WHEREAS by clause 14 of the Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the office of Governor of the State of Stituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, bearing date the 29th October, 1900, it is provided that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent from the seat of Govern-ment or from the State, he may in every such case, by an instrument under the Public Seal of the State, constitute and appoint the Lieutenant-Governor to be his Deputy during such absence, and in that capacity to exercise, perform and exeand in that capacity to exercise, perform and exe-cute for and on behalf of the Governor, during such absence but no longer, all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor by such Letters Patent as shall in and by such instrument be specifact; and whereas I, the said Governor, propose to absent myself temporarily from the seat of Government: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, do by this instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint you the said Sir John Patrick Dwyer as from the date of my departure upon the said absence to be my Deputy, and in that capacity to exercise, per-form and execute for and on my behalf, as such Governor, all the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Letters Patent.

Spear-guns Control Act, 1955. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas TO WIT, DOUGLAS ANTHONY KENDREW, Governor. [L.S.] By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-able Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Com-monwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 5 of the Spear-guns Control Act, 1955, that from time to time the Governor may by Proclamation declare areas to be prohibited areas: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers contained in the Spear-guns Control Act, 1955, hereby declare the areas comprised in the schedule hereto to be prohibited areas within the meaning of that Act.

Schedule.

- (a) Scarborough Beach: All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded on the west by a line parallel to and 200 yards westerly from the high water mark of that ocean; on the east by that high water mark; on the north by the prolongation westerly of the northern side of Reserve Street and on the south by the prolongation westerly of the southern side of Brighton Road.
- (b) Trigg Island: All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded on the west by a line parallel to and 200 yards westerly from the high water mark of that ocean; on the east by that high water mark; on the north by the prolongation westerly of the northern side of Kathleen Street and on the south by the prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of Swan Location 1154.
- (c) Mettam's Pool: All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded on the west by a line parallel to and 200 yards westerly from the high water mark of that ocean; on the east by that high water mark; on the north by the prolongation westerly of the northern side of Sholl Avenue and on the south by the prolongation westerly of the southern side of Lynn Street.

- (d) Hamersley Pool: All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded on the west by a line parallel to and 200 yards westerly from the high water mark of that ocean; on the east by that high water mark; on the north by the prolonga-tion westerly of the northern side of Beach-ton Street and on the south by the prolonga-tion westerly of the southern side of Hamersley Street.
- (e) North Beach: All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded on the west by a line parallel to and 200 yards westerly from the high water mark of that ocean; on the east by that high water mark; on the north by the prolonga-tion westerly of the northern side of Castle Street and on the south by the prolongation westerly of the southern side of North Beach Road.
- (f) Watermans Bay: All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded on the west by a line parallel to and 200 yards westerly from the high water mark of that ocean; on the east by that high water mark; on the north by the prolonga-tion westerly of the northern side of Beach Road and on the south by the prolongation westerly of the southern side of Ada Street.

Fauna Protection Act, 1950-1954.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Fauna Protection Act, 1950-1954, I, the Governor, of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare an open season for Finches of all species, from 1st September to 31st December, 1965, and in every year thereafter, throughout the whole of the Kimberley Division of the State as defined in the Land Act, 1933-1963: Provided that finches shall be taken in the area aforesaid only by a person who is-

- (a) the holder of a license issued under regulation 8 of the Fauna Protection Regulations: or
- (b) a property owner whose property is being damaged by finches; provided further that such a property owner shall not take any finches for sale or sell any finches unless he is the holder of a license issued under regulation 8 of the Fauna Protection Regulation.

Corres. 2103/63. WHEREAS by section 31 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, the Governor may, by Proclamation and sub-ject to such conditions as may be expressed therein, classify as of Class "A" any lands of the Crown reserved to Her Majesty for any of the purposes specified in the said section; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the Reserve described in the schedule hereto should be classified as of Class "A": Now, therefore I, the Governor, with the ad-vice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation classify as of Class "A" the reserve described hereunder.

Schedule.

- Reserve No. 27575 (near Wanneroo) containing about 2,900 acres for the purpose of "National Park". (Plans Locations near Yanchep, Yanchep 40, Sheets 3 and 4, 1A/40.)

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 23rd day of June, 1965, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Land Act, 1933-1963.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is, inter alia, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as de-fined in the said section) subject to the condi-tion that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:-

Corres. 1633/61.—That Reserve No. 27477 (Beacon Lot 21) should, subject as aforesaid be granted in fee simple to The St. John Ambulance Association in Western Australia Incorporated to be held in trust for the purpose of an Ambulance Centre.

Corres. 2015/65.—That Reserve No. 27587 (Vic-toria Location 10738) should, subject as afore-said be granted in fee simple to the Returned Sailors', Soldiers' & Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (W.A. Branch) Incorporated to be held in trust for a "Hall Site (R.S.L.)".

Corres. 1252/65 .- That Reserve No. 27608 (Kalamunda Lot 126) should, subject as aforesaid be granted in fee simple to Congregation of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate to be held in trust for the purpose of a "School Site (Roman Catholic.'

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforemen-tioned reserves shall be granted in fee simple to

the abovementioned bodies, to be held in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

Land Act, 1933-1963.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corres. 73/64.—That Reserve No. 27338 (Kojonup Lot 283) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Kojonup in trust for the purpose of Recreation.

Corres. 3250/51.—That Reserve No. 23341 (at Ravensthorpe) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Ravensthorpe in trust for the purpose of Depot Site.

Corres. 2480/61.—That Reserve No. 26361 (in Wyncham)) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wyncham-East Kimberley in trust for the purpose of Park.

Corres. 872/18.—That Reserve No. 24410 (at Fremantle) should vest in and be held by the Fremantle Port Authority in trust for the purpose of Harbour Purposes.

(The Order in Council issued under Executive Council Minute No. 384 dated the 13th March, 1956, is hereby superseded.

Corres. 2103/63.—That Reserve No. 27575 (near Wanneroo) should vest in and be held by the National Park Board of Western Australia in trust for the purpose of National Park.

Corres. 2048/65.—That Reserve No. 27640 (Swan Location 7764) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Perth in trust for the purpose of Public Recreation.

Corres. No. 2047/65.—That Reserve No. 27641 (Swan Location 7763) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Perth in trust for the purpose of drainage.

Corres. 2047/65.—That Reserve No. 27642 (Swan Location 7765) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Perth in trust for the purpose of Drainage.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Forests Act, 1918-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 701/63, L. & S. 2395/62.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.
- (b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 30th day of October, 1963, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown land as State Forest No. 65 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the schedule hereto.

Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1.

Beatrice Avenue, Riverton, Extension (1965).

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 60803/65.

WHEREAS by section 7 (a) of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1963, it is provided that the Governor may, by Order in Council, alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Area, or of any District, or Metropolitan Main Drainage District; and whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of the Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 as at present defined should be extended: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, doth hereby order and declare as follows:—

That the boundaries of the Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 be and are hereby extended by including therein the land described in the schedule hereto.

Schedule.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of lot 1122 of Canning Location 25 as shown on Land Titles Office Plan 4391 with the centre-line of Herald Avenue, a point on the present boundary of the Metropolitan Main Drainge District No. 1 (Modillion Avenue, Riverton Extension), and extending southerly along that centre-line and onwards to the centre-line of Acanthus Road; thence westerly along that centre-line to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the eastern boundary of lot 1142 as shown on Land Titles Office Plan 4394; thence northerly to and along that boundary to the north-eastern corner of that lot; thence easterly to the south-western corner of lot 1131; thence

No. 9234.

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1963.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1963, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Main Drainage.

Shire of Rockingham.

M.W.S. 815035/64.

The construction of a 21-inch diameter water main, approximately 5,270 feet in length, complete with valves and all necessary apparatus and as shown on plan M.W.S.S. & D.B., W.A. No. 9240.

Metropolitan Main Drainage. Shire of Perth.

M.W.S. 489541/65.

The construction of a pumping station, rising main and gravity main between Colin Road and the Indian Ocean, approximately 5,000 feet in length, with all necessary apparatus and as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.B., W.A. No. 9241. These Orders in Council shall take effect from the 2nd day of July, 1965.

Busselton Water Board—Proposed Loan of £4,540. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the Water Board Act, 1904-1954, a Water Board may, with the approval of the Governor, borrow money for the construction of works for the storage, distribution and supply of water: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby approves, under the provisions of section 113 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, of the Busselton Water Board borrowing a sum of four thousand five hundred and forty pounds (£4,540) for a period of fifteen (15) years, re-payable by thirty (30) half-yearly instalments with interest at the rate of five pounds fifteen shillings (£5 15s.), per centum per annum for the work approved by Order in Council dated 7th April, 1965, and published in the Government Gazette of the 15th April, 1965.
