AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 20th day of January, 1965, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Land Act, 1933-1963.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corres. 2767/61.—That Reserve No. 27294 (Swan Location 7827) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wanneroo in trust for the purpose of Recreation (excluding use of the land for Public Camping and Caravan Park).

Corres. 2130/63.—That Reserve No. 27403 (Halls Creek Lots 161 and 162) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Halls Creek in trust for the purpose of Aged Pensioners' Homes Site.

Corres. 1577/63.—That Reserve No. 27406 at Jurien should vest in and be held by the Shire of Dandaragan in trust for the purpose of a Caravan Park.

Corres. 1521/64.—That Reserve No. 27407 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Perth in trust for the purpose of Drainage.

Corres. 1717/64.—That Reserve No. 27408 (Exmouth Lot 3) should vest in and be held by the Minister for Works in trust for the purpose of Water Supply.

Corres. 2814/63.—That Reserve No. 27409 (Exmouth Lot 1) should vest in and be held by the Commissioner of Main Roads in trust for the purpose of a Depot Site (Main Roads Department).

Corres. 2662/63.—That Reserve No. 27413 (Exmouth Lot 142) should vest in and be held by the Minister for Police in trust for the purpose of a Court House and Police Station Site.

Corres. 114/64.—That Reserve No. 27414 (Exmouth Lot 306) should vest in and be held by the Minister for Fisheries in trust for the purpose of an Office Site (Fisheries Department).

Corres. 71/64.—That Reserve No. 27415 (Exmouth Lot 143) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Exmouth in trust for the purpose of a Fire Station Site.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Land Act, 1933-1963.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is, *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corres. 1677/99, Vol. 2.—That Reserve No. 27339 (Perth Lot 827) should, subject as aforesaid be granted in fee simple to the Metropolitan (Perth) Passenger Transport Trust to be held in trust for the purpose of an Office and Depot Site (Metropolitan Transport Trust).

(The Order in Council issued under Executive Council Minute No. 2493 dated 25th November, 1964, relating to this reserve is hereby superseded.)

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall be granted in fee simple to the abovementioned persons and body, to be held in trust for the aforesaid purposes, subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.
