### Evidence Act, 1906-1966. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas TO WIT, DOUGLAS ANTHONY KENDREW, Governor. EL.S.J WITHEDEAS, it is associated with the state of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section two of the Evidence Act Amendment Act, 1966, that the Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation; and whereas under section seventythree V of the Act, the Governor may by Proclamation except any document or class of documents specified in the Proclamation from the provisions of the Division of the Act contained in sections 73A to 73V of the Act: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix the 1st day of February, 1967, as the date on which the Evidence Act Amendment Act, 1966 shall come into operation, and do except from the provisions of the abovementioned Division all Wills, codicils and other testamentary documents sought to be proved, and all documents of, or purporting to be of, a testamentary nature, lodged or required to be lodged in connection with applications for grants of representation to the estates of deceased persons.

Reserve No. 28401 (Geikie Gorge) for the pur-pose of "National Park" being a strip of land, two miles wide, having as its centre the centre line of the Fitzroy River, extending southerly from an east-west line passing through survey mark C.54 A.F.93 and containing an area of about 7,750 acres. ### ORDER IN COUNCIL

Corres. 4753/65.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1965, it is *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor to direct that any land reserved pur-suant to the provisions of the Act shall be leased for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid, by Instrument of Lease in the form of the Fourth Schedule of the Act to any person (as defined in the said Section); and whereas it is deemed expedient that Swan Location 7980, being portion of Esserve No. 28400 (Swan Locations 7977) portion of Reserve No. 28400 (Swan Locations 7979 portion of Reserve No. 28400 (Swan Locations 7979) and 7980), shall be leased for a term of four years to the Commonwealth of Australia, to be held in trust for the purpose of "Migrant Hostel": now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the portion of abovementioned reserve shall be leased to the Commonwealth of Australia, to be held in trust for the purpose of "Migrant Hostel", for a term of four years at a peppercorn rental. ### Land Act, 1933-1965. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 688/32.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1965, it is *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 23407 (Port Hedland Lot 226) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to The Roman Catholic Bishop of Geraldton, to be held in trust for "Church Purposes (Roman Catholic)": Now, therefore, His Excellency, the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Evecutive Council doth hereby direct that the the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the aforesaid body, to be held in trust for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the conditions that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1964, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.
- (b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal, dated the 13th day of October, 1965, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before

Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown land as State Forests Nos. 14 and 37 by excising those portions of such State Forests as are described in the Schedule hereto.
