THE following Licensing Court Rules, 1970, made under the provisions of the Liquor Act, 1970, are published for general information.

#### LIQUOR ACT, 1970.

WE, Jack Sydney Lewis, Chairman, and Alexander Robert Connell and Herbert Richard Robinson, Members, constituting the Licensing Court of Western Australia, established under the Liquor Act, 1970, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by that Act, hereby make the rules set out in the schedule hereunder.

### Schedule.

# LICENSING COURT RULES, 1970

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Licensing Court Rules, 1970. Citation.
- 2. In these rules unless the contrary intention appears— "nominee" means the person to be responsible, under the Act, as licensee;

Interpretation.

"the Act" means the Liquor Act, 1970.

- 3. (1) The several forms set out in the First Schedule to these Forms. rules are the forms prescribed for the respective purposes therein appearing.
- (2) Where a form is used under these rules the particulars and matters referred to in the form shall, in accordance with the directions, if any, on the front and reverse of the form, be completed to the extent that they apply in the case in which the form is used and shall be lodged in accordance with the Act and those directions.
- 4. In respect of any application for a permit that is, under subsection (1) of section 58, required to be made by informal notice in writing, the notice shall be in triplicate and two copies of it shall be lodged, with the prescribed fee, with the clerk of the Licensing Court nearest to the place where the permit is to operate and one copy shall be lodged with the senior member of the Police Force nearest that place.

Addresses of applicants.

- 5. An applicant for a provisional certificate, licence, permit, or transfer or removal of a licence shall, on the reverse of the form of notice prescribed by these rules or on the informal notice given under subsection (1) of section 58, as the case requires, state—
  - (a) the residential address of the applicant or the nominee and his telephone number, if any, at that address; and
  - (b) the registered office or business or employment address of the applicant and the telephone number, if any, of the applicant at that address.

Authorised officer.

6. An officer of a body corporate, a body or association such as is mentioned in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 50, or a club, acting on its authority in that behalf, shall sign any notice or form that is required by the Act, regulations made under the Act, or these rules but shall lodge with the notice or form an instrument in writing verifying the authority.

Endorsement of nominee on licence.

7. An approval of a nominee under subsection (2) of section 50 shall be endorsed on the licence.

Owners of licensed premises.

- 8. (1) A person who, on the 1st July, 1970, is the owner of premises for which a licence is in force or who, after that date, becomes such an owner shall notify the principal clerk and give to him—
  - (a) the full name and address of the owner; and
  - (b) the complete title description of the land on which the premises are situated.
- (2) The principal clerk shall, on receipt of the particulars referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) of subrule (1) of this rule, record them in the register of owners referred to in section 170.

Simultaneous applications.

9. All applications of which notice is required to be lodged in accordance with the Act and these rules and which may be heard at the one sitting of the Court are deemed to be simultaneous applications, irrespective of the time at which the notices were so lodged.

Conflicting applications.

10. The Court may, at the same time, hear evidence that is relevant to any two or more applications that are, under rule 9 deemed to be simultaneous and that are or may be conflicting.

Display and advertisement of notices of application.

- 11. Where the Act requires that a notice of application be displayed in any place or advertised in a newspaper the applicant—
  - (a) shall, where the application is for a provisional certificate, licence, or removal of a licence, include on the notice, as so displayed or adverised, the date on which the principal clerk received the notice; and
  - (b) shall, as soon as practicable after the notice is so advertised, lodge at the office of the principal clerk the whole page of the newspaper in which it was advertised.

Title documents. 12. An applicant for a provisional certificate, a licence, a removal of a licence, or an unlicensed club permit shall, at the time he lodges notice of the application as required by the Act and these rules, lodge at the office of the principal clerk a photostat copy of the certificate of title, or other document of title, relating to the land the subject of the application.

Plans and specifications. 13. (1) The plans and specifications set out in the second column of the Second Schedule to these rules opposite a type of application, or a purpose, set out in the first column of that Schedule are prescribed as those required for that type of application or that purpose and shall be lodged in duplicate at the place and time set out in the third column of that Schedule opposite the plans and specifications.

- (2) All the plans and specifications referred to in subrule (1) of this rule shall, subject to any order or direction of the Court relating thereto, be prepared in ink on good, durable paper measuring not less than fifteen inches in length and twelve inches in width and shall show clearly the number and size and proposed use of all rooms and outbuildings, the type of construction, and the boundaries of the premises to which the plan relates.
- 14. A notice of application for a permit to sell and supply liquor on unlicensed premises shall specify the area of the premises and the facilities thereon for serving the liquor, general hygiene, and toilet purposes.

Facilities in unlicensed premises subject to a permit.

15. An applicant for the transfer or removal of a licence shall lodge with his notice of application—

Transfer or removal of licences.

- (a) the licence;
- (b) any current permits of a continuing nature held by the licensee; and
- (c) any current notice of grading, under section 107, relating to the premises.
- 16. An application for an entertainment permit—

Entertainment permit.

- (a) shall specify-
  - (i) the name and address of the licensed premises;
  - (ii) the type of licence held;
  - (iii) the day or days for which the permit is required; and
  - (iv) the part of the premises in which the entertainment is to be held under the permit; and
- (b) shall be lodged, not less than fourteen days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.
- 17. An application for an occasional permit-

Occasional permit.

- (a) shall specify—
  - (i) the name and address of the licensed premises;
  - (ii) the type of licence held;
  - (iii) a description of the special occasion;
  - (iv) the number and class of persons who are to attend the special occasion:
  - (v) the date and the hours for which the permit is required; and  $% \left( \frac{1}{2}\right) =\frac{1}{2}\left( \frac{1}{2}\right) +\frac{1}{2}\left( \frac{1}{2}\right) +\frac{1}{2}\left($
  - (vi) the part of the licensed premises in which liquor is to be sold and supplied under the permit; and
- (b) shall be lodged, not less than two days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act. required to be lodged.
- 18. An application for a caterer's permit—

Caterer's

- (a) shall specify-
  - (i) the name and address of the licensed premises;
  - (ii) the type of licence held;
  - (iii) the day or days and the period or periods for which the permit is required;
  - (iv) the premises in which liquor is to be sold and supplied under the permit; and

(b) shall be lodged, not less than seven days before the permit is required, with all person with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.

# Lodger's permit.

- 19. An application for a lodger's permit-
  - (a) shall specify-
    - (i) the name and address of the licensed premises; and
    - (ii) the details of accommodation provided for the travelling public on the licensed premises; and
  - (b) shall be lodged, not less than thirty days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.

# Late delivery permit.

- 20. An application for a late delivery permit-
  - (a) shall specify the name and address of the licensed premises and details of the nature of the business conducted thereon requiring the making of late deliveries of liquor sold there; and
  - (b) shall be lodged, not less than seven days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.

# Reception area permit.

- 21. An application for a reception area permit-
  - (a) shall specify the name and address of the licensed premises, the type of licence held, and the part of the premises in which liquor is to be sold and supplied; and
  - (b) shall be lodged, not less than thirty days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.

# Unlicensed club permit.

- 22. An application for an unlicensed club permit-
  - (a) shall specify-
    - (i) the name and address of the club;
      - (ii) the date the club was formed;
      - (iii) three printed copies of the rules of the club;
      - (iv) a list of the names and addresses of the members of the club as at the date of the lodging of the application;
      - (v) the history of its operations and management for a period of at least two years prior to the making of the application;
      - (vi) an estimate of the number of persons expected to be in attendance at the club between such hours, and on such days, for which the permit is required; and
    - (vii) the name and address of the licensed premises where it is intended to purchase the liquor for sale and supply by the club under the permit; and
  - (b) shall be lodged, not less than thirty days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.

# Function permit.

- 23. An application for a function permit-
  - (a) shall specify—
    - (i) the hours and days for which the permit is required;
    - (ii) the type of function;

- (iii) the number and type of persons expected to attend the function; and
- (iv) the name and address of the premises where liquor is to be sold and supplied under the permit; and
- (v) the name and address of the licensed premises where it is intended to purchase the liquor for sale and supply under the permit; and
- (b) shall be lodged, not less than seven days before the permit is required, with all persons with whom it is, under the Act, required to be lodged.
- 24. (1) A person may at any time during the hours when the Searches office of the principal clerk is open for business, on payment of of records. the fee prescribed in the regulations made under the Act, inspect at such office any registers, records of evidence taken by the Court at any hearing and applications to and orders made by the Court, in the keeping of the principal clerk, and may make copies thereof or take extracts therefrom.

- (2) The principal clerk shall upon request by a person either in person or by letter, on payment of the fee prescribed in the regulations made under the Act, issue or forward by post to that person a copy of or extract from any register, record, application or order referred to in subrule (1) of this rule and in his keeping, certified under his hand and the seal of the Court to be a true copy or extract.
- (3) Notwithstanding subrules (1) and (2) of this rule, a person shall not be permitted to inspect, or to make or receive, a copy of or extract from any record, declaration, return, entry or document that discloses particulars of liquor purchased or the percentage fees assessed thereon in respect of any licensed premises, except where that person is a member or officer of the Court, the owner or licensee of the licensed premises, or a person duly authorised in writing in that behalf by that owner or licensee.
