AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 23rd day of December, 1963, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Inspection of Machinery Act, 1921-1958.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Mines 1063/63.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 82 of the Inspection of Machinery Act, 1921-1958, that the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, make regulations for any of the matters specified in that section: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by the Act, hereby makes the regulations set out in the schedule hereunder.

Schedule. Regulations.

1. In these regulations the regulations made under the provisions of the Inspection of Machinery Act, 1921 (as amended), reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, in the *Government Gazette* of the 6th August, 1962, with all amendments up to and including the 18th May, 1956, and as amended by notice published in the *Government Gazette* on the 4th May, 1962, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. The principal regulations are amended by adding after subregulation (6) of regulation 32 under the heading, "Regulations Relating to the Conduct of Examinations, Qualifications of Applicants, and the Granting of Certificates to Engine Drivers, Crane and Hoist Drivers, and Boiler Attendants," the following subregulation:—

(7) An applicant for a restricted Crane and Hoist Driver's Certificate, which may be granted by the Board in respect only of portal or semi-portal cranes or other cranes that are fitted with jibs, and which are operated by power other than hand or animal power and are controlled by the Fremantle Harbour Trust and used for handling cargo, shall comply with paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of subregulation (2) of this regulation and shall produce satisfactory evidence that he has for periods totalling at least 320 hours assisted to drive a portal or semi-portal crane, such assistance being under the supervision of a person who is the holder of a certificate entitling him to drive and have charge of such a crane.

Forests Act, 1918-1954. ORDER IN COUNCIL

F.D. 836/62; L. & S. 4093/40.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that the Governor may, by an Order in Council, reserve any Crown land as a timber reserve; and may revoke in the whole or in part any such reservation: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby revoke Timber Reserve No. 149/25, Plan 438A/40, B2.

Forests Act, 1918-1954. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 1231/62, L. &. S. 2405/54.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954 it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

(a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.

(b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 8th day of November, 1962, for the revocation in part of such dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown land as State Forest No. 4 by excising those portions of such State Forest as are described in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule.

State Forest No. 4.

(a) All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the south-eastern corner of Collie Town Lot 1259, a point on the present boundary of State Forest No. 4, and extending generally south-westerly along the western side of Gavan Street (road number 10187) to the northern side of Gibbs Road (road No. 10188); thence generally west-north-westerly along that side to an eastern boundary of Collie Townsite, a point on the present boundary of State Forest No. 4 aforesaid, and thence generally northerly and generally southeasterly along that boundary to the starting point.

(b) All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-eastern corner of Collie Town Lot 1259, a point on the present boundary of State Forest No. 4, and extending generally southeasterly along the southern side of Briggs Street (road No. 1987) to the western side of Gavan Street (road No. 10187); thence generally south-westerly along that side to the south-western corner of Lot 1259 aforesaid, a point on the present boundary of State Forest No. 4 aforesaid, and thence northnorth-easterly along that boundary to the starting point.

Declaration of Townsites.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 154/57.

HIS Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the power conferred by section 686 of the Local Government Act, 1960, doth hereby—

- declare that all those pieces of land described in the schedule hereto, situate within the district of the Shire of Harvey, shall be townsites having the names of Benger, Roelands, Wokalup and Yarloop;
- (2) revoke the order concerning Yarloop Townsite which appeared in the Government Gazette of the 28th December, 1962, at pages 4139/40.

Technical Description.

Proposed Benger Townsite under the Local Government Act, 1960.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-western corner of lot 6 of Wellington Location 1 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 24321, and extending easterly along the northern boundary of that lot and onwards to the eastern side of the South-Western Highway (road number 806); thence south-south-westerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of lot 3 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 4500; thence westerly to and along that boundary and the southern boundaries of lots 4 to 8 inclusive to the south-western corner of the lastmentioned lot; thence north-north-easterly along the western boundary of that lot and onwards to the northern side of road number 5484; thence easterly along that side to the south-western corner of lot 4 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 14394; thence north-north-easterly along the western boundary of that lot to its north-western corner; thence easterly along the northern boundaries of that lot and lot 3 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 11751 to the south-western corner of lot 5 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 16486, and thence north-north-easterly along the western boundaries of that lot and lot 6 aforesaid to the starting point. Proposed Roelands Townsite under the Local Government Act, 1960.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-western corner of lot 1 of Wellington Location 4 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 9834, and extending easterly along the northern boundary of that lot and onwards to the eastern side of road number 383; thence southerly along that side to the northern side of a right-of-way passing along the northern boundary of lot 6 as shown on Land Titles Office Plan 3946; thence easterly along that side and the northern boundary of lot 26 and onwards to the eastern side of a one-chain road passing along the east-ern boundaries of that lot and lots 20 to 25 inclusive; thence southerly along that side to the Titles Office Diagram 4965; thence south-easterly along the northern boundary of that lot to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of lot 1 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 20624; thence southerly to and along the eastern boundaries of that lot and lots 2, 3 and 4 to the south-eastern corner of the lastmentioned lot; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that lot to the eastern side of the one-chain road passing along the eastern boundaries of lots 20 to 26 inclusive aforesaid; thence southerly along that side to the southern side of Colton Street; thence westerly along that side to the eastern side of road number 383 aforesaid; thence generally south-westerly along that side to the northern side of road number 153; thence generally south-easterly along that side to a point situate 31 degrees 7 minutes from the northern corner of lot 1 as shown on Land Titles Office Plan 12857; thence south-westerly to that corner; thence generally south-westerly along north-western boundaries of that lot to the eastern side of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence generally north-easterly along that side to the southern side of road number 153 aforesaid; thence corner of lot 1 as shown on Land Titles Office north-westerly to the southernmost corner of lot 11 as shown on Land Titles Office diagram 9834; thence westerly, northerly, north-easterly and south-easterly along boundaries of that lot to the western side of the South-Western Highway (road number 1150); thence generally north-easterly along that side to the southern corner of lot 10; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that lot to its western corner, and thence generally northerly along the western boundaries of that lot and lots 9 to 1 inclusive to the starting point. (Public Plan 411A/40.)

Technical Description. Proposed Wokalup Townsite under the Local Government Act, 1960.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the south-western corner of lot 37 of Wellington Location 50 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 4878, and extending easterly along the southern boundary of that lot to the western side of the South-Western Highway; thence northerly and north-easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of part of lot 35 of location 50 aforesaid being the subject of Certificate of Title Volume 1147, folio 288; thence southerly and south-westerly to and along boundaries of that part of lot 35 to its southern corner; thence southerly along the western boundary of lot 1 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 28518 to the southern boundary dary of location 50 aforesaid; thence westerly along that boundary to the western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence southsouth-westerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of lot 3 of location 1 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 23170; thence westerly, northerly and easterly to and along boundaries of that lot to the western side of the South-Western Highway aforesaid; thence north-north-easterly along that side to the easternmost eastern boundary of lot 47 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 18775; thence northerly along that boundary and the eastern boundaries of lots 1 and 72 as shown on Land Titles Office Plan 2527 and onwards to the starting point. (Public Plan 383D/40.)

Technical Description. Extension and Redescription of Yarloop Townsite.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the eastern side of the South-Western Railway Reserve situate in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of Wellington Location 826 and extending easterly to and along that boundary and onwards to the eastern side of the South-Western Highway (road number 41); thence south-south-easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the northernmost northern boundary of Harvey Agricultural Area Lot 163; thence westerly and southerly to and along boundaries of that lot to the northern boundary of Reserve 4506; thence easterly, southerly, westerly, northerly and again westerly along boundaries of that reserve to a western boundary of lot 163 aforesaid; thence southerly and westerly along boundaries of that lot to the eastern side of road number 1443; thence generally southerly along that side to the north-western corner of lot 4 of lot 163 aforesaid as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 6666; thence easterly and southerly along boundaries of that lot and onwards to the southern side of Clifton Road (road number 479); thence westerly along that side to the eastern side of the South-Western Railway Reserve aforeside of the South-Western Railway Reserve afore-said; thence generally northerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Harvey Agricultural Area Lot 187; thence westerly to the south-eastern corner of that lot; thence generally northerly, westerly and again northerly along boundaries of that lot to the southern side of Wickham Street (road number 10515); thence westerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation southside to a point situate in prolongation south-easterly of the south-western boundary of part of lot 106 as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 7326; thence north-westerly and north-easterly to and along boundaries of that part of lot 106 to the north-western corner of that part of lot 106 being the subject of Certificate of Title Volume 1026, folio 531; thence easterly and south-easterly along boundaries of that part of lot 106 to the northern side of Wickham Street aforesaid; thence easterly along that side to the western side of easterly along that side to the Western side of Teesdale Street; thence generally northerly along that side to the south-eastern corner of lot 33 of lot 106 as shown on Land Titles Office Plan 2620; thence westerly and northerly along boun-daries of that lot and northerly along the western boundaries of lots 34 to 42 inclusive and onwards to the northern side of road number 478; thence easterly along that side and onwards to the east-easterly along that side and onwards to the easteasterly along that side and onwards to the east-ern side of the South-Western Railway Reserve aforesaid and thence generally northerly along that side to the starting point. (Public Plan 383A/40.)

> Local Government Act, 1960. Shire of Cranbrook. Alterations of Wards and Membership. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 320/62.

WHEREAS it is provided in paragraphs (g), (h), (i) and (j) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960 that upon presentation of a petition under the Common Seal of the Municipality, the Governor may alter the boundaries of Wards existing in a district, create new Wards, describe the boundaries of Wards and within the limits prescribed by the Act alter the number of offices of Councillor assigned to a municipality; and whereas it is furthr provided in paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section 12 of the said Act that the Governor may give such directions as he thinks necessary in order to give effect to an alteration in the number of members of a Council wards; and whereas the municipality of the Shire of Cranbrook has submitted a petition under its Common Seal praying that the existing Wards may be altered and a new Ward created to be known as the Bokerup-Unicup Ward and further praying that the number of offices of Councillor assigned to the municipality shall be altered by increasing the number from nine to twelve; and whereas it is considered desirable that the prayer of the petition should be granted: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and pursuant to the powers conferred by the said Act, doth hereby:-

(a) alter the boundaries of the Wards existing in the district of the municipality of the Shire of Cranbrook, create a new Ward to be known as the Bokerup-Unicup Ward, and describe the boundaries of the Wards as existing after the changes, as set forth in the attached Schedule;

(b) alter the number of offices of Councillor assigned to the municipality of the Shire of Cranbrook from nine to twelve and direct that these shall be allocated to the respective Wards as follows:—

Gordon

each to be represented by two members, Central

Bokerup-Unicup

each to be represented by one member.

Stirling Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-eastern corner of Plantagent Location 2971, a point on a southern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and extending along the prolongation easterly of the northern boundary of that location to the eastern side of the Great Southern Railway Reserve; thence generally northwesterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation north-westerly of the south-eastern boundary of location 4426; thence south-westerly and north-westerly to and along boundaries of that location to its eastern corner; thence northeasterly, north-westerly and south-westerly along boundaries of Cranbrook Townsite to the southeastern corner of location 1016; thence west-southwesterly along the southern boundary of that location and generally west-north-westerly and north-westerly along boundaries of location 3049; thence west-north-westerly along that prolongation to the western side of Albany Highway (road number 6963); thence generally north-westerly along that side to its intersection with the left bank of the Gordon River; thence generally northeasterly upwards along that bank to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of location 1240, a point on a northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook aforesaid and thence generally south-easterly, generally easterly, southerly and generally westerly along boundaries of that Shire to the starting point.

Tenterden Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the south-eastern corner of Hay Location 2005, a point on a southern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and extending northerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to the south-western corner of location 1181; thence northerly along the western boundary of that location and northerly and easterly to and along boundaries of location 482 to the south-western corner of location thence northerly along the western boundary 663: of that location and onwards to the northern side of road number 6575; thence generally north-westerly along that side and onwards to the generally north-easterly along that side and genrally north-easterly along that side and genrally north-easterly and south-easterly along the northern side of road number 1070 to the easternmost south-eastern corner of Plantagenet of location 3049 and onwards to the western boundary of location 3867; thence south-easterly and generally east-south-easterly along boundaries of that location and east-north-easterly along boundaries of southern boundary of location 1016 to the north-western boundary of Cranbrook Townsite; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along boundaries of the townsite to the casterly along boundaries of that townsite to the eastern side of the Great Southern Railway Reserve; thence generally southeasterly along that side to a point situate in

prolongation easterly of the northern boundary of location 2971; thence westerly to the north-eastern corner of that location, a point on a southern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook aforesaid and thence generally west-south-westerly along boundaries of that Shire to the starting point.

Frankland Ward

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-western corner of Nelson Location 12256, a point on a southern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and extending along the prolongation northerly of the western boundary of that location to the southern boundary of location 342; thence generally westerly, northerly, easterly and again northerly along boundaries of that location to the southernmost south-western corner of location 350 (reserve 25506); thence northerly, westerly and again northerly along boundaries of that location to the south-western corner of location 343; thence northerly along the western boundary of that location and northerly and easterly along bound-aries of location 354 to the south-western corner of location 358; thence northerly along the western boundaries of that location and location 346 and onwards to the south-western corner of location 12231; thence easterly along the southern boundary of that location and onwards to the westernmost south-western corner of location 12011; thence easterly, southerly, again easterly and northerly; along boundaries of that location to the southernmost south-eastern corner of location 12009; thence westerly, northerly, easterly, again northerly, again easterly and again northerly along boundaries of that location to the southern boundary of location 12008; thence generally north-westerly, easterly and northerly along boundaries of that location to the southern boundary of location 349; thence westerly and northerly along boundaries of that location and onwards to the south-eastern corner of location 3908; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that location and onwards to the western side of road number 7292; thence northerly along that side to the southermost south-eastern corner of location 356, a point on a northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook aforesaid; thence generally north-easterly along that boundary to the south-eastern corner of location 7079 and onwards to the left bank of Towerlup Brook; thence generally southerly downwards along that bank and the left bank of the Frankland River to a point situate in prolongation north-westerly of the north-eastern side of road number 3394; thence generally south-easterly to and along that side to the western corner of the north-eastern severance of Hay location 1033; thence easterly and southerly along boundaries of that severance to the northern side of road number 3394 aforesaid; thence generally south-easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the northernmost western boundary of location 875; thence southerly, westerly and again southerly to and along boundaries of that location to the northern side of road number 1301; thence generally easterly along that side to the northern side of road number 6575; thence 6575; thence generally south-easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the western boundary of location 663; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the northern boundary of location 482; thence westerly and southerly along boundaries of that location and onwards along the western boundary of location 1181 to the north-western corner of location 2005; thence easterly and southerly along bound-aries of that location to its south-eastern corner, a point on a southern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook aforesaid and thence generally westerly along that boundary to the starting point.

Bokarup-Unicup Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the southernmost south-eastern corner of Nelson location 356, a point on a northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and extending southerly along the western side of road number 7292 to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of location 3908; thence easterly to and along that boundary to the southeastern corner of that location; thence southerly and easterly to and along boundaries of location 349 to the north-western corner of location 12008; thence southerly, westerly and generally southeasterly along boundaries of that location to the northernmost north-western corner of location 12009; thence generally southerly, westerly, southerly, again westerly, again southerly and easterly along boundaries of that location to the easternmost north-eastern corner of location 12011; thence generally southerly, westerly, northerly and again westerly along boundaries of that location and onwards to the south-eastern corner of location 12231; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that location to its south-western corner; thence southerly to and along the western boundaries of location 346 and 358 to the northern boundary of location 354; thence westerly and southerly along boundaries of that location and southerly along boundaries of that location 350; thence southerly, easterly and again southerly along boundaries of that location to the northernmost north-western corner of location 342; thence southerly, wasterly, again southerly along boundaries of that location to the northernmost north-western corner of location 342; thence southerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the western boundary of location 12256; thence southerly to the north-western corner of that location, a point on a southern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and thence generally south-westerly, generally north-westerly and generally easterly along boundaries of that Shire to the starting point.

Gordon Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-eastern corner of Hay Location 93, a point on a northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and extending southerly along the eastern boundary of that location and onwards to the left bank of the Gordon River; thence generally easterly upwards along that bank to the west-ern side of Albany Highway (road number 6963); thence generally south-easterly along that side to the northern side of road number 1070; thence north-westerly and generally south-westerly along that side and generally south-westerly along the northern side of road number 1301 to the western-most western boundary of Hay Location 875; thence northerly, easterly and again northerly along boundaries of that location and onwards to the northern side of road number 3394; thence gener-ally north-westerly along that side to the southern corner of the north-eastern severance of location 1033; thence northerly and westerly along boundaries of that severance to the eastern side of road number 3394 aforesaid; thence generally northwesterly along that side and onwards to the left bank of the Frankland River; thence generally northerly upwards along that bank and the left bank of Towerlup Brook to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Nelson location 7079; thence westerly to the southeastern corner of that location, a point on the northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and thence generally north-easterly along that boundary to the starting point.

Tunney Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the left bank of the Gordon River situate in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of Plantagenet Location 1240, a point on the northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and extending generally south-westerly and generally westerly downwards along that bank to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the eastern boundary of Hay Location 93; thence northerly to and along that boundary to the north-eastern corner of that location, a point on the northern boundary of the Shire of Cranbrook and thence generally easterly along that boundary to the starting point.

Central Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the eastern corner of Plantagenst Location 4426, a point on a south-eastern boundary of Cranbrook Townsite and extending south-westerly and north-westerly along boundaries of that location to its western corner, a point on a southwestern boundary of Cranbrook Townsite aforesaid

and thence north-westerly, north-easterly, southeasterly and south-westerly along boundaries of that townsite to the starting point.

(Public Plans: 443/80, 444/80, 445/80, 437C/40, 437D/40, 436C/40, 436D/40 and 438C/40, Cranbrook Townsite.)
