PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas TO WIT, Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-Governor. [L.S.] by His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-Most Distinguished Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and Over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Com-monwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of-section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1962, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclama-tion declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the land described in the schedule hereunder be declared a totalisator agency region for those purposes: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and con-sent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that as from and including the 2nd day of December, 1963, the land described in the schedule hereunder shall be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1962.

Schedule.

The whole of the land contained in the muni-cipal district of the Shire of Mundaring.

Railways (Cue-Big Bell and Other Railways) Discontinuance Act, 1960.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas TO WIT, Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the DOUGLAS ANTHONY KENDREW, Governor. [L.S.] Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-month of the Bath, Commander of the Companion of the Distinguished Service Orthogovernor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Com-monwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted, inter alia, by section 2 of the Railways (Cue-Big Bell and other Railways) Discontinuance Act, 1960, that the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclama-tion, and that it shall not be necessary to proclaim that the whole of the Act shall commence on one day, but the several sections and paragraphs of the Act may be proclaimed to commence on such days as are respectively fixed by Proclamation; and whereas it is enacted by section 9 of the Act that on and after the commencement of that section the railway constructed from Mukinbudin to Bullfinch, as described in that section, shall cease to be operated until the Governor otherwise de-clares; and whereas it is enacted by section 10 of the Act that on and after the commencement of that section the railway constructed from Southern Cross to Bullfinch, as described in that section, and in addition thereto all that portion of railway line as extends west of the point of termination specified in the schedule to the Southern Cross-Bullfinch Railway Act, 1910 (Act No. 9 of 1910) to the point of termination specified in the Schedule to the Lake Brown-Bullfinch Railway Act, 1926, shall cease to be operated until the Governor otherwise declares; and whereas it is desired that each of sections 9 and 10 of the Act shall commence: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executve Council, do hereby fix the day on which this Proclamation is published in the Government Gazette as the day

on which each of sections 9 and 10 of the Railways (Cue-Big Bell and other Railways) Discontinuance Act, 1960, shall commence.
