WHEREAS section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1889, provides that the Governor in Council may vest in Heads of Departments, or other officers or persons within the State, power to make minor appointments; and whereas it is desirable that power of appointment of foremen and other per-sons employed at a daily rate of wage on works under the control of the Department of Public Works, and of Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage (exclusive of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Department) should be vested in Byron Collins Cornish): Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby vests in Byron Collins Cornish the appointment of foremen and all other persons employed on such foremen and all other persons employed on such works at a daily rate of wage.

Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1960. Coorow Water Supply.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 4 of the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912-1950 it is provided, inter alia, that all water works, sewerage, drainage and irrigation works constructed by the Government and declared by the Governor to be subject to any of the Acts mentioned in the Schedule to the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912-1950, shall vest in the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage on behalf of Her Majesty unless and until those works are vested in a board; and whereas by section 11 of the Fublic Works Act, 1902-1956 the Governor by Order in Council published in the Government Gazette on the 31st December, 1959, authorised the Minister for Works to undertake, construct or provide Coorow Town Supply Headworks pipeline and standpipe on land coloured green on Plan P.W.D., W.A. 37926 and whereas by Order in Council dated the 23rd December, 1959, and published in the Government Gazette on the 31st December, 1959, the Coorow Country Water Area was constituted under the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1957: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers contained in section 4 of the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912-1950, doth hereby declare the Coorow Town Supply (Headworks pipeline and standpipe) on the land coloured green on Plan P.W.D., W.A. 37926 to be subject to the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1960 (being an Act mentioned in the Schedule to the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912-1950, and to vest in the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage.
