Land Act, 1933-1963.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 7190/97.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of sub-leasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 27669 (Katanning Lots 49 and 53) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Katanning in trust for the purpose of Recreation: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Katanning in trust for Recreation with power to the said Shire of Katanning, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 686 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1963, that the Governor may by order declare land, including land which is privately owned and subdivided, to be a townsite, having such name as is specified in the order; and whereas it appears to His Excellency the Governor expedient that the land hereinafter mentioned should be declared a townsite under, and for the purposes of, the Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the power conferred by the said section 686 and acting by and with the advice and consent

of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the land described in the schedule hereto to be a townsite having the name of "Nabawa."

Nabawa Townsite.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the north-eastern corner of lot 3 of Victoria Location 2115, as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 20470, and extending southerly, westerly and northerly along boundaries of that lot to the south-eastern corner of location 10396; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that location to the eastern boundary of location 1364; thence southerly along that boundary to the south-eastern corner of lot 7 of location 1364 aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 29995; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that lot to the south-eastern side of road number 11178; thence generally southerly along that side and the eastern side of road number 4436 to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern side of road number 1810 within location 57; thence westerly along that side to the left bank of the Chapman River; thence generally north easterly upwards along that bank to the north-eastern side of road number 4436 aforesaid; thence generally south-easterly along that side and the north-eastern side of road number 8645 to the westernmost south-western corner of the south-eastern severance of location 1829 and onwards to the northern boundary of location 7011 and thence westerly along that boundary and the northern boundary of location 2115 aforesaid to the starting point.
