Declaration of Main Road.

M.R.D. 49/1945-1.

WHEREAS by section 13 of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1961, it is enacted that the Governor may on the recommendation of the Commissioner declare by Proclamation that any road shall be a Main Road and may, in like manner and on the like recommendation declare that any Main Road shall cease to be a Main Road; and whereas the Governor, by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* on the 27th day of July, 1928, declared, *inter alia*, that the road described in Schedule I hereto shall be a Main Road; and by

Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* on the 16th day of January, 1931, declared, *inter alia*, that the road described in Schedule II hereto shall be a Main Road known as the Northam-York-Cranbrook Road: and whereas it is deemed expedient that the portion of the said road described in Schedule I hereto shall cease to be a Main Road and that the portion of the said road described in Schedule II hereto shall cease to be part of the Northam-York-Cranbrook Road and shall form part of the Midland-Merredin-Southern Cross Road and that portion of the road described in Schedule III hereto shall be a Main Road: Now, therefore, I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby declare that portion of the Midland-Merredin-Southern Cross Road described in Schedule I, heretofore declared to be a Main Road, as aforesaid, shall cease to be a Main Road and that the portion of road described in Schedule II heretofore known as part of the Northam-York-Cranbrook Road, as aforesaid, shall now form part of the Midland-Merredin-Southern Cross Road and that the road specified in Schedule III hereto, as aforesaid, shall be a Main Road within the meaning of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1961, and that the footpaths, if any, of such road be excluded from the Main Road and the said Proclamations are hereby varied accordingly.

Schedule I.

Midland-Merredin-Southern Cross Road.

Town of Northam.

That portion of an existing road reserve commencing at the intersection of Chidlow Street, Northam, with the north-eastern building alignment of Peel Terrace, Northam; thence north-eastwards through the existing Railway Reserve and between Northam Town Lots 63 and 64 (Chidlow Street) to the southern boundary of lot 14, Northam Suburban Lot N3.

Thence south-eastward along York Road, Northam, to the prolongation of the eastern boundary of Lot 112, Avon Location P1, to the southern boundary of part Lot 7, Avon Location P1.

Schedule II.

Midland-Merredin-Southern Cross Road.

Town of Northam.

That portion of Road Reserve commencing at the prolongation of the eastern building line of Chidlow Street, northward over Peel Terrace, Northam; thence eastward along Peel Terrace and Yilgarn Avenue to a line joining the north-east corner of lot 33 to the south-west corner of Lot 14, Part Avon Location P1.

Schedule III.

Midland-Merredin-Southern Cross Road.

Town of Northam.

A strip of land 1 chain wide, north-west of a prolongation of the north-western boundary of lot 5, Avon Location P1, to the north-east corner of lot 33 (L.T.O. Plan 1863) between the southern building line of York Road and the northern building line of Yilgarn Avenue, Northam, and being portions of Railway Reserve, and lots 112, 14 and 113 on L.T.O. Plan 1863.

WHEREAS by The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1963, it is provided that subject to the provisions of the Act, the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council does hereby empower the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

- (c) the whole of each of them applies to the whole of each of the municipal districts set out in the First Schedule hereto; and
- (d) the whole of each of them applies to those portions specified in each of the districts set out in the Second Schedule.
