WHEREAS by section 18 of the Native Welfare Act, 1963, it is provided that the Governor is empowered by proclamation to declare any Crown Lands to be a Reserve for Natives; and whereas it is now deemed desirable that a Reserve for Natives should be declared at Moolyella, Marble Bar: Now, therefore, I, the said Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby declare all that portion of land, being De Gray location to be a Reserve for Natives. (Reserve No. A28380.)

Main Roads Act, 1930-1966. Declaration of Main Road. PROCLAMATION.

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT, DOUGLAS ANTHONY KENDREW, Governor.

IL.S.1 By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

M.R.D. 49/45-2.

WHEREAS by section 13 of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1966, it is enacted that the Governor may on the recommendation of the Commissioner, declare by proclamation that any road shall be a main

road and may, in like manner and on the like recommendation, declare that any main road shall cease to be a main road; and whereas the Governor, by Proclamations, published in the Government Gazettes of the 12th day of October, 1928, and 11th day of November, 1938, declared, inter alia, that the road described in Schedules I and II, respectively, hereto shall be a main road; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the portion of the said road described in Schedules I and II shall cease to be a Main Road and that the portion of the said road described in Schedule III hereto shall be a Main Road: Now therefore, I, the said Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in the exercise of the power conferred by the said Act, do hereby declare that the portion of the Midland Junction-Merredin-Southern Cross Road described in Schedules I and II hereto, heretofore declared to be a main road as a special solutions. road as aforesaid, shall cease to be a main road and that the portion of the Midland Junction-Merredin-Southern Cross Road, as aforesaid and described in Schedule III hereto shall be a main road within the meaning of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1966, that the footpaths, if any, of such road be excluded from the main road and that the said Proclamation is hereby varied accordingly.

Schedule I.

Midland Junction-Merredin-Southern Cross Road. Shire of Merredin.

That portion of public road commencing at the western boundary of the Townsite of Merredin; thence following the Railway line through the townsite to the southern boundary of Reserve 14803, crossing the Northam-Goomalling-Merredin Railway at this point and continuing through Reserve 14803 to the junction of King Street and Barrack Street No. 5277; thence continuing in an easterly direction along Barrack Street, Road No. 5277 as shown on Plan No. M.R.D. W.A. 424.

Schedule II.

Midland Junction-Merredin-Southern Cross Road. Shire of Merredin.

That portion of a public road commencing at the intersection of Barrack Street and Hunt Street within the Townsite of Merredin; thence north-easterly along the said Hunt Street to its junction with Mary Street; thence easterly through lot 167 and northeastly through Reserve No. 13138 and Reserve No. 18469 to junction with Road No. 5062; thence easterly and southeasterly along the said Road No. 5062 to junction with the northern side of the Eastern Goldfields Railway at the southwestern corner of Avon Location 24301, as shown on Plan M.R.D. W.A. 920.

Schedule III.

Midland Junction-Merredin-Southern Cross Road.
Shire of Merredin.

Commencing at a point, approximately 9 chains from the westernmost boundary of the Merredin Townsite, within the existing declared road, on the northern boundary of the existing Eastern Goldfields Railway Reserve, thence continuing along and across the said Railway Reserve in a southeasterly direction to approximately the intersection of Todd and Solomon Streets, thence in a general easterly direction along Todd Street, crossing the southern branch of the said Railway Reserve, thence continuing along the said Todd Street and across the said Eastern Goldfields Railway Reserve to a road reserve on the southern boundary of Reserve 22639, thence continuing in an easterly direction along the said Road Reserve to rejoin the existing declared road at a point on the eastern boundary of the Merredin Townsite—Lands Department Litho Merredin Townsite, and Main Roads Department Plan No. 920.

Constitution Act, 1899.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.R. 3/67.

WHEREAS the enactment countained in section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1899, by which the appointment of all public officers under the Government of the State is vested in the Governor in Council does not apply to minor appointments, which by Order in Council are vested in Heads of Departments or other officers or persons within the State; and whereas it is desirable that the appointment of foremen and all other persons employed at a daily rate of wage on works under the control of the Commissioner of Main Roads should be vested in the officer whose name is set out in the attached schedule: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby vests in the officer named in the attached schedule and any person or persons appointed to temporarily act in their place, the appointment of foremen and all persons employed on such works at a daily rate of wages.

Local Government Act, 1960. ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act, 1960, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request by a Council of a Municipal District, by Order published in the Government Gazette to declare any lands reserved or acquired for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way. public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control, and management of the Council, or lands

comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street of which the public has had uninterrupted use for a period of not less than ten years, as a public street and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriageway and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Councils mentioned in the schedule hereunder have requested that certain lands named and described in the said schedule, which have been reserved for streets within the said Councils, be declared public streets: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be public streets, and such land shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as streets within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

Road No. 13272 (Arcadia West). Local Government Act, 1960-1966.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 584/65.

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraphs (g), (h), (i) and (j) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1966, that upon the presentation to him of a petition under the common seal of the municipality the Governor may by Order abolish wards existing in a district, create new wards in a district, describe the boundaries of the wards of a district and determine the number of offices of councillor assigned to a municipality; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section 12 of the Act that the Governor may give such directions as he thinks necessary to give effect to an alteration in the number of members or to an alteration in the number of wards; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 20 of that Act, that where the Governor exercises a power conferred by section 12, he may by Order direct who, if any, of the members whose district is affected by the exercise of the power shall go out of office and when, and may direct the holding on a day appointed by Order of an election of such members so affected, as the case requires; and whereas the Council of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle has presented a petition under its Common Seal praying that the existing wards shall be abolished, that six new wards be created being designated the North, City, East, South, Beaconsfield and Hilton Wards

respectively with boundaries as described in the Schedule hereto, that the number of offices of councillor be altered from fifteen to eighteen with three offices of councillor being assigned to each of the said wards, that the retirement of the councillors for the new wards take place in accordance with the provisions of the Act and that the boundaries of the new wards follow the lines referred to in the schedule hereto; now therefore, I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby—

- (a) abolish the existing wards of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle;
- (b) create six new wards to be known as the North, City, East, South, Beaconsfield and Hilton Wards respectively, having the boundaries described in the schedule hereto.
- (c) determine the number of offices of councillor assigned to the municipality to be eighteen, three of such offices to be assigned to each ward; and
- (d) direct that all of the existing members of the Council of the City of Fremantle shall retire from office on the 27th day of May, 1967, and further direct that on that day an election shall be held to return eighteen members of the Council.

Redivision of Wards.

North Ward.

- 1. All that portion of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle situate north-west of the Swan River
- 2. All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the northern side of Marmion Street with the eastern side of East Street, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle and extending southerly along the last mentioned side to the centre line of Ellen Street; thence southwesterly along that centre line to the centre line of Parry Street; thence northwesterly along that centre line of Edward Street; thence northwesterly along that centre line and onwards to the northwesterly side of Victoria Quay, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle aforesaid and thence generally northeasterly and southerly along that boundary to the starting point.

City Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the northwestern side of Victoria Quay situate in prolongation northwesterly of the centre line of Edward Street, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle and extending southeasterly to and along that centre line to the centre line of Parry Street; thence southeasterly along that centre line to the centre line of Ellen Street; thence northeasterly along that centre line to the eastern side of East Street; thence generally southerly along that side and the eastern side of Swanbourne Street to the centre line of Stephens Street; thence southwesterly along that centre line to the centre line of Hampton Road; thence northwesterly along that centre line to the centre line of Alma Street; thence generally southwesterly along that centre line to the centre line of South Terrace; thence southeasterly along that centre line to the centre line of Howard Street; thence southwesterly along that centre line and onwards to the Low Water Mark of the Indian Ocean, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle aforesaid and thence generally northwesterly and generally northeasterly along that boundary to the starting point.

East Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the eastern side of Carrington Street with the northern side of Sainsbury Road, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle and extending westerly in prolongation westerly of the northern side of Sainsbury Road aforesaid to the centre line of Carrington Street aforesaid; thence generally southerly along that centre line to the centre line of Samson Street; thence westerly along that centre line to the centre line of Wood Street; thence southerly along that centre line to the centre line of South Street; thence westerly along that centre line to the centre line of Hampton Road; thence generally northerly along that centre line to the centre line of Stephens Street; thence northeasterly along that centre line to the eastern side of Swanbourne Street; thence generally northerly along that side and the eastern side of East Street to the northern side of Marmion Street, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle aforesaid and thence generally easterly and generally southerly along that boundary to the starting point.

South Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the Low Water Mark of the Indian Ocean situate in prolongation southwesterly of the centre line of Howard Street, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle and extending northeasterly to and along that centre line to the centre line of South Terrace; thence northwesterly along that centre line to the centre line of Alma Street; thence generally northeasterly along that centre line to the centre line of Hampton Road; thence generally southerly along that centre line to the centre line of South Street; thence easterly along that centre line to the centre line of Edmund Street; thence southerly along that centre line to the centre line of Lefroy Road; thence westerly along that centre line to the centre line of Livingstone Street; thence southerly along that centre line and onwards to the southeastern boundary of part of Cockburn Sound Location 128, as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 12209; thence southwesterly along that boundary and onwards to the centre line of Hampton Road aforesaid; thence generally southerly along that centre line to the northern alignment of Road No. 1716, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle aforesaid and westerly and generally no thence generally northerly along boundary to the starting point.

Beaconsfield Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the northern alignment of Road No. 1716 with the centre line of Hampton Road, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle and extending generally northerly along that centre line to a point situate in prolongation southwesterly of the southeastern boundary of part of Cockburn Sound Location 128, as shown on Land Titles Office Diagram 12209; thence northeasterly to and along that boundary to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the centre line of Livingstone Street;thence northerly along that centre line to the centre line of Lefroy Road; thence easterly along that centre line to the centre line of Edmund Street; thence northerly along that centre line to the centre line of South Street; thence easterly along that centre line to the centre line of Wood Street; thence northerly along that centre line to the centre line of Samson Street; thence easterly along that centre line to the centre line of Carrington Street; thence southerly along that centre line to the centre line of South Street aforesaid; thence easterly along that centre line to the centre line of Hines Road; thence southerly along that centre line to its intersection with the centre line of Rennie Crescent North; thence southerly passing through Cockburn Sound Location 1693 (Reserve 23530) to the intersection of Rennie Crescent South with the centre line of Grigg Place; thence southerly along the last mentioned centre line to the northern side of

Winterfold Road, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle aforesaid and thence generally westerly along that boundary to the starting point.

Hilton, Ward.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the northern side of Winterfold Road with the centre line of Grigg Place, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle and extending northerly along that centre line to its intersection with the centre line of Rennie Crescent South; thence northerly passing through Cockburn Sound Location 1693 (Reserve 23530) to the intersection of the centre line of Rennie Crescent North with the centre line of Hines Road; thence northerly along the last mentioned centre line to the centre line of South Street; thence westerly along that centre line to the centre line of Carrington Street; thence generally northerly along that centre line to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the northern side of Sainsbury Road; thence easterly to the intersection of the northern side of Carrington Street aforesaid with the eastern side of Carrington Street aforesaid, a point on the boundary of the Municipality of the City of Fremantle aforesaid and thence generally easterly, southerly and westerly along that boundary to the starting point.

Local Government Act, 1960. Shire of Tableland. Appointment of Commissioner. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is provided in section 31 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that where a Municipality has no Council the Governor may, by Order, appoint such person as he thinks fit to be a Commissioner of a Municipality; and whereas the Municipality of the Shire of Tableland has not sufficient members holding office to form a quorum; and whereas it is considered expedient to appoint a Commissioner to administer the affairs of the district: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby appoint Reginald Clarence Paust, Secretary for Local Government, to be Commissioner of the Municipality of the Shire of Tableland as from the 2nd day of March, 1967.

Local Government Act, 1960. Shire of Mandurah. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

 $L.G.\ 86/67.$

WHEREAS the Council of the Shire of Mandurah is desirous, under the by-law making power conferred by section 193 of the Local Government Act, 1960, of making bylaws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in the sea and estuarine waters adjoining though outside its district for a distance of two hundred (200) yards from low water mark at ordinary spring tides; and whereas it is enacted by subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of that section, that such by-laws may be made only pursuant to an order made under sub-section (8) of section 190 of the Act; and whereas it is enacted by the subsection lastmentioned, that where in the opinion of the Governor a by-law making power conferred by the Act on a Council should be extended to areas which are outside the district, the Governor may by order declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the power the areas are to be regarded as being within the district and that the Council may exercise the power in respect of the areas as if in fact they were within the district; and whereas the Governor is of the opinion that the said by-law making power should be extended to the said areas outside the district of the said Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, pursuant to the powers conferred by subsection (8) of section 190 of the Local

Government Act, 1960, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that for the purpose of the exercise of the said by-law making power areas which are outside the district of the Shire of Mandurah, namely areas which adjoin that district and extend for a distance of two hundred (200) yards seaward and into estuarine waters from low water mark at ordinary spring tides are to be regarded as being within the district of the Shire of Mandurah, and that the Council of the Shire of Mandurah may make by-laws for regulating public bathing and the costumes of bathers and the conduct of bathers and others in respect of those areas as if in fact they were within the municipal district of the Shire of Mandurah.

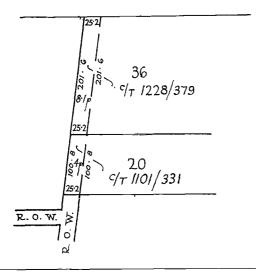
