#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 578/61.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 433A of the Local Government Act, 1960-1964, that the Governor may (*inter alia*) make and publish in the *Government Gazette* uniform general by-laws for all or any of the purposes for which by-laws may be made by a Council under Part XV of that

Act and, by order, declare that all or any such uniform general by-laws as are specified in the order together with any amendments thereof whether by way of addition, substitution or cancellation shall apply to the whole or any portion of a district so specified; and whereas the Governor has made and published uniform general by-laws namely the Uniform Building By-laws, 1961, and has from time to time thereafter made and published amendments thereto: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers aforesaid, doth hereby declare that, of the Uniform Building By-laws, 1961, published in the *Government Gazette* on the 23rd June, 1961, and the amendments thereto published in the *Government Gazette* from time to time thereafter—

- (a) the whole of each of them, with the exception of paragraph (a) of by-law 401, applies to the whole of the municipal district of the Shire of Rockingham;
- (b) the whole of each of them applies to the municipal district of the Shire of Swan-Guildford with the exception of paragraph (a) of sub-bylaws (1) of by-law 33 and sub-bylaw (2) of by-law 423 which apply only to those portions of the district which are not shown as for "Rural Development" on the Metropolitan Regional Plan;
- (c) the whole of each of them applies to the whole of each of the municipal districts set out in the First Schedule hereto; and
- (d) the whole of each of them applies to those portions specified in each of the districts set out in the Second Schedule.
