2. Regulation 240 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking subregulations (5) and (6) and substituting the following subregulations:-

(5) Subject to the other provisions of these regulations prescribing a maximum speed for any vehicle lower than that prescribed for that vehicle by this subregulation a person shall not-

- (a) drive a goods vehicle, the weight of which together with any load carried is not more than three tons, at a speed exceeding—
 - (i) 35 miles per hour within the metropolitan area or within a town outside the metropolitan area; or
 - (ii) 60 miles per hour elsewhere;
- (b) drive a goods vehicle, the weight of which together with any load carried, is more than three tons but is not more than seven tons, at a speed exceeding—
 - (i) 35 miles per hour within the metropolitan area or within a town outside the metropolitan area; or
 - (ii) 50 miles per hour elsewhere;
- (c) drive a goods vehicle, the weight of which together with any trailer attached including the total load carried, is more than seven tons, at a speed exceeding—
 - (i) 30 miles per hour within the metropolitan area or within a town outside the metropolitan area; or
 - (ii)) 40 miles per hour elsewhere;
- (d) drive any vehicle to which a trailer or other vehicle is attached at a speed exceeding 45 miles per hour; or
- (e) drive any vehicle licensed for the carriage of eight or more passengers at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.

(6) For the purposes of subregulation (5) of this regulation "goods vehicle" means a vehicle carrying goods or designed or ordinarily used for the carriage of goods, but does not include a vehicle designed and ordinarily used primarily for the carriage of passengers.

2. No person shall enter the golf course otherwise than by the public entrance gateway unless authorised by the Council, and no person shall enter the golf course except during the hours and days on which the golf course is open for playing or practising.

3. The golf course shall be open for the playing and practising of golf at such hours as the Council may from time to time fix and on all days except those on which the golf course shall be declared closed by order of the Council.

4. No person who offends against decency as regards dress, language or conduct shall enter or remain in the golf course or any building erected thereon and any person behaving in a disorderly manner or creating or taking part in any disturbance or using indecent or abusive language or committing any nuisance or in any way offending against decency on the golf course or being found thereon in a state of intoxication or otherwise offending shall be liable to be forthwith removed by any officer or servant of the Council or by any constable and shall be guilty of an offence against this by-law.

5. No person shall park, ride or drive any horse, bicycle, motor cycle, motor car, or other vehicle on any portion of the golf course, excepting on such areas paved and set apart for that purpose as indicated by a notice board and every person using any such area shall obey any order or direction given by an officer of the Council or person authorised by the Council and shall on days directed by the Council pay a fee not exceeding two shillings for entrance to the golf course or for the use of such parking areas.

6. The Council may at any time by notice posted at the public entrance gateway to the golf course prohibit the taking of a bicycle, motor cycle, motor car or other vehicle to any portion of the golf course.

7. The Council may at any time by notice posted at the public entrance gateway to the golf course prohibit any person from entering on to any portion of the golf course.

8. Every person entering the golf course by the public entrance gateway shall, on days directed by the Council, pay an entrance fee not exceeding two shillings, provided that such entrance fee shall not be chargeable to persons in possession of a ticket or receipt authorising such persons to play or practise golf on the day of entry.

9. No person shall gather, pick up, cut, dig up, remove or have in his possession whilst on the golf course, or take away herefrom, any shrub, flower, grass or other vegetation.

10. No person shall do anything which may cause or be likely to cause damage by fire to anything growing upon the golf course.

11. No person shall take or suffer any dog to enter into or remain on any part of the golf course unless such dog is confined to a motor vehicle or other vehicle.

12. No person, not being a player or employee of the Council shall cross or trespass upon any portion of the golf course prepared for play or practice, or any practice putting greens, except with the permission of the Council or the Controller.

13. No person shall cross or trespass upon any portion of the golf course, when it would be injurious to such portion laid out as a golf course or practice area, and when notices are posted to that effect.

14. No person, except an officer and workmen employed by the Council shall enter upon any part of the golf course enclosed or set apart for a nursery for trees, plants, grass plots, flowers, or shrubs, nor shall any person, without lawful excuse, enter any enclosure or area thereon wherein a house, pump house or equipment shed is located.

15. No person shall wilfully obstruct any portion of the golf course nor shall any person damage or interfere in any way with the trees, greens, bunkers, mounds or the approaches thereto, or the sloping sides thereof, or the fairways on the golf course, or any prepared portions of the golf course, or any equipment or notices set up thereon by the Council.

16. No person shall enter on or pass over the tees, fairways, greens, bunkers, mounds or the respective approaches thereto, or the sloping sides thereof, unless such person has permission to play golf on the golf course or is authorised by the Council.

17. No person other than a person authorised to play golf on the golf course shall pick up, remove or have in his possession on the golf course any golf ball and any person other than a person authorised to play golf on the golf course found having in his possession on the golf course a golf ball shall, for the purpose of this by-law, be deemed to have found such ball on the golf course and it shall lie on such person to prove that he did not do so.

18. No person except the Controller or professional employed by the Council shall offer for sale any golf ball or any golf equipment within the golf course, and no person shall buy any golf ball or golf equipment within the golf course, except from the Controller or professional.

19. No person shall coach or instruct any person in the playing of golf within the golf course unless with the consent in writing of the Council first obtained.

20. No person shall offer for employment or be employed for a fee as a caddie unless with the permission of the Controller first obtained and any such caddie shall abide by any direction given by the Controller as being reasonable and consistent with these by-laws, and no caddie of school age shall be eligible for employment on the golf course during school hours on school days.

21. Any written permission granted or ticket or receipt issued in pursuance of this by-law shall be produced for inspection at any time to any person duly authorised by the Council to demand the production of same.

22. No person shall be permitted to play on the golf course until he has first paid the green fee fixed by the Council and shall have first obtained and be in possession of a ticket or receipt issued by the Controller and any person found playing golf in contravention of this by-law shall be liable, in addition any penalty prescribed, to be refused by the Council entrance to the golf course for such period as the Council may, in each particular case, determine.

23. All persons authorised to play golf on the golf course must play the holes in the correct sequence commencing at the first tee, unless otherwise authorised by the Controller.

24. No person shall play on the golf course, if, in the opinion of the Controller, such person is not in full possession of sufficient and suitable golfing equipment for the purpose or is not reasonably and decently dressed. A sufficient and suitable golfing equipment shall comprise a golf-bag, one putter and three other clubs and golf balls. 25. All persons, after the commencing of play on the golf course, shall keep up with the players in the next preceding group of players in front of them and when any player is unable to do so, on account of looking for a lost ball or from any other cause, shall invite and permit the players next following them to play through.

26. All golf-bag buggies shall have a width of tyre not less than one inch and no person shall take a golf-bag buggy or any other such conveyance fitted with wheels or allow any such golf-bag buggy or equipment to be taken on to any part of the golf course laid out as a putting green.

27. The number of persons playing together in any group shall not exceed four, and, in order to facilitate the even flow of play, the Controller may direct golfers at the commencement of the round to form into groups not exceeding four. No person shall behave in any unruly manner on the golf course and no person shall by conduct, cause inconvenience or annoyance to any member of the public or officer of the Council.

28. Any person authorised to play golf on the golf course must commence play at the time directed by the Controller and any person who, for any reason, is unable to commence play at the time so directed shall forfeit any priority of play and the decision of the Controller must be complied with.

29. The ticket or receipt issued in pursuance of this by-law shall be available only for that part of the day on the date for which the ticket is dated for use.

30. No person shall play any other game of sport than golf on the golf course.

31. All players must observe and comply with the directions of the Controller in respect to any special conditions of play or notice in respect to "preferred lies" or "ground under repair."

32. All persons are admitted to the golf course under the express condition that the Council shall in no case be responsible for damage or injury to any person caused by any player or spectator from any cause whatsoever.

33. Every person playing on the golf course shall at all times observe the rules and etiquette of golf.

34. No person shall play or practise golf on any part of the golf course, and no person shall remain on any part of the golf course nor any building thereon outside the hours fixed by the Council.

35. No person shall take on to or consume intoxicating liquor on the golf course and no person shall take into or consume intoxicating liquor within any building on the golf course, unless authorised by the Council.

36. No person shall be permitted to practise golf shots on the tees, fairways, and greens on the golf course and no person shall practise golf shots except on those parts of the golf course indicated by notice board and prepared for such practice.

37. No person shall be permitted to practise golf shots on any portion of the golf course until he has first paid the fees fixed by the Council for such practice and shall have first obtained and be in possession of a ticket or receipt issued by the Controller.

38. No person authorised to play golf on the golf course may be accompanied by a non-playing spectator except by consent first obtained of the Controller, and no person under the age of 14 years shall play or practise golf on the golf course.

39. The Council may withdraw, cancel or annul any permission receipt or ticket authorising any person to play on the golf course.

40. No person shall remain on the golf course when lawfully directed by the Controller to leave same.

41. Every person who shall commit a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law may be forthwith removed from or directed to leave the golf course by the Controller, and such person shall, in addition be liable to prosecution for such breach.

42. Every person offending against any of the provisions of this by-law shall, for each offence, be liable to a penalty not exceeding $\pounds 50$.

43. The following fees shall be paid by persons for playing or practising golf:-

At all times for each 9 holes—4s. Or at a fee to be determined from time to time by the Council. Practice on days to be fixed by the Council for each half hour or part thereof—1s.

BUSH FIRES ACT. 1954-1964. Department of Lands and Surveys,

Perth, 15th February, 1965.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the provisions of the Bush Fires Act, 1954-1964, has been pleased to make the regulations set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Principal regulations.

1. In these regulations the Bush Fires Act, 1954, Regulations, as reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, and published as so reprinted in the Government Gazette on the Government Gazette on the 27th May, 1964, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Reg. 19 2. Regulation 19 of the principal substituted. the following regulation is substituted:-Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is revoked and

(1) Every application such as is mentioned in regulation 18 of these regulations shall be sent or delivered so as to be received by the authorised officer at least seven days prior to the day for which the permit is sought and shall be accompanied by such fee, not exceeding £4 4s., as the local authority may, by by-law, from time to time prescribe.

(2) The authorised officer shall, after the receipt of (2) The authorised onder shall, after the receipt of an application to burn clover, enter upon and inspect the land in respect of which the permit is sought and, upon being satisfied that the burning can be conducted with safety, may, subject to the succeeding provisions of this regulation and the provisions of regulations 20 and 21 of these regulations, issue a permit in the form of Form 5 in the Appendix.

(3) The authorised officer shall specify in a permit the day, not being a Sunday and not necessarily the day for which the normit was sought on which huming is which the permit was sought, on which burning is authorised and shall, subject to subregulation (4) of this regulation, specify such time between the hours of 4 p.m. and midnight, as he thinks fit or as the local authority may, from time to time, direct, at which burning may be commenced.

(4) The Board may, by notice in the Government Gazette authorise the issue of permits for the burning of clover, in any district or part of a district, at a time prior to 4 p.m. and, in that event a permit may, subject to the directions of the local authority for that district or that part of a district, specify a time prior to 4 p.m. for the commencement of burning.

Reg. 19A

The principal regulations are amended by adding, after regulation 19, the following regulation:-

19A. (1) A person to whom a permit is issued under the provisions of regulation 19 of these regulations shall at least four days before commencing to burn, deliver or cause to be delivered a notice of his intention in that regard-

- (a) to every occupier of land adjoining the area to be burnt;
- (b) to the bush fire control officer for the district, if he is not the authorised person who issued the permit; and
- (c) to a forest officer who is employed in any State forest situated within two miles of the area to be burnt.

(2) A person to whom a permit to burn clover is issued shall not burn or permit or suffer the burning of any area other than that for which the permit was issued or burn or permit or suffer burning on any day other than, or at any time prior to that specified in the permit.

(3) A person burning clover or causing it to be burnt shall, himself, provide at least three men to be present, and ensure their constant attendance, at the area of the fire, from the time it is lighted, until it is completely extinguished, to assist in keeping the fire under control and contained in the area to be burnt.

Reg. 38A amended.

4. Regulation 38A of the principal regulations is amended-

- (a) by inserting, immediately after the word, "tractor", in line two of subregulation (1), the passage, ", or on any day the towing or drawing of any grain bin mounted on steel skids,"; and
- (b) by substituting for the passage, "officer.", being the concluding passage of subregulation (1), the passage "officer; or
 - (c) prohibit the towing or drawing of any grain bin mounted on steel skids, on that land on that day or during specified periods on that day."

5. Regulation 38B of the principal regulations is revoked and Reg. 38B 5. Regulation 38B of the principal substituted. the following regulation is substituted:-

38B. (1) Where, in the opinion of the bush fire control officer, the operation of any power saw, bag loader or other plant or equipment activated by internal combustion engine on any land in the district may constitute a fire hazard, he may, by wireless broadcast from a radio station giving broadcast coverage to the district, by publication in a news-paper circulating in the district or by written notice or oral direction given to any person or persons, subject to such direction as may be given by the local authority, prohibit the operation of any such power saw, bag loader or other plant or equipment, until further notice, unless the operator has first-

- provided, at the site of operation, such fire-(a) fighting equipment, supply of water and other means of extinguishing fire as the bush fire control officer may, by the same means, direct; or
- (b) fitted to the engine by which the power saw, bag loader or other plant or equipment is activated a spark arrester of a suitable design, maintained in a clean, sound and efficient condition.

(2) Notwithstanding, but without limiting, the foregoing provisions of this regulation and in any event, every person shall, before operating any power saw, bag loader or other plant or equipment activated by internal combustion engine on land of which any part is under crop, pasture or stubble or that is forest land, fit to the engine by which the power saw, bag loader or other plant or equipment is activated a spark arrester of suitable design, maintained in a clean, sound and efficient condition.

(3) Every person who operates any power saw, bag loader or other plant or equipment activated by internal combustion engine, contrary to the provisions of, or contrary to any prohibition or direction given under, this regulation, commits an offence.

6. Regulation 38C of the principal regulations is amended by adding, immediately after the word, "so", being the last word in subregulation (1), the passage, ", or unless the local authority has, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, declared the Sunday or public holiday as being one to which this regulation does not apply".

1. In these regulations the Agricultural Products Act Regulations, published in the Government Gazette on the 21st January, 1938, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices published in the Government Gazette, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. Regulations 2 and 3 of the principal regulations, are revoked and the following regulations substituted:—

- - Part I-Regulations 4-5, Apples and Pears.
 - Part IA-Regulations 5A-5D, Bananas.

Part IB-Regulations 5E-5AE, Citrus Fruits.

- Part IC-Regulations 5AF-5AM, Grapes.
- Part II-Regulations 6-19, Eggs.
- Part III—Regulations 20-23, Potatoes.
- Part IIIA-Regulations 23A-23C, Onions.
- Part IV-Regulations 24-26, General.
- Part V-Regulations 27-34, Detention, Disposal and Destruction of Packages of Fruit.
- 3. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-
 - "Act" means the Agricultural Products Act, 1929, as amended; "Form" means one of the forms in The Appendix to these regulations.

3. The principal regulations are amended by adding, immediately after regulation 5AE, the following heading and Part:---

Part 1C.

Grading of Grapes.

5AF. Grapes intended for sale in Western Australia shall be graded, according to the following grades, namely:---

- (a) Special.
- (b) Standard.
- (c) Special Assorted.
- (d) Standard Assorted.

5AG In this regulation, for the purpose of grading grapes,----

- (a) "Special" grade shall consist of sound, clean grapes of one variety, of uniformly good colour for the variety, and the berries shall be firmly attached to the bunch; the grapes shall be free from diseased, split, cut, wilted, shrivelled, immature, malformed, blemished, raisined, dried or small berries and shall be of a uniformly good size for the variety;
- (b) "Standard" grade shall consist of sound, clean grapes of one variety, fairly good colour for the variety and the berries shall be firmly attached to the bunch; the grapes

shall be free from diseased, split, cut, wilted, shrivelled, immature, dried or small berries and from serious malformation or unsightly blemish;

- (c) "Special Assorted" grade shall consist of sound, clean grapes of not more than four varieties in any package and shall be of uniformly good colour for each variety and the berries shall be firmly attached to the bunch; the grapes shall be free from diseased, split, cut, wilted, shrivelled, immature, malformed, blemished, raisined, dried or small berries and shall be of a uniformly good size for the variety; and
- (d) "Standard Assorted" grade shall consist of sound, clean grapes of not more than four varieties in any package and shall be of fairly good colour for each variety and the berries shall be firmly attached to the bunch; the grapes shall be free from diseased, split, cut, wilted, shrivelled, immature, dried or small berries and from serious malformation or unsightly blemish.

5AH. For the purposes of this Part-

- (a) grapes shall be deemed immature, if a sample of the strained juice from not less than 1 lb. weight of grapes taken at random from any package or packages being similarly marked, has a hydrometer reading of less than 16.2° at 68° F., when taken with a hydrometer graduated on the Brix Scale and standardised at a temperature of 68° F., cr 9° at 68° F., when taken with a hydrometer graduated on the Beaume Scale and standardised at a temperature of 68° F., except that the varieties, Early Madeleine and Chasselas, shall be deemed immature if the juice has a Brix hydrometer reading of less than 15.4° at 68° F., or a Beaume hydrometer reading of less than 8.5° at 68° F;
- (b) "disease", means any abnormal condition of, or in, grapes, and includes any condition arising from functional disorders or caused by, or due to, the presence, operation, development or growth of any insect, fungus, bacterium or virus;
- (c) "sound", means not over-ripe, soft or wilted and free from physical injuries affecting the keeping quality of the grapes; and
- (d) "small berries", in relation to grapes, means small imperfectly seeded or seedless berries (commonly known as "shot berries") found in an otherwise normal buch of seeded grapes.

5AI. A person shall not pack grapes for sale, or sell grapes in any package, unless they conform to one of the grades mentioned in this Fart.

5AJ. All grapes shall be firmly and fully packed in either open or closed containers, approved under the Fruit Cases Act, 1919, but when grapes are packed in open containers, other than prescribed half bushel containers, the grapes shall be level with, and not protrude above the level of, the top of the container.

5AK. The outer layers of shown surfaces of grapes in a container shall be taken as being a true indication of the contents of the container.

5AL. Every package containing grapes intended for sale in the State of Western Australia shall be marked according to the requirements of the Fruit Cases Act, 1919, and, in addition, shall bear on one end thereof, in letters or figures of not less than one-quarter of an inch in height, if printed on a label, and not less than threequarters of an inch in height, if stencilled on the package, particulars of the variety and grade of grapes contained therein, unless a package contains assorted grades of grapes, in which case it shall be sufficient to include particulars of the grade only.

5AM. The provisions of this Part shall be read and construed in conjunction with the regulations made under the Fruit Cases Act. 1919, and for the time being in force.

4. Regulation 25 of the principal regulations is revoked.

5. The principal regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 26, the following heading and Part:—

PART V.

Detention, Disposal and Destruction of Packages of Fruit.

27. Where an inspector seizes or detains any package of fruit he shall issue to the owner or person in charge thereof a notice in accordance with Part A of Form 3, and a person shall not thereupon sell or remove or cause or permit to be sold or removed the fruit or any part of it, without the written authority of an inspector, given in accordance with Part B of Form 3 or of one of the orders or permits prescribed by the succeeding provisions of this Part.

28. Where an inspector orders fruit to be repacked by the owner or person in charge thereof or to be taken to a suitable place to be repacked, at the expense of the owner, or directs the owner or person in charge thereof to take other measures or do other acts necessary for the proper observance of the Act or these regulations, he shall issue an order in accordance with Part A of Form 4 and a person shall not sell or cause or permit to be sold the fruit or any part of it, without the written authority of an inspector, given in accordance with Part B of Form 4.

29. Where an inspector is of the opinion that any package of fruit should be destroyed, he shall make a report in accordance with Part A of Form 5, and, if the destruction is approved by the Minister or by any person thereunto authorised by him, the Minister or the person so authorised shall issue an order for destruction in accordance with Part B of Form 5.

30. For the purposes of this Part, "destruction", in relation to packages, means burning, and in relation to fruit, means burning, boiling, burying, dumping in a municipal tip or any other method of disposal that, in the opinion of an inspector, effectually does away with the fruit.

31. Where the owner of any fruit that does not comply with the Act or these regulations informs the inspector, prior to the execution of any order issued in accordance with either of regulations 28 or 29 of these regulations, that he desires to dispose of the fruit other than by sale or destruction, the inspector shall, if satisfied that the method of disposal specified by the owner does not contravene the Act or these regulations, issue a permit in accordance with Form 6.

32. Where an order is made under regulation 29, or a permit is issued under regulation 31, of these regulations the inspector may require the owner to satisfy him, by means of documentary evidence or otherwise, that the fruit described in the order or permit was disposed of as required by the order or allowed by the permit.

33. Where any notice, direction, order or permit is given, made or issued under this Part, the inspector may attach to the package of fruit a warning ticket in accordance with Form 7 and a person shall not detach that ticket or cause or permit it to be detached, without the written authority of an inspector.

34. Every person who contravenes the provisions of this Part commits an offence under section 4 of the Act.

6. The Appendix to the principal regulations is amended by adding, immediately after Form 2, the following forms:— Agricultural Products Act, 1929.
