WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsection (3) of section 30 of the Marketing of Potatoes Act, 1946-1966, that the Western Australian Potato Marketing Board may deduct from the proceeds of the sale of potatoes, or, as the case may be, from progress or final payments made by it, such portion thereof but not exceeding one and a half per centum thereof, as the Governor by Proclamation from time to time declares to be paid into a reserve fund to be maintained by the said Board pursuant to that paragraph: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred on me by the said Act and section 11 of the Interpretation Act, 1918-1962, do hereby declare that, on and after the 1st day of February, 1967, the amount of the deduction from the proceeds of the sale of potatoes, or as the case may be, from progress or final payments made by the said Board, shall be three-quarters of one per centum thereof.

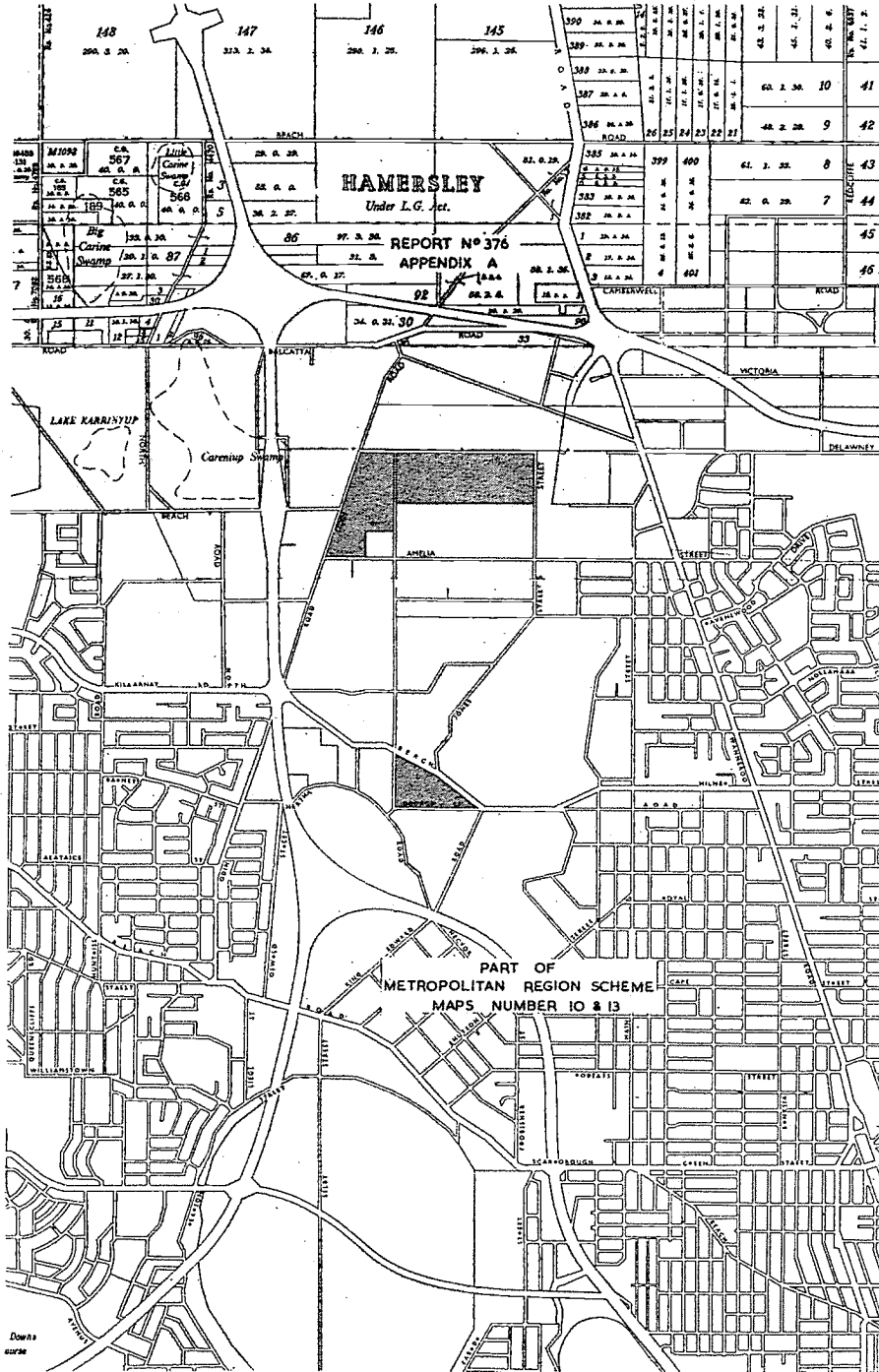
