WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (g) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that the Governor may, upon effectual presentation of a petition bearing the common seal of the municipality, alter the boundaries of Wards existing in a district; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (e) of the said subsection that the Governor may alter the name of any Ward of a Municipality; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (j) of the said subsection that the Governor may, within the limits presented by this Act, determine the number of offices of councillor assigned to a Municipality; and whereas it is further provided

by subsection 1 of section 20 of the said Act that where the Governor exercises a power conferred by section 12 he may direct who, if any, of the members whose district is affected by the exercise of the power shall go out of office and may direct the holding on a day appointed by the Order, of an election to elect members so affected; and whereas the Municipality of the Shire of Quairading has submitted a petition under its Common Seal praying for the alteration of the boundaries of the Wards and the names of the Wards; and whereas it is considered expedient to grant the prayer of the petition; now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby:—

- (1) abolish the existing Wards of the Municipality of the Shire of Quairading;
- (2) create six new wards to be known as the North-West, South-East, Central, North-East, South-West and Town respectively having the boundaries described in the Schedule hereto;
- (3) determine the number of offices of councillor assigned to the Municipality to be eleven allocated to the respective wards as follows:—

North-West Ward—2.
South-East Ward—2.
Central Ward—2.
North-East Ward—2.
South-West Ward—2.
Town Ward—1.

- (4) direct that all the existing members of the Council of the Shire of Quairading shall go out of office on the 25th May, 1968 and an election shall be held on that day to return the eleven members of the Council.
