WHEREAS by section 7 (a) of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-Water Supply, sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1967, it is provided that the Governor may, by Order in Council, alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Area, or of any Metropolitan Main Drainage District; and whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of the Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 as at present defined should be extended. Local Government Act, 1960-1967. Kojonup Regional Traffic District. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 950/67.

WHEREAS it is provided (inter alia) by section 329 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1967, that the Governor, at the request made by the Councils of two or more municipalities, may, by Order, constitute as a regional district for local government purposes, whether under that or another Act, the whole or portion of the combined area of the district of those municipalities; and shall in the order assign a name to the district and specify the number of members to be allotted to the district and to be nominated by each constituent Council; and whereas the Councils of the municipalities of the Shires of Kojonup, Cranbrook and Tambellup have made a request that the whole of their districts be constituted as a regional district for the local government purpose of the appointment, engagement and control of traffic inspectors, the prosecution of offenders against the Traffic Act, regulations and by-laws relating to traffic, the inspection of vehicles, and generally, the regulation and control of traffic under the Traffic Act, 1919-1967, exclusive only of the licensing of vehicles and of the powers and duties of a sign erecting authority within the meaning of the regulations made under the lastmentioned Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers aforesaid, doth hereby constitute as a regional district, for the local government purpose of the appointment, engagement and control of traffic inspectors, the prosecution of offenders against the Traffic Act, 1919-1967, exclusive only of the licensing of vehicles and of the powers and duties of a sign erecting authority within the meaning of the regulations made under the lastmentioned Act, the whole of the area of the Shires of Kojonup, Cranbrook and Tambellup and doth assign to the district the name "Kojonup Regional Traffic District" and specify that six members, of whom two shall be allotted to the district.
