PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas TO WIT, DOUGLAS ANTHONY KENDREW, Governor. IL.S.J Mothony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-able Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependancies in the Com-monwealth of Australia.

L.G. 777/53A.

Whereas by the provisions of the Cemeteries Act, 1897, the Governor is empowered, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, to declare any public cemetery to be closed for burials: Now, therefore I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this Proclamation declare that Ninghan Location 2553 (Reserve 15963) at Ballidu and being a public cemetery shall be closed for burials.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 181/54 (R808).

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act, 1960, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette* to declare any lands reserved, or acquired, for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control and management of a Council, or lands comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Council as a public street, and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriage way and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Town of Bunbury has requested that certain lands named and de-scribed in the schedule hereunder which have been scribed in the schedule hereunder, which have been reserved for a street within the Town of Bunbury be declared a public street: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be a public street, and such lands shall, from the date of this order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a street within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

Alteration and Adjustment of Boundaries. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 761/60.

WHEREAS it is provided in paragraph (f) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Govern-ment Act, 1960, that the Governor upon the pre-sentation of a petition under the Common Seal of the district concerned may alter and adjust the boundaries of adjoining districts; and whereas the municipality of the Shire of Canning has presented a petition praying that the boundaries

of its district where these are based on the banks of the Canning River and abut on the boundaries of the Town of Melville and the City of South Perth shall be altered and adjusted as set out in the schedule hereunder in order to correct an anomaly created by the severance of certain portions of the district of Canning and their annexation to the district of South Perth on the 10th day of June, 1965; and whereas it is considered expedient that the prayer of the petition should be granted: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby alter and adjust the boundaries of the district of the Shire of Canning, in relation to those of the Town of Melville and the City of South Perth, by severing from the district of the municipality of the Shire of Canning the area described in the schedule hereto.
