Land Act, 1933-1967.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1967, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient, as follows:—

Corres. 12046/02.—That Reserve No. 8439 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Dardanup, in trust for the purpose of "Gravel and Rubbish Dump".

Corres. 2999/66.—That Reserve No. 28730 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Harvey, in trust for the purpose of "Recreation".

Corres. 202/68.—That Reserve No. 29028 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Upper Blackwood, in trust for the purpose of "Historical Purposes".

Corres. 230/67.—That Reserve No. 29035 should vest in and be held by the Minister for Water Supply, in trust for the purpose of "Water".

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies, in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Land Act, 1933-1967. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 5144/14, V.2.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, body corporate, or other person or

persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 15837 should vest in and be held by the Shire of West Arthur, in trust for the purpose of "Public Recreation": Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of West Arthur, in trust for Public Recreation, with power to the said Shire of West Arthur, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said Reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

(The Order in Council dated the 7th May, 1930, is hereby superseded.)

Land Act, 1933-1967. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 3713/65.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1967, it is inter alia, made lawful for the Governor by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the conditions that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall dem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 28405 (Exmouth Lot 397) should, subject as aforesaid be granted in fee simple to the Returned Services League of Australia W.A. Branch (Incorporated) to be held in trust for the purpose of "Club and Club Premises": Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice

and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the aforesaid body, to be held in trust for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the conditions that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

Local Government Act, 1960. Shire of Ravensthorpe. Division into Wards.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 630/53.

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (g) of subsection 1 of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1967 that upon the presentation to him of a petition signed by at least one-third of the persons whose names appear on the municipal roll of the municipality the Governor may by Order divide a district into wards and fix the boundaries of the wards of a district and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section 10 of the Act that where a district of a Shire is divided into wards the number of offices of member for each ward is such as is from time to time declared by Order; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 20 of that Act, that where the Governor exercises a power conferred by section 12, he may by Order direct who, if any, of the members whose district is affected by the exercise of the power shall go out of office and when, and may direct the holding on a day appointed by the Order of an election of such members so affected, as the case requires; and whereas one-third of the persons whose names appear on the Municipal roll of the Municipality of the Shire of Ravensthorpe have presented a petition praying that the district be divided into six wards being designated the Munglinup, East, South, West, North and Ravensthorpe-Elverdton Wards respectively with boundaries as described in the schedule hereto, that the number of offices of councillor be allocated one to each of the Munglinup, East, South, West and North Wards and two to the Ravensthorpe-Elverdton Wards, that the retirement of the councillors for the new wards take place in accordance with the provisions of the Act and that the boundaries of the new wards follow the lines referred to in the schedule hereto. Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby

- (a) divide the district of the Municipality of the Shire of Ravensthorpe into six new wards to be known as the Munglinup, East, South, West, North and Ravensthorpe-Elverdton Wards respectively, having the boundaries described in the schedule hereto;
- (b) determine the number of offices of councillor allocated to the wards to be as follows:—

Munglinup—(1 member).
East—(1 member).
South—(1 member).
West—(1 member).
North—(1 member).
Ravensthorpe-Elverdton—
(2 members);

(c) direct that all of the existing members of the Council of the Shire of Ravensthorpe shall retire from office on the 25th day of May, 1968, and further direct that on that day an election shall be held to return seven members of the Council.
