WHEREAS by section 19 (2) (a) of the Child Welfare Act, 1947-1962, it is provided that the Governor may appoint such persons, male or female, as he may think fit, to be members of any particular Children's Court and may deter-mine the respective seniorities of such members; and whereas by section 19 (1) (b) (ii) of the said Act the Governor may amend, vary or revoke any such appointment: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby appoint William Albert Thornton and Murray Alexander Forbes to be members of the Children's Court at Cunderdin and doth hereby revoke the appoint-ment of John Ashley Bull as a member of the Children's Court at Cunderdin.

Land Act, 1933-1963. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 684/61. WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 27176 (Wongan Hills Lot 109) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu in trust for the purpose of Aged People's Homesites: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu in trust for Aged People's Homesites with power to the said Shire of Wongan-Ballidu, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding twentyone (21) years from the date of the lease.
