WHEREAS it is enacted, inter alia, by subsections (2) and (3) of section 172 of the Companies Act, 1961-1962, that the Governor may, by Proclamation, declare that a company or foreign company is a company to which Division 4 of Part VI of the Act applies and that a declaration shall not be made in respect of a company or foreign company unless the Governor is satisfied that a prima facie case has been established that, for the protection of the public, it is desirable that the affairs of the company or foreign company should be investigated under that Division: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 172 of the Act, being satisfied that a prima facie case has been established that it is desirable that the affairs of the companies and foreign companies set forth in the schedule and foreign companies set forth in the schedule to this Proclamation should be investigated under Division 4 of Part VI of the Act, do hereby declare that those companies and foreign companies are companies to which that Division applies.
