ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 357/65.

WHEREAS it is provided in subsection (2) of section 12 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1970, that the Governor may, upon effective presentation of a Petition under the Common Seal of each Municipality which will be affected by an Order, alter and adjust the boundaries of adjoining districts; and whereas the Municipalities of the Shires of Kalamunda and Canning have submitted a joint petition praying that the boundaries between the said two adjoining districts should be altered and adjusted; and whereas it is considered expedient that the prayer of the petition should be granted: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby alter and adjust the boundaries of the districts of the Municipalities of the Shires of Kalamunda and Canning as set out in the Schedule hereto.



 - (a) by substituting for the words "A departure signal cancel plunger is also provided in the locked box" in lines fifteen and sixteen of sub-rule (1b) of rule 245, the words "A departure signal cancel plunger which is locked by a standard padlock is also provided in the traffic annex at each end of a crossing loop";
 (b) by adding after the passage "plunger." in line seven of sub-rule (1c) of rule 245, a sub-rule as follows—
 - - (1d) Under no circumstances must the departure signal cancel plunger be operated until permission has been obtained from the train controller.;
 - (c) by substituting for the diagram to rule 245 the following diagram-

(d) by substituting for rule 248, the following rule:-

248. (When a train is to be despatched from the loop, the departure signal will be at Stop. A releasing switch for this signal is provided in a locked box adjacent to the signal by which, provided the section is clear, the loop departure signal may be placed at Proceed.)

An indicator is provided in the releasing switch box which exhibits a White light when the departure signal can be placed at Proceed. When the White light is not illuminated it indicates—

- (a) that an opposing train is approaching; or
- (b) that a departing train travelling in the same direction is still occupying the first track section in advance of the departure signal; or
- (c) that a train approaching from the rear is sufficiently close to the crossing station to place the main line departure signal at Proceed.
- (1) Where the indicator in the releasing switch box is exhibiting a White light, the Fireman must push in the loop departure signal releasing switch (this action will place the signal at Proceed), after which the Driver must whistle to draw the Guard's attention but must not start the train until the Guard signals him to do so.

In the event of the indicator in the releasing switch box not exhibiting a White light when the train is ready to depart, the Fireman must immediately communicate with the Train Controller.

(2) If for any reason a train departing from the loop is stopped before the train is clear of the trailable points, the Guard must immediately set the points by hand for the loop and, under no circumstances, is a set back move to be permitted until the Driver is hand signalled by the Guard.

(Because of the provision of Facing Point Lock Spring Switch Machines (trailable points) attached to the loop facing points, trains departing from the loop are permitted to trail through points to main line without setting points for this move. When the last vehicle of the train has trailed through the points, they will automatically reset for the main line.); and

(e) by substituting for the words "Engine Load Table" in lines two and three of sub-rule (8) of rule 531, the words "Working Timetables Book".

Tanker-Driver Milk Grader's Certificate.

- $28A.\ \ \, (1)$ The certificate of competency for a tanker-driver milk grader shall be in Form 10 with the words "Tanker-Driver" endorsed on it.
- (2) Candidates for examination for a certificate of competency as a tanker-driver milk grader shall give satisfactory evidence of practical experience, and shall satisfy the examiner by means of a theoretical and practical examination as to their knowledge respectively of the following:-
 - (a) Elementary milk bacteriology—effect of bacteria on milk, sources of bacterial contamination.
 - (b) Common defects in milk-causes and remedies.
 - (c) Principles of senses grading, grades of milk, outline of other common milk quality tests.
 - (d) Milk sampling-
 - (i) Methods—drip, dip;
 - (ii) For chemical analysis;
 - (iii) For bacteriological analysis;
 - (iv) Care of samples.
 - (e) Measurement of milk in bulk milk tanks and tankers.
 - (f) Principles of cleaning and sterilising—
 - (i) Farm bulk milk tanks;
 - (ii) Milk tankers.
- (g) Relevant provisions of the Act and Regulations.

Reg. 36 3. The principal regulations are amended by substituting for substituted. regulation 36 and the heading thereto the following heading and regulation:

Grading of Milk for Manufacturing Purposes.

Milk supplied to a dairy produce factory for use in the manufacture of dairy produce shall be pure milk without addition or substraction, and shall be classified as follows:-

No. 1—First Grade.

No. 2-Second Grade.

First Grade Milk is milk free from serious taints, colostrum and foreign matter and which, when subjected to the Methylene Blue Reductase test in accordance with subregulation (3) of regulation 38 of these regulations, does not completely decolourise Methylene Blue in less than three hours.

Second Grade Milk is milk free from colostrum and foreign matter and which, when subjected to the Methylene Blue Reductase test in accordance with subregulation (3) of regulation 38 of these regulations, completely decolourises Methylene Blue in less than three hours.

Milk shall be rejected for use in the manufacture of dairy produce if it is affected by a serious physical change or a serious chemical, absorbed or biological taint, or if it contains more than 0.25 per cent. acidity calculated as lactic acid.

The grade assigned to any milk shall be that which is ascertained by the application of either the Senses Test or the Methylene Blue Test as employed in the grading of that milk. When both tests are used in conjunction, the grade to be assigned to the milk shall be the grade which, by the application of either of the tests, is ascertained to be the lower.

Reg. 38 amended.

44. The manager of a dairy produce factory shall ensure that every individual supply of milk received at the factory is sampled, weighed, tested and recorded. The samples of those

supplies may be mixed to form a composite sample and the testing of the composite sample shall be carried out at intervals of not more than eight days.

The principal regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 44 the following heading and regulation-

Bulk Collections of Milk

- 44A. (1) For the purpose of this regulation-
 - "milk tanker" means an approved insulated tank mounted upon a vehicle and fitted with approved appurtenances for receiving milk from a farm bulk milk tank;
 - "farm bulk milk tank" means a milk storage vat which Complies with respect to design and construction with Australian Standard N46-1963 or any subsequent amendment published by the Standards Association of Australia or otherwise has been verified and marked with a certifying stamp in pursuance of the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, 1915;
 - "parcel of milk" means any quantity of milk which is received into the milk tanker at one time.
- (2) The owner or manager of a dairy produce factory or a milk tanker or depot may receive milk into an approved milk tanker at a dairy farm and such milk shall be deemed for the purposes of these regulations to have been received at a dairy produce factory or depot and shall be weighed, graded, sampled, tested, recorded and paid for in accordance with the requirements of these regulations.
- (3) For the purpose of ascertaining and recording the weight of milk in each parcel every owner or manager of a dairy produce factory or depot or bulk milk tanker who receives milk into a bulk milk tanker shall, in pursuance of the Weights and Measures Act, 1915, carefully measure the amount of milk in the parcel while the milk is at complete rest and record the result in pounds in a record book.
- (4) Every owner or manager of a dairy produce factory or depot or of a milk tanker shall, prior to receiving any parcel of milk into a milk tanker, cause it to be graded by the senses test by a certificated grader who shall record the grade of milk in the record book.
- (5) Every owner or manager of a dairy produce factory or depot or a milk tanker shall, prior to sampling or receiving any parcel of milk into a milk tanker, cause that parcel to be thoroughly mixed in the farm bulk milk tank.
- (6) A representative sample of milk for Methylene Blue and butterfat estimation tests shall be taken by the certificated grader. The sample so taken shall be placed in a sterile, water tight container marked with the name or number of the supplier so as to ensure identification and the container shall be placed immediately in ice or other approved refrigerant and to be stored in the refrigerant and submitted at the factory for testing.
- (7) The certificated grader shall record the weight and grade of milk received into the milk tanker. He shall also sign the record at the end of each run.
- (8) The certificated grader shall sign and leave with the farmer a statement showing the following particulars-
 - (a) Date;
 - (b) Name of farmer;
 - (c) Weight in pounds of milk received;
 - (d) Temperature of the milk; and
 - (e) Grade of the milk as determined by the senses test.
- (9) No person shall mix or permit to be mixed in a milk tanker, or any other container, any parcel of milk considered by a certificated grader after examination by the senses test to be unsuitable for receival, with milk considered to be suitable for receival.
- (10) The owner or manager of a dairy produce factory or of a milk tanker shall cause the farm bulk milk tank to be rinsed free of milk residues immediately after removal of the parcel of milk.
- (11) Every person about to install a farm bulk milk tank for use in a dairy shall, before installing it, notify either the Chief of the Division of Dairying or an officer of the Dairying Division in the district.
- (12) No farm bulk milk tank shall be installed in a milk room unless the room is large enough to allow a minimum free space of two feet on all sides of the tank.
