### Fisheries Act, 1905-1964. PROCLAMATION

EL.S.J Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-Most Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Com-monwealth of Australia.

F.D. 166/21; Ex. Co. No. 2184. IN pursuance of the provisions of section 10 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1964, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do

hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever by means of fishing nets in any of the portions of Western Australian waters as specified in the schedule hereto for a period of five years from the date of publication of this Proclamation in the Government Gazette.

### Schedule.

- (1) All that portion of Western Australian waters known as "The Deadwater" situated in Sussex Location No. 11.
- All the waters of those portions of Wonnerup Inlet, Wonnerup Estuary and the Indian Ocean contained within the area bounded by lines starting from a point on the high water mark of the Indian Ocean situate north of the northern corner of Wonnerup Town Lot 64 and extending south-easterly to the intersection of a north-eastern shore of Wonnerup Estuary with the north-western side of Road Number 1291; thence south-westerly along that side to the southern shore of Wonnerup Estuary; thence generally south-westerly along that shore and the right bank of Wonnerup Inlet to the north-eastern side of Road Number 12828; thence north-westerly along that side to the left bank of Wonnerup Inlet; thence north-north-easterly to a point on the high water mark of the Indian Ocean aforesaid situate north of the northern corner of lot 26 and thence north-easterly to the starting point. northern corner of Wonnerup Town Lot 64 and and thence north-easterly to the starting point.

Public Plans Wonnerup Townsite 4133/40.

The Proclamation dated 30th June, 1960, and published in the Government Gazette (No. 57) of 8th July, 1960, is hereby revoked.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 10 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1964, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever by means of fishing nets in any of the portions of Western Australian waters specified in the schedule hereto for a period of five years as from the date of publication of this Proclamation in the Government Gazette.

### Schedule.

- (1) The whole of the waters of the Capel River, with its tributaries.
- (2) The waters of Geographe Bay, near Wonnerup Inlet, extending one-quarter of a mile north and south of the entrance to Wonnerup Inlet and extending seawards one-quarter of a mile measured rectangularly from the foreshore.
- (3) All that portion of Western Australian waters known as Yallingup Bay, starting from the point of high-water mark at the Rocky Point half-a-chain south of the mouth of the Yallingup Brook; thence into the water a quarter of a mile; thence north-easterly to a point a quarter of a mile from the north-west corner of Government Reserve No. 8427A; thence easterly to the point of high water mark on the foreshore and back to the point of commencement.

### Factories and Shops Act, 1963-1964. PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided (inter alia), by section 59 of the Factories and Shops Act, 1963-1964, that the occupier of a factory shall allow to any person

employed in the factory a half holiday on any day proclaimed to be a half holiday in the district or locality in which the factory is situate and, by section 95 of that Act, that every shop, except an exempted shop and small shop, shall be closed, and a shopkeeper shall allow each shop assistant a half holiday on any day that is proclaimed to be a helf holiday that is proclaimed to be a half holiday that is applicable to the area in which the shop is situate; and whereas it appears to me, the Governor, expedient that a half holiday should be proclaimed for the day and place hereinafter appearing: Now therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council do hereby proclaim the after-noon of Wednesday, the 27th day of October, 1965, to be a half holiday, within the municipal district of, and applicable to the area of, the Shire of Moora.

### Constitution Act, 1889-1963.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1060/58.

WHEREAS section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1889-1963, provides that the Governor in Council may vest in Heads of Departments, or other offimay vest in Heads of Departments, or other offi-cers or persons within the State, power to make minor appointments, and whereas it is desirable that power of appointment of foremen and other persons employed at a daily rate of wage on works under the control of the Department of Public Works, and of Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage (exclusive of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Department) should be vested in Gerald Joseph Clarke, and that the power vested in Frank Falconer should that the power vested in Frank Falconer should be revoked: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice of the Execu-tive Council hereby vests in Gerald Joseph Clarke the appointment of foremen and all other persons employed on such works at a daily rate of wage; and doth hereby revoke the power vested in Frank Falconer.

# Land Act, 1933-1963.

### ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient, as follows:

Corres. 3682/07 .- That Reserve No. 27841-Canning Location 1993, should vest in and be held by the Shire of Gosnells in trust for the purpose of "Youth Centre".

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforemen-tioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purpose aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers re-served to him by section 37 of the said Act.

### Land Act. 1933-1963. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 2442/19, V2.

WHEREAS by Section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1963, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of sub-leasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 22672 at Harvey should vest in and be held by the Shire of Harvey in trust for the purpose of Recreation and Golf Links: Now, there-fore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Harvey in trust for Recreation and Golf Links with power to the said Shire of Harvey subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said Reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease.

### Forests Act. 1918-1954. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 574/61; L. and S. 3170/61.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:---

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;
- (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 8th day of November, 1961, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown land as State Forest No. 27 by excising that por-tion of such State Forest as is described in the schedule hereto.

Metropolitan Main Drainage.

Kewdale Marshalling Yards and Industrial

Area. Mills Street Drain.

Ewing Street Branch-Welshpool.

The construction of (a) an excavated compensating basin and (b) a reinforced concrete pipe drain of 21 inch and 30 inch diameter. (a) and (b) together with all things necessary for the undertaking and as shown on plan M.W.S.S. & D.B. W.A. No. 9287.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 22nd day of October, 1965.

# Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1963. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 487054/65.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1963, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metro-politan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections and esti-mates in respect of the works hereinafter menmates in respect of the works hereinatter men-tioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act namely:

Metropolitan Main Drainage.

Shire of Bayswater.

The construction of a gravity pipe drain approximately 400 feet in length between Beechboro Road and Avenell Road, complete with all other apparatus necessary for the undertaking, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 9314.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 22nd day of October, 1965.

# Local Government Act, 1960. City of Perth.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 1088/63.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 688 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that where through an impediment or accidental omission anything required to be done by or under this Act is not done, or is not done within the prescribed time, manner, or form, the Governor, for the purpose of giving effect to the intention and purposes of this Act, may by Order take such measures as are necessary for rectifying the omission or removing the impediment and may validate anything which has been done otherwise than in the prescribed time, manner, or form; and whereas the Council of the City of Perth has, on the 10th day of July, 1965, conducted a sale of land set out in the schedule hereto, under the provisions of sub-division 'C' of Division 6 of Part XXV of the Local Government Act; and whereas the Council has accidentally omitted to advertise the sale of land in the Government Gazette, as required by section 584 subsection 1 of that Act and to deliver a memorial of the advertisement to the Registrar of Titles in accordance with subsection 3 of section 584 of the Local Government Act: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power aforesaid doth hereby validate the sale of land as shown in the schedule hereto.
