WHEREAS by section 31 of the Land Act, 1933-1965, the Governor may, by Proclamation and subject to such conditions as may be expressed therein, classify as of Class "A" any lands of the Crown reserved to Her Majesty for any of the purposes specified in the said section; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Hay Location 2276 as an addition to Class "A" Reserve 849 (Hay Location 2090) should be classified as of Class "A": Now, 2090) should be classified as of Class "A": Now, therefore, I, the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council do by this my Proclamation classify as of Class "A" Hay Location 2276 and establish the area of the said Class "A" Reserve as about 629 acres 3 roods 11 perches. AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, on the 6th day of April, 1966, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:-

> Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1965. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

W.C.B. 447/65.

WHEREAS it is enacted, inter alia, by section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1965, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister a policy of insurance for the full amount of the liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an employer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all payments to become due under such liability, the Governor may, by Order in Council, exempt such employer from the operation of that section; and whereas the Dampier Mining Company Limited of 37 Saint George's Terrace, Perth, being an employer within the meaning of the section has, duly, in accordance with the Act and the regulations made thereunder, made application for exemption from the operation of the section, and has satisfied the Minister that it has established a fund for insurminister that it has established a fund for insurance against the said liability, and has deposited at the Treasury a security, to wit, a bond for ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), charged with all payments to become due under the said liability: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, dath hereby exempt the Dampier Mining Company doth hereby exempt the Dampier Mining Company Limited from the operation of section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1965, for a period terminating on the 31st day of October, 1967.

Corres. 3248/58.—That Reserve No. 25164 (Jerramungup Lot 24) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Gnowangerup, in trust for the purpose of "Municipal Purposes."

Corres. 1841/06.—That Reserve (Williams Location 15395) should vest in and be held by The Fauna Protection Advisory Committee of Western Australia in trust for the purpose of "Conservation of Flora and Fauna."

Corres. 1811/22.—That Reserve No. 20960 (New-

degate Lots 69 and 88) should vest in and be held by the Shire of Lake Grace, in trust for the purpose of "Recreation."

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserves shall vest in and be held by the aforementioned bodies, in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Land Act, 1933-1965. ORDER IN COUNCIL.
