WHEREAS by section 7 (a) of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1962, it is provided that the Governor may, by Order in Council, alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Area, or of any District, or Metropolitan Main Drainage District; and whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of the Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 as at present defined should be extended: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 and declare that the said boundaries as shown on Plan M.W.S.S.&D.D., W.A. No. 7087, and as described in Order in Council of 19th June, 1957, and subsequent Orders in Council shall be extended in the following manner, by adding the area described in the Schedule hereunder and including it in Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1.

Commencing at a point in the centre of the intersection of Sulman Avenue, Manning, and Letchworth Centre Avenue and proceeding in a westerly direction along Letchworth Centre Avenue to the prolongation of the western boundary of lot 13, Letchworth Centre Avenue; thence northerly along the said boundary and westerly along the southern boundary of lot 207, Sulman Avenue, and northerly along the western boundaries of lots 207 and 206, Sulman Avenue; thence westerly along the southern boundary of lot 193, Klem Avenue, across Klem Avenue and along the southern boundaries of lot 143, Klem Avenue, and Lot 131, Pepler Street, to the centre of Pepler Street; thence southerly, westerly and northerly along Pepler Street, Letchworth Centre Avenue and Welwyn Avenue respectively. worth Centre Avenue and Welwyn Avenue respectively and continuing along Welwyn Avenue across Conochie Crescent to the prolongation of the northern boundary of lot 16, Welwyn Avenue; thence westerly along the said boundary and northerly along the western boundaries of lots 9 to 14, inclusive, and 26, 27, 28, Welwyn Avenue; thence north-easterly across Bradshaw Crescent and northerly along the western boundaries of lots and portherly along the western boundaries of lots. and northerly along the western boundaries of lots and northerly along the western boundaries of 1005 5 and 4, Welwyn Avenue, and westerly along the southern boundary of lot 1, Henning Crescent; thence northerly along the western boundary of the said lot 1 across Henning Crescent and along the western boundary of lot 518, Henning Crescent, and westerly and northerly along the southern and western boundaries respectively of lot 513, Downey Drive; thence north-westerly across Downey Drive and northerly along the western boundary of lot 423, Downey Drive; thence westerly along the southern boundaries of lot 415 and 414 Manning Road, and northerly along the western boundary of the said lot 414 to the centre of Manning Road; thence westerly along Manning Road and northerly along Davilak Crescent past Pether Road and along Davilar Crestent pass retirer road and north-easterly along Godwin Avenue across Crawshaw Crescent to the prolongation of the south-western boundary of lot 56, Godwin Avenue; thence north-westerly along the said boundary and north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of lots 56 and 55, Godwin Avenue, across Canavan Crescent and along the north-western boundary of lot 157, Canavan Crescent; thence northerly along the western boundary of lot 156, Godwin Avenue, and easterly along the northern boundaries of lots 156 and 155, Godwin Avenue, and northerly along the western boundary of lot 149, Henley Street, to the centre of Henley Street; thence easterly along Henley Street and along a right-of-way, southerly along Abjornson Street and westerly along Gillon Street; thence southerly along Goss Avenue, easterly along Manning Road and southerly along Elderfield Road past Griffin Crescent to Hope Avenue; thence westerly along Hope Avenue and

north-westerly and south-westerly along the north-eastern and north-western boundaries respectively of Canning Location 39 to the centre of Hope Avenue and continuing westerly along Hope Avenue and southerly along Sulman Avenue past Potter Avenue to the point of commencement as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 7087.

Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1960.

WHEREAS it is enacted, inter alia, by section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1960, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister a policy of insurance for the full amount of the liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an employer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all payments to become due under such liability, the Governor may, by Order in Council, exempt such employer from the operation of that section; and whereas Australian Iron & Steel Pty. Limited, a company incorporated in the State of New South Wales having its registered office in the State of Western Australia at T. & G. Building, 37 St. George's Terrace, Perth, being an employer within the meaning of the section has, duly, in accordance with the Act and the regulations made thereunder, made application for exemption from the operation of the section, and has satisfied the Minister that it has established a fund for insurance against the said liability, and has deposited at the Treasury a security, to wit, a bond for £5,000 charged with all payments to become due under the said liability: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby exempt Australian Iron & Steel Pty. Limited from the operation of section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1960, for a period terminating on the 25th day of January, 1965.

Declaration Under and Pursuant to Section 7F of the Housing Loan Guarantee Act, 1957-1962.

I, The Honourable David Brand, the Treasurer, having been requested under the provisions of section 7F of the Housing Loan Guarantee Act, 1957-1962 (in this notice called "the Act") to do so, do by this notice declare the following matters, that is to say—

- (a) the maximum amount which the Treasurer may guarantee under the Act during the period commencing the 19th May, 1958, and ending the 30th June, 1964, is the sum of three million pounds (£3,000,000);
- (b) the maximum amount in respect of which agreements for indemnity may be entered into by the Treasurer during the period commencing the 1st January, 1962, and ending the 30th June, 1964, is the sum of one million six hundred and ten thousand and ninety-four pounds (£1,610,094);
- (c) the maximum rate of interest which an approved institution may charge on a loan to a borrower or on the purchase money to a purchaser in respect of any period whilst an agreement for indemnity is in force in respect of the loan or purchase money, is six and one-half per centum $(6\frac{1}{2}\%)$; and
- (d) for the purposes of section 7B of the Act, the maximum amount which an approved institution shall advance to a borrower on the giving of a first mortgage of a new house or the maximum amount of the purchase moneys which an approved institution shall permit to remain payable under a contract for sale and purchase of a new house before an indemnity is given by the Treasurer under the Act, is sixty per centum (60%) of the value of a new house, as defined in the Act.
