WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963, that the Governor section 4 Betting

may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation, declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the land described in the schedule hereunder be declared a totalisator agency region for those purposes: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that as from and including the 9th day of August, 1965, the land described in the schedule hereunder shall be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963.
