WHEREAS it is provided (*inter alia*), by section 59 of the Factories and Shops Act, 1963-1964, that the occupier of a factory shall allow to any person employed in the factory a half holiday on any day proclaimed to be a half holiday in the district or locality in which the factory is situate and, by section 95 of that Act, that every shop, except an exempted shop and small shop, shall be closed, and a shopkeeper shall allow each shop assistant a half holiday on any day that is proclaimed to be a half holiday that is applicable to the area in which the shop is situated; and whereas, it appears to me, the Governor, expedient that a half holiday should be proclaimed for the day and place hereinafter appearing: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim the afternoon of Thursday the 18th day of March, 1965, to be a half holiday, within the municipal district of, and applicable to the area of, the Town of Bunbury.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 10th day of March, 1965, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

## Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1963.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, by section 8B of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1963, it is provided (*inter alia*) in subsection (2) of that section that, if a member is the only member applying to sit for an Electoral Province, the Governor shall, as soon as practicable after the period referred to in subsection (1) of that section, declare by Order in Council that the member shall sit and vote for that Electoral Province and on and from the date of the order the member shall sit and vote accordingly; and whereas by subsection (4) of the above-mentioned section it is provided (*inter alia*) that if after members have been allotted the Electoral Provinces for which they shall respectively sit, pursuant to subsection (2) or (3) of that section, there remains any Electoral Province or Electoral Provinces in respect of which no such allotment has been made, the Governor shall, as soon as practicable thereafter, by Order in Council allocate a member who has not been allotted a seat to sit for that Electoral Province or one of those Electoral Provinces, and on and from the date of the order the member shall, subject to the Act, sit accordingly: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the abovementioned provisions of the said Act and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth—

- (a) declare that the member named in the first column of the schedule hereunder shall sit and vote for the Electoral Province set out opposite his name in the second column, and

on and from the date of this order the member shall sit and vote accordingly:—
