Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1964.

# ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted, inter alia, by subsection (2) of section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1964, that for the purposes of the Act the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council, adjust the boundaries of a fire district; and whereas by an Order in Council published in the Government Gazette on the 10th day of November, 1961, a portion of the municipal district of the Shire of Denmark was constituted a fire district with the name Denmark Fire District; and whereas it is deemed expedient to adjust the boundaries of that fire district: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby adjust the boundaries of the Denmark Fire District by substituting for the portion of the municipal district of the Shire of Denmark described in the schedule to the abovementioned Order in Council the portion of the municipal district of that Shire set out in the schedule to this Order in Council.

#### Schedule.

### Denmark Fire District.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the western corner of Denmark Town Lot 356, a point on the south-eastern side of Mc-Lean Road, and extending generally north-easterly and generally easterly along that side to the western side of Scotsdale Road; thence generally northerly along that side to a point situate west of the southern corner of Denmark Estate Lot 613; thence east to that corner; thence generally east-north-easterly along the northern side of Riche Road to the western boundary of Plantagenet Location 1854; thence southerly along that boundary

and onwards to and along the western boundaries of locations 2046 and 2300 to the north-western corner of Denmark Town Lot 238; thence easterly and southerly along boundaries of that lot and the eastern boundary of lot 271 and onwards to the southern side of Morgan Road; thence generally north-easterly along that side to the northern corner of Denmark Town Lot 255; thence southerly, westerly and again southerly along boundaries of that lot to the south-western corner of location 2637; thence westerly to and along the southern boundary of Denmark Town Lot 259 to the north-eastern corner of lot 548; thence southerly along eastern boundaries of that lot and lot 913 and onwards to the low water mark of Wilson Inlet; thence generally south-westerly and generally northerly along that low water mark to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the eastern boundary of location 646; thence northerly to and along that boundary to the northeastern corner of that location; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of locations 646 aforesaid and 647 to the western side of Ocean Beach Road; thence northerly along that side to the north-eastern corner of location 1974; thence westerly along the northern boundary of that location to the south-eastern corner of Denmark Estate Lot 617; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of that lot and onward to the northwestern side of Little River Road; thence generally south-westerly along the eastern boundary of that lot to the south-eastern corner of lot 337; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of that lot to the south-eastern corner and onwards to the northerly along the eastern boundary of that lot to its north-eastern corner and onwards to the northern side of McNabb Road; thence generally westerly along that side to the south-eastern corner of Denmark Town Lot 356 aforesaid and thence generally westerly along southern boundaries of that lot to the starting point. (Public Plans Denmark Townsite and 452C/40.)

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient, as follows:—

Corres. 4548/18.—That Reserve No. 17430—Kojonup Location 5672 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Katanning in trust for the purpose Gravel

Corres. 3763/59.—That Reserve No. 27116—(Albany Lot 1139) should vest in and be held by the Town of Albany in trust for the purpose of an Anzac War Memorial Site.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Land Act, 1933-1963.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 1808/64.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is, inter alia, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple on the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 27401 (Esperance Lot 431) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to The St. John Ambulance Association in Western Australia Incorporated, to be held in trust for the purpose of an Ambulance Centre: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the aforesaid body, to be held in trust for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

Local Government Act, 1960.

# ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act, 1960, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of a Council, by notice in the Government Gazette to declare any land reserved, or acquired,

for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control and management of a Council, or land comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Council as a public street, and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriage way and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Council mentioned in the schedule hereunder have requested that certain land named and described in the said schedule, which has been reserved for a street within the said Council be declared public streets: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be public streets, and such lands shall, from the date of this order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as streets within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.
