### HEALTH ACT, 1911-1962. Shire of Gingin.

P.H.D. 1795/62.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Health Act, 1911-1962, a local authority may make or adopt by-laws and may alter, amend or repeal any by-laws so made or adopted: Now, therefore, the Shire of Gingin, being a local authority within the meaning of the Act and having adopted the Model By-laws described as Series "A," as reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, in the *Government Gazette* on the 9th day of August, 1956, doth hereby resolve and determine that the said adopted by-laws shall be amended as follows:—

#### PART I.—GENERAL SANITARY PROVISIONS.

1. By-law 1C is revoked and a new by-law is inserted as follows:—

#### 1C.—Provision of Apparatus for the Bacteriolytic Treatment of Sewage.

(a) Every new building constructed within the townsites of Lancelin, Guilderton and Ledge Point, as constituted under the Land Act, which are required to be provided with sanitary conveniences shall also be provided with apparatus for bacteriolytic treatment of sewage. The effluent from such apparatus shall be disposed of within a distance of not more than 30 feet from the rear boundary of the property.

(b) Every house constructed after the coming into operation of this by-law which is within the townsite of Gingin, as constituted under the Land Act, 1933, shall be provided by the owner of that house with an apparatus for the bacteriolytic treatment of sewage before it is occupied or used.

2. By-law 41 (a) is amended as follows:—

By inserting after the word "pollution" where it appears in line 2, the following, "and situate not more than 30 feet from the front boundary of the property."

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1960.

The Municipality of the Shire of Bayswater.

By-laws Relating to the Removal of Refuse, Rubbish or Other Material.

L.G. 722/62.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the abovementioned Municipality hereby record having resolved on the 21st day of November, 1962, to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following by-laws:—

1. The Council may require the owner or occupier of any land within the District to remove, within a time specified in a notice given by the Council and served on the owner or occupier of the land, refuse, rubbish or other material whatsoever which in the opinion of the Council is likely to affect adversely the value of adjoining property or the health, comfort or convenience of the inhabitants thereof.
2. Any owner or occupier of land who fails to comply with the terms of a notice given in accordance with the previous by-laws within the time specified in the said notice shall be guilty of an offence.
3. Where the owner does not remove the refuse, rubbish or other material within the time specified in the notice given by the Council and served on the owner in pursuance of the provisions of by-law No. 1 hereof, the Council may remove the said refuse, rubbish or other material and recover from the owner in a Court of competent jurisdiction the amount of the expense of so removing the refuse, rubbish or other material.
4. Any person who shall commit a breach of any of these by-laws shall be liable to—
  - (a) a maximum penalty of £50; and
  - (b) a maximum daily penalty during the breach of £5 per day.

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1960.

Municipality of the Town of Northam.

By-law Governing Long Service Leave to be Granted to Employees of the Northam Town Council.

L.G. 450/62.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the abovementioned Municipality hereby records having resolved on the 28th day of November, 1962, to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following by-laws.

1. In the interpretation of the by-laws, the following words shall have the meanings assigned to them hereunder:—
  - (a) "Council" means the Northam Town Council; "employee" means and includes all persons employed in any capacity by the Council, and who are in the regular and full time employment of the Council.

- (b) "Continuous service" means service in the employment of the Council during which an employee has not been absent from the service of the Council for a continuous period of more than two days or an aggregate period of more than 10 days without leave of absence being granted by the Council.

2. All present and future employees of the Council shall after each period of 10 years' continuous service as permanent full time employees thereof, commencing from the 1st day of July, 1953, be entitled to three months' long service leave, and no long service leave shall be granted to an employee without a qualifying period of 10 years being first completed.

Provided however that where an employee of the Council has become entitled to long service leave under the provisions of the Long Service Leave Act, 1958, he shall not be entitled to any further long service leave until after the expiration of 10 years' continuous service from the date he became entitled to long service leave under the provisions of the Long Service Leave Act, 1958.

Except that the Council may grant *pro rata* long service leave to an employee who has served a minimum of five years' continuous service with the Council and has reached the retiring age of 65 years or is retired on the grounds of ill-health or is dismissed through staff retrenchments.

3. (a) The Council may grant long service leave to an employee of the Council who has been granted long service leave for 10 years' continuous service if, before a further period of 10 years' continuous service is reached, such employee retires from the Council's service owing to having reached the retiring age of 65 years, or is retired on the grounds of ill-health, or dismissed through staff retrenchments, in which case the long service leave may be adjusted *pro rata*.

Provided that no such grant shall be made to an employee of the Council who prior to completing a further period of 10 years' continuous service resigns his employment with the Council.

(b) The long service leave which may be granted under this by-law shall be for a period not exceeding one and three-tenths weeks for every completed year of service since the conclusion of the period which qualified the employee for his previous long service leave, and shall be on full pay.

4. An employee dismissed by the Council for neglect of duty or for irregular practices shall not be paid any sum in pursuance of the preceding by-law.

5. Absence on account of sickness shall not be deemed to be a break in continuity of service, providing the period of absence shall not exceed three months in any year, unless otherwise decided by the Council.

6. (a) Long service leave shall be taken at the convenience of the Council, who will, as far as possible, meet with the wishes of the employee, but the Council may require the employee to take leave by giving not less than three months' notice.

(b) Long service leave shall be taken by every employee within 12 months of its becoming due, and if not so taken, the employee shall not begin to qualify for further long service leave until resumption of duty after taking the long service leave already due to him. Provided that with the express approval of the Council, an employee be allowed to accumulate long service leave up to, but not exceeding six months.

7. In the event of retirement or death of an employee, the Council may pay to such an employee (or in case of death to his personal representatives, or if there be none, to his dependants) a sum of money equal to his wages or salary for the period of long service leave which the Council is empowered under these by-laws to grant to such employee under these by-laws at the date of his retirement or death, or if the Council after consideration of all the circumstances, direct that the death of an employee be presumed the Council may authorise the payment to the dependants a sum equivalent to the amount of wages or salary which would under this by-law, have been granted the employee immediately prior to the date of his death, such date to be determined by the Council.

8. (a) Employees due to take long service leave shall be paid their salary or wages for the period thereof at the rate equivalent to the salary paid in the week immediately preceding the taking of long service leave.

(b) The Council may at its discretion either (1) pay to an employee his wages or salary periodically during long service leave, or (2) pay to the employee in advance a sum representing the amount of his wages or salary for the period of his long service leave.

9. All annual leave to which an employee is entitled or will become entitled before the expiration of his long service leave shall be taken by the employee in conjunction with his long service leave, but any public holidays which may occur during the taking of his long service leave, are not to be paid for over and above the long service leave, but are to form part of such long service leave.

10. Long service leave shall be considered as a special period of recuperation after a lengthy term of service, with a view to fitting the employee for a further term and during such leave no employee shall undertake any form of employment for hire or reward. Any contravention of this by-law shall entitle the Council to dismiss the employee from its service and to cease paying or to recover any amounts paid in advance on account of long service leave.

1. In these regulations the Noxious Weeds Act Regulations, 1951, published in the *Government Gazette* on the 9th November, 1951, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices published in the *Government Gazette*, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. Regulation 6A of the principal regulations is amended, by adding, after subregulation (3), the following subregulation:—

(4) Without limiting the generality of subregulation (1) of this regulation, a person shall not commence spraying operations of any kind, within the area defined in subregulation (2), with any chemical mentioned in subregulation (3), of this regulation, unless he shall, at least fourteen clear days prior to that commencement, have given to the Chief Weed Control Officer notice in writing of his intention in that regard; and every notice given pursuant to this this subregulation shall set out—

- (a) the approximate area to be sprayed;
- (b) the location of the area to be sprayed;
- (c) the chemical to be used;
- (d) the method of spraying; and
- (e) the proposed date of spraying.

## MILK ACT, 1946-1960.

Regulations.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Honey Pool Act Regulations, 1963.
2. In these regulations unless the context requires otherwise—  
“the Act” means the Honey Pool Act, 1955 (as amended); “Trustees” means the body corporate named “The Trustees of the Honey Pool of Western Australia” constituted under the Act.
3. The Trustees may at any time during the operation of any voluntary honey pool established under the Act fix a date after which the Trustees will cease receiving honey for inclusion in that pool, and thereupon the Trustees shall give not less than five days’ notice of the date so fixed in a newspaper circulating throughout the State and shall specify in such notice that only those persons who submit honey for sale through that pool on or before that date shall be participants in respect of that pool
4. When in respect of any voluntary honey pool the Trustees give notice pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of regulation 3 of these regulations, a person shall not be a participant in respect of the pool unless honey submitted by him for sale through a pool is received by the Trustees not later than the date specified in that notice, and any honey received by the Trustees after that date may at the option of the Trustees be returned to the sender at his own expense or be retained for inclusion in the next following voluntary honey pool established by the Trustees under the Act.
