[L.S.] Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the Transfer of Land Act, 1895-1959, the Governor is empowered by Proclamation in the Government Gazette to revest in Her Majesty as of Her former estate all or any lands, whereof Her Majesty may become the registered proprietor; and whereas Her Majesty is now the registered proprietor of the lands described in the schedules hereto: Now, therefore, I, the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation revest in Her Majesty, Her heirs, and successors, the land described in the Schedules hereto as of Her former estate.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section two of the Argentine Ant Act, 1968, that that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix the first day of January, 1969, as the date on which the Argentine Ant Act, 1968, shall come into operation.

## Rights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914-1964. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT, DUUGLAS KENDREW, Governor. [L.S.] By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 27 of the Rights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914-1964, that the Governor, without constituting any irrigation district under Part IV of the said Act, may, on the recommendation of the Minister and acting with the advice of the Commissioners appointed under subsection (4) of section 3 of the Act, at any time and from time to time by Proclamation declare that Part III of the said Act shall extend to and have effect in and throughout any portion of the State to be defined in the Proclamation, and shall apply to and have effect in relation to all rivers, streams, watercourses, lagoons, lakes, swamps or marshes situated within that portion of the State specified and defined aforesaid, but that no such declaration shall be made until after the expiration of thirty days after notice of intention to make such declaration has been given to the local authority or local authorities in or through whose district or districts such rivers, streams, watercourses, lagoons, swamps, lakes or marshes run or are situate to the intent that before the making of such declaration any objection by such local authority or local authorities may be considered; and whereas the Minister has recommended and the Commissioners have advised the Governor by Proclamation to declare that Part III of the said Act shall extend to and have effect in relation to that portion of the State that is defined in the Schedule to this Proclamation and shall apply to and have effect in relation to all rivers, streams, watercourses, lagoons, lakes, swamps, and marshes situated within that portion of the State; and whereas after due notice given the local authority or local authorities concerned have not made any objection to the proposed declaration: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Minister and with the advice of the Commissioners and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby declare that Part III of the Fights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914-1964, shall extend to and have effect in and have effect in relation to all rivers, streams, watercourses, lagoons, lakes, swamps and marshes situated within that portion of the State as defined in the Schedule hereto and shall apply to and have effect in relation to all rivers, streams, watercourses, lagoons, lakes, swamps and marshes situated within that portion of the State and which portion is, for the purposes of that Act, to be known as the Donnelly River System.

#### Schedule.

4544; thence southwesterly to the southeastern corner of location 6798; thence westerly to the northernmost northeastern corner of location 5841; thence west-northwesterly to the northeastern corner of location 9773; thence west-northwesterly to the northeastern corner of location 6277; thence southwesterly to the intersection of a northern boundary of State Forest Number 36 with the eastern side of a one chain road passing through location 11926; thence south about 121 chains; thence 220 degrees, about 286 chains to the north-eastern corner of location 6283; thence west-south-westerly to the northeastern corner of location 5450; thence southeastern corner of location westerly to the northeastern corner of location 5450; thence southerly to its southeastern corner; thence southwesterly to the southwestern corner of location 5456 and onwards to the prolongation northwesterly of the northeastern boundary of location 10051; thence southeasterly to and along that boundary to the eastern corner of that loca-tion; thence south-southeasterly to the northeast-ern corner of location 10071; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of that location to its southeastern corner; thence southwesterly to the southeastern corner; thence southwesterly to the southwestern corner of location 9122; thence south-southeasterly to the southeastern corner of location southeasterly to the southeastern corner of location 9124; thence south-southwesterly to the western corner of location 8181; thence westerly to the southeastern corner of late lease 49/91; thence southwesterly to the southeastern corner of Re-serve 9537; thence west-southwesterly through Silver Mount and onwards to the Low Water Mark of the Indian Occan aforesaid; and thence approx of the Indian Ocean aforesaid; and thence gener-ally northwesterly along that Low Water Mark to the starting point as shown on Public Works De-partment Plan W.A. 44799.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1968, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient, as follows:-

Corres. 4677/65.—That Reserve No. 29540 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale in trust for the purpose of Public Recreation.

-That Reserve No. 29542 should Corres. 2545/63.vest in and be held by the Shire of West Kimberley in trust for the purpose of Public Recreation.

Corres. 3818/68.—That Reserve No. 29561 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Denmark in trust for the purpose of Gravel.

Corres. 3947/67.-That Reserve No. 29564 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu in trust for the purpose of Camping.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforemen-tioned Reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies, in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 72/68.

Corres. 72/68. WHEREAS by Section 33 of the Land Act, 1933, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the Order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in Section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such Order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 29562 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Westonia in trust for the purpose of Aerial Landing Ground: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Westonia, in trust for Aerial Landing Ground, with power to the said Shire of Westonia, subject to the approval in writ-ing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, ing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said Re-serve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Forests Act, 1918-1964.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 323/68, L. and S. 615/06.

WHEREAS by The Forests Act, 1918-1964, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;
- (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council revoke such dedication;

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament, his proposal dated the Ninth day of Parliament, his proposal dated the Ninth day of October, 1968, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown Lands as State Forest: And whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth headby works in part the dedication of Crown doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown Land as State Forest No. 22 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the schedule hereto.

Constitution of South Coast Water Reserve.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 1241/68.

WHEREAS it is enacted under section 9 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1964 that the Governor may by Order in Council constitute a Water Reserve: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the consent of the Exceutive Council doth hereby constitute the South Coast Water Reserve as defined in the schedule hereunder, and assign the name of South Coast Water Reserve thereto.

## Schedule.

#### South Coast Water Reserve.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the high water mark of the Indian Ocean (Torbay) situate in prolongation southerly of the westernmost western boundary of Reserve 13773 and extending northerly to and along that boundary and eastern boundary of Location 3103 and onwards to the northwestern side of Road Number 2191; thence generally northeasterly and northerly along sides of that road and onwards to the southern side of the Great Southern Railway Reserve; thence generally easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the easternmost eastern boundary of Albany Town Lot 1104; thence southerly to and along that boundary and onwards to the high water mark of Princess Royal Harbour; thence generally southerly and generally southeasterly along that high water mark to a point situate in prolongation northwesterly of the northeastern boundary of Plantagenet Location 365; thence southeasterly and onwards to the high water mark of the Indian Ocean aforesaid and thence generally north westerly along that high water mark of the Indian Ocean aforesaid and thence generally north westerly along that high water mark to the starting point, as shown bordered blue on Plan P.W.D., W.A. 45045-1-1.

#### Local Government Act, 1960-1968.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

L.G. 884/62.

WHEREAS by Order in Council made under section 329 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1968 the whole of the area of the districts of the Town of Kalgoorlie and the Shire of Kalgoorlie were constituted as a regional district under the name "Kalgoorlie Regional Traffic District" for the local government purpose of the regulation and control of traffic, under the Traffic Act, 1919 (exclusive of the licensing of vehicles), and six members, of whom three are nominated by each constituent council, were allotted to the district; and whereas it is provided, *inter alia*, by subsection (2a) of section 329 of the Local Government, Act 1960-1968, that the Governor, on the application of a regional council and the council of a municipality that desires to be added to the regional district, may by Order in Council vary the constitution of the regional district by the addition thereto of the municipal district in respect of which the application is made; and whereas it is provided, *inter alia*, by subsection (2) of that section that the Governor may by Order in Council vary the number of members to be allotted to a regional district and the number of members to be nominated by each constituent council; and whereas the council of the Kalgoorlie Regional Traffic District and the Coolgardie Shire Council have applied for the addition to the Kalgoorlie Regional Traffic District of the municipal district of the Shire of Coolgardie: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby vary the constitution of the Kalgoorlie Regional Traffic District by the addition thereto of the municipal district of the Shire of Coolgardie and doth specify that seven members shall be allotted to the district, of whom three shall be nominated by the Kalgoorlie Town Council, three by the Kalgoorlie Shire Council, and one by the Coolgardie Shire Council, in lieu of the numbers previously allotted and specified.

#### Shire of Victoria Plains.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L. G. 288/57.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 433A of the Local Government Act, 1960, that the Governor may, inter alia, make and publish in the Government Gazette uniform general by-laws for all or any of the purposes for which by-laws may be made by a Council under Part XV of that Act, and, by order, declare that all or any such uniform general by-laws as are specified in the Order shall apply to the whole or any portion of a district so specified; and whereas the Governor has so made and published the uniform general by-laws hereinafter in this Order appearing; Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers aforesaid, doth hereby declare that the whole of each of the uniform general bylaws published in the Government Gazette on the 15th October, 1965, and amendments thereto, published in the Government Gazette from time to time thereafter shall apply to all townsites in the district of the Shire of Victoria Plans.

Local Government Act, 1960-1968.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 190/68.

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraphs (g), (h), (i) and (j) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that upon the presentation to him of a petition under the Common Seal of the municipality the Governor may by Order abolish wards existing in a district, create new wards in a district, describe the boundaries of the wards of a district and determine the number of offices of councillor assigned to a municipality; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section 12 of the Act that the Governor may give such directions as he thinks necessary to give effect to an alteration in the number of members or to an alteration in the number of wards; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 20 of that Act, that where the Governor exercises a power conferred by section 12, he may by Order direct who, if any, of the members whose district is affected by the exercise of the power shall go out of office and when, and may direct the holding on a day appointed by the Order of an election of such members so affected, as the case requires; and whereas the Council of the Municipality of the Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup has presented a petition under its Common Seal praying that the existing wards shall be abolished, that nine new wards be created being designated the Badgeminnup, Nyabing, Kuringup, North, Central, Mindarabin, Kwobrup, South and Cairlocup Wards respectively with boundaries as described in the Scheedule hereto, that the number of offices of councillor be altered from seven to nine with the number of offices of councillor allocated one to each of the nine wards, and that the retirement of the councillors for the new wards take place in accordance with the provisions of the Act: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby—

- (a) abolish the existing wards of the Municipality of the Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup;
- (b) create nine new wards to be known as the Badgeminnup, Nyabing, Kuringup, North, Central, Mindarabin, Kwobrup, South and Cairlocup Wards respectively, having the boundaries described in the Schedule hereto;
- (c) determine the number of offices of councillor allocated in the municipality to be one member for each of the nine wards; and
- (d) direct that all of the existing members of the Council of the Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup except those for the Badgeminnup and Central Wards shall retire from office on the 24th day of May, 1969, and further direct that on that day an election shall be held to return seven members of the Council.

## Technical Description.

#### Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup. Re-division of Wards.

### Badgeminnup Ward:

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the northwestern corner of Williams Location 11420, a point on the boundary of the Shire of Nyabing-Pingrup and extending generally southerly along western boundaries of that location and Locations 11419, 11523 and 11524 to the northwestern corner of Location 11278; thence easterly and southerly along boundaries of that location and southerly along the eastern boundary of Location 9762 and onwards to the northern boundary of Kojonup Location 6186; thence easterly along that boundary and easterly and southerly along boundaries of Location 7792 to the southeastern corner of the lastmentioned location; thence southerly along boundaries of Location 7292 and onwards to the northern boundary of Location 6186 aforesaid and southerly, easterly and again southerly along boundaries of Location 7292 and onwards to the northern boundary of Location 8516; thence easterly, southerly, generally southwesterly and westerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the western boundary of Location 5295; thence southerly and easterly to and along boundaries of that location to the northwestern corner of Location 5565; thence southerly along the boundaries of that location and Location 7645 and onwards to the northern boundary of Location 6173; thence westerly and southerly along the eastern boundary of Location 7484 and onwards to the northeastern boundary of Location 7531; thence southeasterly along that boundary

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraphs (g), (h), (i) and (j) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960, that upon the presentation to him of a petition under the Common Seal of the municipality the Governor may by Order abolish wards existing in a district, create new wards in a district, describe the boundaries of the wards of a district and determine the number of offices of councillor assigned to a municipality; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section 12 of the Act that the Governor may give such directions as he thinks necessary to give effect to an alteration in the number of members or to an alteration in the number of members or to an alteration in the number of wards; and whereas it is further provided in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 20 of that Act, that where the Governor exercises a power conferred by section 12, he may by Order direct who, if any, of the members whose district is affected by the exercise of the power shall go out of office and when, and may direct the holding on a day appointed by the Order of an election of such members so affected, as the case requires; and whereas the Council of the Municipality of the Shire of Perth has presented a petition under its Common Seal praying that the existing wards shall be abolished, that seven new wards be created being designated the Hamersley, Scarborough, Osborne, Lawley, Inglewood, Balga and Maylands Wards respectively with boundaries as described in the Schedule hereto, that the number of offices of councillor be altered from eleven to thirteen with the number of offices of councillor allocated two to each of the Hamersley, Scarborough, Osborne, Lawley, Inglewood and hat the retirement of the councillors for the new wards take place in accordance with the provisions of the Act: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby—

(a) abolish the existing wards of the Municipality of the Shire of Perth;

- (b) create seven new wards to be known as the Hamersley, Scarborough, Osborne, Lawley, Inglewood, Balga and Maylands Wards respectively, having the boundaries described in the Schedule hereto;
- (c) determine the number of offices of councillor allocated to the municipality to be thirteen, to be as follows:—
  Hamersley (2 Members), Scarborough (2 Members), Osborne (2 Members), Lawley (2 Members), Inglewood (2 Members),

Balga (2 Members), Maylands (1 Member),

and

(d) direct that all of the existing members of the Council of the Shire of Perth shall retire from office on the 24th day of May, 1969, and further direct that on that day an election shall be held to return thirteen members of the Council.
