Fauna Conservation Act, 1950-1967.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT, TO WIT, BOUGLAS KENDREW, Governor.

[L.S.] Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

F.D. 49/48.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Fauna Conservation Act, 1950-1967, I the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare as follows:—

- (1) That the period from five o'clock in the forenoon of January 1, 1969, until seven o'clock in the afternoon of December, 31, 1970, shall be an open season in respect of those species of wild ducks specified in the First Schedule hereto in those parts of the State which lie within the boundaries of the Kimberley, North-West and Eastern Divisions, as defined in section 28 of the Land Act, 1933, with the exception of those areas defined in the Second Schedule hereto.
- (2) That a person shall not take any wild duck or the egg of any wild duck for the purpose of keeping it in captivity, or for the purpose of aviculture, or for the purpose of sale.
- (3) That a person shall not sell any wild duck.

- (4) That a person shall not take any wild duck by any means other than a shotgun provided that this restriction shall not prohibit a person who is a native within the meaning of the Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954, from using any native artifact in the taking of wild ducks.
- (5) That a person shall not take or attempt to take wild ducks from any boat, raft, launch or other type of boat which is powered by any type of motor or engine or which is propelled or towed by any means other than by hand nor shall he use in any manner whatsoever such boat, raft, launch or other type of boat in the taking of any wild ducks.

First Schedule.

Whistling Tree-duck (Dendrocygna arcuata). Plumed Tree-duck (Dendrocygna eytoni). Mountain Duck (Tadorna tadornoides). Black Duck (Anas superciliosa). Chestnut Teal (Anas castanea).
Grey Teal (Anas gibberifrons).
Blue-winged Shoveler (Anas rhynchotis). Pink-eared Duck (Malacorhynchus membranaceus). Freckled Duck (Stitctonetta naevosa). White-eyed Duck (Aythya australis). Blue-billed Duck (Oxyura australis). Musk Duck (Biziura lobata). Wood Duck or Maned Goose (Chenonetta jubata). Pied or Magpie Goose (Anseranas semipalmata).

Second Schedule.

The whole of Reserve 1058 and all land and water within 200 chains of the boundaries of that reserve as shown on Public Plan 1054/80, including the land and waters known as Parry Lagoons, Police Hole and Jogalong Billabongs.

Land Act, 1933-1968. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1968, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any

Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the Order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such Order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 23776 should vest in and be held by the Minister for Mines in trust for the purpose of Explosive Magazine: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Minister for Mines in trust for Explosive Magazine with power to the said Minister for Mines to lease the whole or any portion of the said Reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Local Government Act, 1960-1968.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L. & S. 2799/62 (MR 600), M.R.D. 1174/62.

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1968, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request by a Council of a Municipal District, by Order published in the Government Gazette to declare any lands reserved or acquired for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control, and management of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street of which the public has had uninterrupted use for a period of not less than ten years, as a public street and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriageway and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Shire of Meekatharra has requested that certain lands named and described in the schedule hereunder, which have been reserved for a street within its municipal district be declared a public street: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be a public street, and such land shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a street within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.




