FISHERIES ACT, 1905-1967.

Department of Fisheries and Fauna, Perth, 25th November, 1968.

IT is hereby notified for general information that the Minister for Fisheries and Fauna, acting pursuant to the provisions of section 17 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1967, has imposed in respect of fishing licenses, in addition to the conditions so imposed and notified in the Government Gazettes published on the 8th June, 1962, on the 26th July, 1963, on the 19th March, 1965, on the 22nd October, 1965 and on the 16th December, 1966, the following conditions:—

- (16) Crayfish shall not be processed on a freezer-boat before all crayfish on that boat of a length less than the legal length prescribed are returned to the ocean.
- (17) Crayfish of a length less than the legal length prescribed, taken by a freezer-boat, shall be returned to the ocean prior to the boat arriving at anchorage.
- (18) A freezer-boat shall not engage in the taking of crayfish in the waters of the Indian Ocean lying between the coastline of Western Australia and a line commencing at a point three miles due west from Robert Point at Mandurah and extending northwards to a point three miles due west from Moore Point at Geraldton, as shown in the plan hereunder, from the first day of January to the fourteenth day of August in every year as from the first day of January, 1969.
