portion of the district of the municipality of Esperance specified in the second column of the Schedule to the Order in Council issued on the 7th June, 1961, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 16th June, 1961, the following portion of that district:—

The whole of the district with the exception of all townsites.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 578/61.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsection (1) of section 433A of the Local Government Act, 1960, that the Governor may make and publish in the *Gazette* uniform general by-laws for all or any portion of the purposes for which by-laws may be made by a Council under Part XV of the Act and may by order declare that all or any such uniform general by-laws as are specified in the order shall apply to the whole or any portion of a district so specified; and whereas by Orders in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on the 23rd June, 1961, the 13th June, 1962, and the 4th October, 1962, the Governor did thereby make certain uniform general by-laws, and declare that those by-laws should have the force of law in each municipal district specified in the Second Schedule to the Order in Council; and whereas it is desired that the said by-laws should apply to the portion of the district set out hereunder: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the power conferred by the Local Government Act, 1960, doth hereby declare that the uniform general by-laws made pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 433A of the Local Government Act, 1960, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 23rd day of June, 1961, the 13th day of June, 1962, and the 4th day of October, 1962, shall apply to the portion of the district specified in the first schedule hereto to the extent specified in the second schedule hereto.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G.D. 862/62.

WHEREAS by the Local Government Act, 1960-1962, it is provided that the Governor, at the request made by the councils of two or more municipalities, may, by Order, constitute as a regional district for local government purposes, whether under that or another Act, the whole or portion of the combined area of the district of those municipalities; and shall in the Order assign a name to the district and specify the number of members to be allotted to the district and to be nominated by each constituent council; and whereas the councils of the municipalities of Brookton, Pingelly and Cuballing have made a request that the whole of their districts be constituted as a regional district for the local government purpose of the regulation and control of traffic (exclusive of the licensing of vehicles): Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute as a regional district, for the local government purpose of the regulation and control of traffic, under the Traffic Act, 1919-1961, (exclusive of the licensing of vehicles) the whole of the area of the district of Brookton, Pingelly and Cuballing and doth assign to the district the name "Brookton, Pingelly, Cuballing Regional Traffic District" and doth specify that six members, of whom two shall be nominated by each constituent council, shall be allotted to the district.
