ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 31/56.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1967, it is, *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor by Order in Council to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of that Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the conditions that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 29079 (Kwinana Lot 101) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to the Western Australian Fire Brigades Board to be held in trust for "Fire Station Site." Corres. 823/68.—That Reserve No. 29124 should vest in and be held by the Minister for Water Supply, in trust for the purpose of "Water".

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies, in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

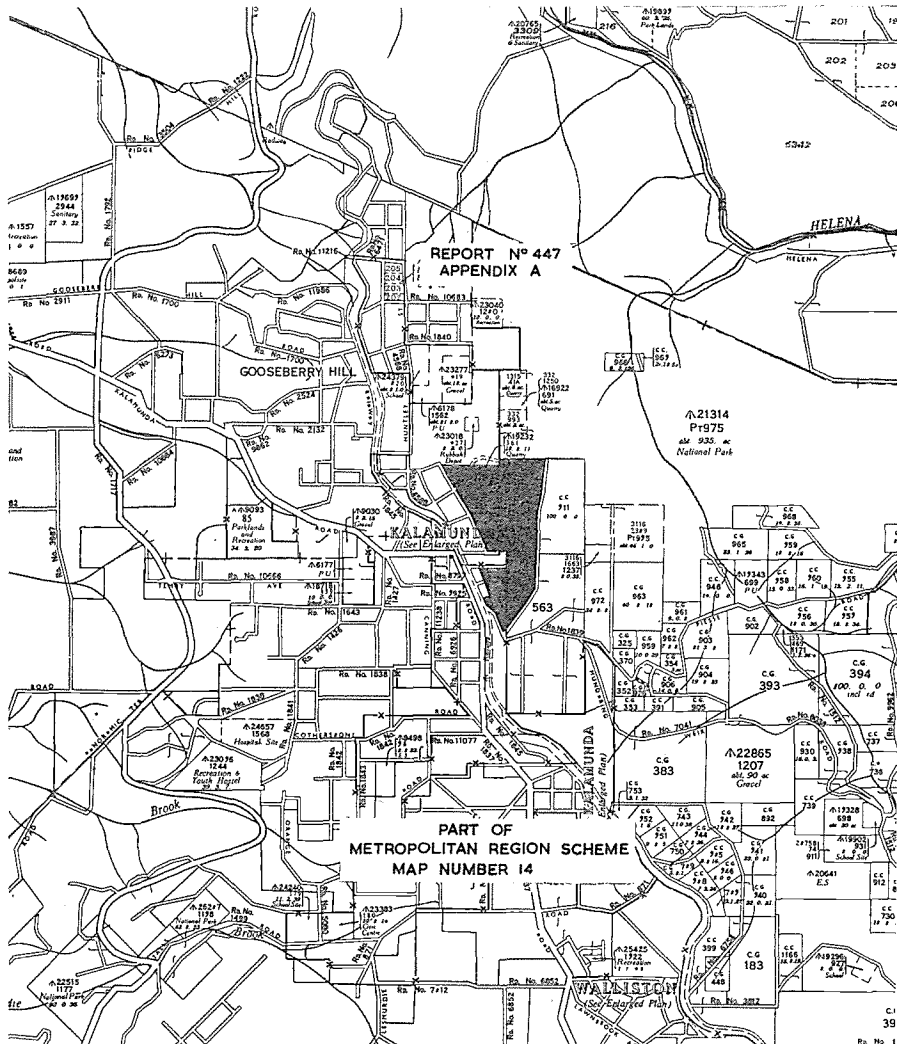

AUGUSTA SCHEME.**

Scheme Text.

1. **Responsible Authority:** The authority responsible for enforcing the observance of this Scheme is the Shire of Augusta-Margaret River (hereinafter called "the Council").
2. **Area:** The Scheme shall apply to the areas of land contained within the inner edge of a blue border on each of Plan No. 1 and Plan No. 2. The said land is hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme Area."
3. **General Objects:** The general objects of the Scheme are:—
 - (a) To improve and develop the Scheme Area to the best possible advantage.
 - (b) To make provision for the better use of the land within the Scheme Area for building purposes.
 - (c) To make better provision for roads and traffic within the Scheme Area.
 - (d) To make provision for drainage within the Scheme Area.
 - (e) To provide a basis for future subdivision of land within the Scheme Area.
4. **Works to be Carried Out:** The following works to be carried out within the Scheme Area:—
 - (a) The Scheme Area shall be re-surveyed in conformity with the design shown on Plan No. 2.

8. **Offers of lots:** The offer referred to in Clause 7 hereof shall be made in writing to each of the said owners and posted by certified post to him at his address as appearing in the Rate Book of the Council and shall specify the lot number on Plan No. 2 the subject of the offer and the old lot number on Plan No. 1 in respect of which the offer of the replacement lot is made.
9. The offer shall state the amount of money (if any) payable by the owner on the acceptance of the offer.
10. The offer shall specify a date not being less than twenty-eight days after the posting of the said offer within which the offer may be accepted.
11. 16. **Time Limit for Claims for Compensation:** Claims for compensation by reason of the operation of this Scheme shall be made within six months of this Scheme coming into operation and claims for compensation on resumption of any land shall be made within six months from the issue of a notice of resumption or the date of rescission under Clause 12, which ever is the later.
17. **Further Subdivision:** Plan No. 3 indicates a manner in which the lots on Plan No. 2 may subject to the approval of all appropriate authorities be further subdivided. Further subdivision will not be approved unless on to fully constructed drained and sealed sub-divisional roads. The Council shall not be under any obligation to carry out any additional road works required to permit further subdivision.

- (g) Carry out any road construction, drainage, improvements or other works within the Scheme Area.
- (h) Dispose of any land not required for the purposes of the Scheme.
- (i) To transfer any land acquired by it in pursuance of this Scheme whether subdivided in accordance with Plan No. 2 or Plan No. 3 as compensation or part compensation and to enter into agreements relative to the determination and settling of compensation.
- (j) Before sale of any lot or the transfer of it or portion of it as part compensation to further subdivide the land in accordance with Plan No. 3.
- (k) With the consent of the Town Planning Board to make such minor variations to the subdivisional design as the Council considers necessary.
- (l) Retain any surplus or rejected lots.
