Child Welfare Act, 1947-1962.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 19 (2) (a) of the Child Welfare Act, 1947-1962, it is provided that the Governor may appoint such persons, male or female, as he may think fit, to be members of any particular Children's Court and may determine the respective seniorities of such members; and whereas by section 19 (1) (b) (ii) of the said Act the Governor may amend, vary or revoke any such appointment: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby appoint William Albert Thornton and Murray Alexander Forbes to be members of the Children's Court at Cunderdin and doth hereby revoke the appointment of John Ashley Bull as a member of the Children's Court at Cunderdin.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 684/61.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 27176 (Wongan Hills Lot 109) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu in trust for the purpose of Aged People's Homesites: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu in trust for Aged People's Homesites with power to the said Shire of Wongan-Ballidu, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding twenty-one (21) years from the date of the lease.

a district so specified; and whereas, by Orders in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on the 23rd June, 1961, on the 13th June, 1962, on the 4th October, 1962, on the 3rd July, 1963, and on the 30th December, 1963, the Governor did thereby make certain uniform general by-laws; and whereas it is desired that the said by-laws should apply to the portion of the district set out hereunder: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in the exercise of the power conferred by the Local Government Act, 1960, doth hereby declare that the whole of uniform general by-laws made pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 433A of the Local Government Act, 1960, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 23rd day of June, 1961, on the 13th day of June, 1962, on the 4th day of October, 1962, on the 3rd July, 1963, and on the 30th December, 1963, shall apply to the whole of the district with the exception of the pastoral leases of Yardie Creek and Exmouth Gulf Stations within the district of the Shire of Exmouth.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 191/64.

WHEREAS the Council of the Shire of Kwinana is desirous, under the bylaw-making power conferred by section 193 of the Local Government Act, 1960, of making by-laws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in the sea adjoining though outside its district for a distance of two hundred (200) yards from low water mark at ordinary spring tides; and whereas it is enacted by subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of that section, that such by-laws may be made only pursuant to an order made under subsection (8) of section 190 of the Act; and whereas it is enacted by the subsection lastmentioned that, where in the opinion of the Governor a bylaw-making power conferred by the Act on a Council should be extended to an area which is outside the district, the Governor may, by order, declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the power the area is to be regarded as being within the district and that the Council may exercise the power in respect of the area as if in fact it were within the district; and whereas the Governor is of the opinion that the said bylaw-making power should be extended to the said area outside the district of the said Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, pursuant to the powers conferred by subsection (8) of section 190 of the Local Government Act, 1960, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that, for the purpose of the exercise of the said bylaw-making power, an area which is outside the district of the Shire of Kwinana, namely the area which adjoins that district and extends for a distance of two hundred (200) yards seaward from low water mark at ordinary spring tides is to be regarded as being within the district of the Shire of Kwinana, and that the Council of the Shire of Kwinana may make by-laws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in respect of that area as if in fact it were within the municipal district of the Shire of Kwinana.

hundred (200) yards from low water mark at ordinary spring tides; and whereas it is enacted by subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of that section, that such by-laws may be made only pursuant to an order made under subsection (8) of section 190 of the Act; and whereas it is enacted by the subsection lastmentioned that, where in the opinion of the Governor a bylaw-making power conferred by the Act on a Council should be extended to an area which is outside the district, the Governor may, by order, declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the power the area is to be regarded as being within the district and that the Council may exercise the power in respect of the area as if in fact it were within the district; and whereas the Governor is of the opinion that the said bylaw-making power should be extended to the said area outside the district of the said Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, pursuant to the powers conferred by subsection (8) of section 190 of the Local Government Act, 1960, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the said bylaw-making power an area which is outside the district of the Town of Geraldton, namely the area which adjoins that district and extends for a distance of two hundred (200) yards seaward from low water mark at ordinary spring tides is to be regarded as being within the district of the Town of Geraldton and that the Council of the Town of Geraldton may make by-laws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in respect of that area as if in fact it were within the municipal district of the Town of Geraldton.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) (b) of section 373 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that the Governor may, by order, apply all or any of the provisions of Part XV of the said Act to any district or to portion of a district; and whereas by subsection (2) of the said section at the request of a Council the Governor may, by order, from time to time suspend the operation of all or any of the provisions of the said Part XV in its district or any portion thereof; and whereas, by an Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* of the 16th June, 1961, the Governor suspended the operation of Part XV of the Act to the whole of the municipal district of the Shire of Morawa with the exception of the Morawa Town-site; and whereas the Morawa Shire Council has requested that the provisions of Part XV shall apply to the towns of Morawa, Koolanooka, Pintharuka, Gutha and Canna: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by subsection (1) (b) of the Local Government Act, 1960, doth hereby order that all of the provisions of Part XV of the Act shall apply to the towns of Morawa, Koolanooka, Pintharuka, Gutha and Canna within the municipal district of the Shire of Morawa, and doth further order that the suspension of Part XV contained in the reference to the Shire of Morawa in the schedule to the Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* of the 16th June, 1961, be revoked.
