Town of Northampton.

Declaration of the Boundaries of the Townsite of Northampton.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 372/66.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section six hundred and eighty-six of the Local Government Act, 1960, that the Governor may by Order declare land including land which is privately owned and subdivided, to be a townsite, and may vary the boundaries of a townsite; and whereas the boundaries of the Townsite of Northampton were declared by Order published in the *Government Gazette* of the 12th August, 1966; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the boundaries of the said townsite should be varied: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the power conferred by the said section six hundred and eighty-six, doth hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be the boundaries of the Townsite of Northampton.

Schedule.

Description of the Boundaries of the Townsite of Northampton.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the northwestern corner of Northampton Lot 345 and extending easterly along the northern boundary of that lot and easterly and southerly along boundaries of lot 344 to the southwestern corner of Victoria Location 1709; thence easterly along the southern boundaries of that location and location 2376 to the western boundary of location 9750; thence southerly along that boundary

and the western boundaries of locations 9751, 2425 and 259 and onwards to and along the eastern boundaries of Northampton Lots 250, 249 and 248 and again onwards to the southern side of Stephen Street; thence generally easterly and southeasterly to and along southern and southwestern sides of Road No. 6626 to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the southernmost southern boundary of location 7477; thence easterly to and along that boundary and easterly and southerly along boundaries of location 5649 and onwards to the northernmost northwestern corner of location 5332; thence southerly, westerly and again southerly along boundaries of that location to the southwestern side of Adelaide Street; thence 13 chains 76 and six-tenths links along that side; thence 249 degrees 30 minutes 5 chains 45 and four-tenths links; thence 0 degrees 35 minutes to the southern side of Adelaide Street aforesaid; thence westerly along that side to the eastern boundary of location 250; thence generally southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to the northeastern corner of location 140; thence southerly, westerly and northerly along boundaries of that location to the southern boundary of location 331; thence westerly along that boundary to a northwestern corner of location 359; thence southerly, westerly, northerly, northeasterly and again northerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the northern boundary of location 1693; thence westerly and southerly to and along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the northern boundary of location 3826; thence westerly to and along that boundary and onwards to the eastern boundary of location 326; thence northerly along eastern boundaries of that location and locations 2375, 2068 and 2379 to the northwestern corner of lot 357; thence easterly along the northern boundaries of that lot and lots 358 and 359 to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the western boundary of lot 356; thence northerly to and along that boundary and the western boundaries of lots 350 and 347 to the northwestern corner of the lastmentioned lot; thence easterly along northern boundaries of that

lot and lot 348 to the southwestern corner of lot 346 and thence northerly along western boundaries of that lot and lot 345 aforesaid to the starting point. (Public Plans Northampton Town-site; 160 D/40.)

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 293/52.

WHEREAS it is provided in paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that where the district of the Shire is divided into Wards, the number of offices of member for each Ward is such as is from time to time declared by Order; and whereas, it is further provided that on the exercise by the Governor of a power conferred by section 12, he may direct the holding, on a day appointed by the Order, of an election of such members affected as the case requires; and whereas the Shire of Ashburton is at present composed of seven members and has submitted a petition praying that the number of offices of member for the Wards be altered and adjusted by reducing the number of offices of member of the East Ward from 2 to 1 and increasing the number of offices of member of the Town Ward from 1 to 2; and whereas it is considered expedient that the prayer of the petition should be granted: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act, doth hereby—

- (a) declare that the number of offices of member of the East Ward shall be reduced from 2 to 1 and the number of offices of member of the Town Ward be increased from 1 to 2; and that the office of member of the East Ward to be abolished shall be that occupied by A. P. Paterson;
- (b) direct that an election shall be held on the 20th day of January, 1968, to return an additional member for Town Ward.

COMPANIES ACT, 1961-1966.

WHEREAS the Wales Unit Investment Limited (hereinafter called "the company") is the management company within the meaning of section 76 of the Companies Act, 1961-1966, in relation to a trust deed (hereinafter called "the Deed") constituting the Wales Second Equity Trust; and whereas application has been made by the company for exemption from compliance with certain provisions of Division 5 of Part IV of the said Act in respect of the Deed: Now, therefore, I, the undersigned, the Minister administering the said Act, do hereby exempt the company from complying with the provisions of subsection (1) of section 84 and of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 85 of the said Act on the condition that the company—

- (a) keeps or causes to be kept in the State of New South Wales a complete register of interest holders wheresoever resident at a place and in the form and manner in which such a register would be required to be kept if the Deed were an approved deed under the law of the State of New South Wales relating to companies; and
- (b) keeps at a place within three miles of the office of the Registrar of Companies in the State of Western Australia a register of interest holders resident in Western Australia and in relation to that register complies with the requirements of Section 84 of the said Act, and at such place provides reasonable accommodation and facilities for persons to inspect and take copies of that register; and
- (c) within fourteen days of the date upon which a request in that behalf is delivered to or served upon the company or made at its registered office in the State of Western Australia or at the place referred to in paragraph (b) hereof, makes a copy of the register, referred to in paragraph (a) hereof, available thereat to any holder of interests in the trust without charge and to any other person on payment of a sum not exceeding fifty cents as the company may require.

- (a) clear firebreaks at least 8 ft. wide along boundaries of your property which adjoin any trafficable road, burning of road side at least 8 ft. wide will be accepted in lieu of ploughed breaks on the adjoining land, and
- (b) clear firebreaks at least 8 ft. wide immediately around all land which is carrying established pasture or crop, and
- (c) clear of all inflammable material an area immediately surrounding all buildings and/or haystacks and the radius of that area being not less than one chain, and
- (d) either spring burn or provide a one chain firebreak round all bush country.

3. In respect of land owned or occupied by you which exceeds 10,000 acres.

- (a) Divide your property by firebreaks, not less than one chain wide, into sections not less than 10,000 acres and not greater than 15,000 acres, and
- (b) clear firebreaks at least 8 ft. wide immediately around all land which is carrying established pasture or crop, and
- (c) clear of all inflammable material an area immediately surrounding all buildings and/or haystacks and the radius of that area being not less than one chain.

The requirements of section 3 may be dispensed with provided the owner or occupier furnishes the Council with a plan, prior to 30th November, showing all the protective burning that has been carried out to that date.

If it is considered to be impractical for any reason to clear firebreaks or to remove inflammable material from the land as required by this notice, you may apply to the Council or its duly authorised officer not later than the 15th day of November, 1967, for permission to provide firebreaks in alternative positions or to take alternative action to abate fire hazards on the land. If permission is not granted by the Council or its duly authorised officer, you shall comply with the requirements of this notice.

If the requirements of this notice are carried out by burning, such burning must be in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Bush Fires Act.

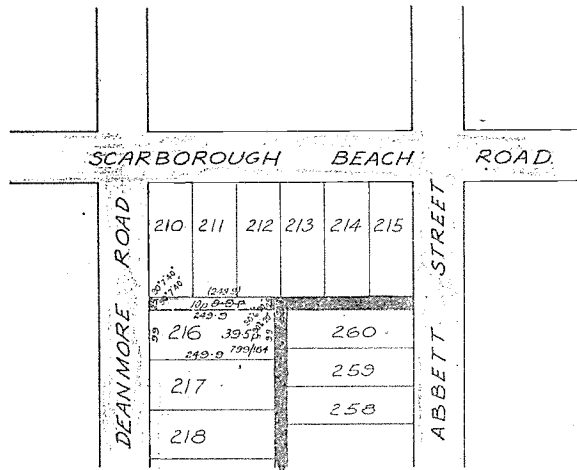
