WHEREAS the enactment contained in section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1889, whereby the appointment of all public officers under the Government of the State is vested in the Governor in Council, does not apply to minor appointments which by Act of Legislature or by Order in Council may be vested in the heads of Departments or other officers or persons within the State; and whereas it is desirable that the appointment of persons as employees of the Forests Department and its branches at a daily or weekly rate of wages should be vested in John William Humphreys or any person appointed to temporarily act in place of such officer: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice of the Executive Council hereby vests in John William Humphreys and any person appointed to temporarily act in place of such officer the appointment of persons as employees of the Forests Department and its branches at a daily or weekly rate of wages.

Corres. 3057/67.—That Reserve No. 30413 should vest in and be held by the Snire of Gosnells in trust for the purpose of Public Recreation.

Corres. 6417/07.—That Reserve No. 30414 should vest in and be held by the Commissioner of Main Roads in trust for the purpose of Gravel.

Corres. 212/70.—That Reserve No. 30417 should vest in and be held by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Board in trust for the purpose of Pipeline M.W.S.S. and D. Board).

Corres. 4266/69.—That Reserve No. 30418 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Perth in trust for the purpose of Children's Playground.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

Local Government Act, 1960-1970.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act, 1960-1970, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request by a Council of a Municipal District, by Order published in the Government Gazette to declare any lands reserved or acquired for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control, and management of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street of which the public has had uninterrupted use for a period of not less than ten years, as a public street and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriageway and footpaths of the public street; and whereas the Councils mentioned in the schedule hereto have requested that certain lands named and described in the said schedule, which have been reserved for streets within the said Councils, be declared public streets: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be public streets, and such land shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as streets within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.


