AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 10th day of May, 1965, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Local Government Act, 1960.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L. and S. Corres. 1566/65 (R1212).

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act, 1960, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette* to declare any land reserved, or acquired, for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control and management of a Council, or land comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Council as a public street, and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriage way and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Shire of Armadale-Kelmscott has requested that certain

lands named and described in the schedule hereunder, which have been reserved for a street within the Shire of Armadale-Kelmscott, be declared a public street: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be a public street, and such lands, shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a street within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.
