

WHEREAS under the provisions of paragraph (d) of the proviso to paragraph (c) of clause 1 of the First Schedule to the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1964, it is enacted that the compensation payable to an injured worker to cover hospital charges shall not exceed that from time to time determined by the Workers' Compensation Board: Now, therefore, the Board in exercise of the power conferred by the Act, doth hereby determine that as from the 1st day of July, 1965, the hospital charges referred to in proviso (d) to paragraph (c) of clause 1 of the First Schedule to the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1964, shall not exceed—

- (1) four pounds ten shillings (£4 10s.) per day for hospitals wherever situated while the injured worker necessarily and properly remains in hospital, provided that this rate shall be regarded as a maximum rate and the rate in each case shall not exceed the general rate chargeable for treatment in cases other than workers' compensation cases in a public ward bed in a public hospital, or a ward bed in a private hospital;
- (2) for operating theatre fees, such amount as would normally be payable to the hospital concerned in cases other than workers' compensation cases, or in a public hospital the sum of £3 3s.
