Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency The Honourable Sir John Patrick Dwyer, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963, that isator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act, and also that a Proclamation so made may be cancelled or from time to time varied by a subsequent Proclamation; and whereas by Proclamations so made and published in the Government Gazette the Governor did declare certain portions of the State to be total declare certain portions of the State to be total-isator agency regions; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that those Proclamations be cancelled and that each of the portions of the State described in the schedule to this Proclamation be declared a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Act: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby-

- (a) cancel every Proclamation made under the said section 4 and published prior to the publication hereof; and
- declare that each of those portions of the State described in the schedule hereto shall be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963,

with effect from and including the 24th day of July, 1964.

Schedule.

- (a) The whole of the land contained in each of the municipal districts of
 - the cities of Perth, Fremantle, Subiaco, Nedlands and South Perth:

- the towns of Albany, Boulder, Bunbury, Carnarvon, Claremont, Cottesloe, East Fremantle, Geraldton, Kalgoorlie, Melville, Midland, Mosman Park, Narrogin, Northam and York;
- the shires of Albany, Armadale-Kelmscott, Balingup, Bassendean, Bayswater, Bel-mont, Boddington, Bridgetown, Brookton, Broomehill, Bruce Rock, Busselton, Canning, Capel, Chapman Valley, Chit-tering, Cockburn, Collie, Coolgardie, Cuballing, Cunderdin, Dandaragan, Cuballing, Cunderdin, Dandaragan, Dardanup, Donnybrook, Dowerin, Dumbleyung, Dundas, Esperance, Gascoyne - Minilya, Geraldton - Greenough, Gingin, Goomalling, Gosnells, Greenbushes, Harvey, Irwin, Kalamunda, Kalamund goorlie, Katanning, Kellerberrin, Kon-dinin, Koorda, Kwinana, Mandurah, Merredin, Mingenew, Mt. Magnet, Mul-lewa, Mundaring, Murray, Nannup, lewa, Mundaring, Muriay, Namus, Narembeen, Narrogin, Northam, Northampton, Peppermint Grove, Perenjori, Perth, Pingelly, Plantagenet, Quairading, Rockingham, Serpentine - Jarrahdale, Swan-Guildford, Tambellup, Tammin, Three Springs, Toodyay, Victoria Plains, Wagin, Wandering, Wanneroo, Waroona, West Arthur, Wickepin, Williams, Wood-anilling, and York;
- (b) the whole of the land contained in the townsite of Moora, as defined in the Government Gazette published on the 6th August, 1943;
- (c) any portion of the State comprised in any river, jetty, wharf, mole, groyne or seaward construction that is contiguous with, but not included any municipal district hereinbeforementioned.
