IT is hereby notified that the Minister administering the Bush Fires Act, 1954, has approved, pursuant to the powers contained in section 25B of the said Act, of the suspension of the operation of the provisions of section 25 of the said Act, that relate to a fire to be lit, or which is lit, for the purpose of destroying garden refuse or rubbish or for any like purpose during the period from 30th December, 1971 to the 31st May, 1972, both dates inclusive, on land set aside for the Kojonup Council's rubbish dump situated on reserves 1006 and 24160 subject to the following conditions:—

- (1) That the firebreaks surrounding the dump site be cleared of all inflammable material for a distance of 20 ft. from the external boundaries of the actual dump.
- (2) That all burning be carried out at least 20 feet from the perimeter fence and that all rubbish being burnt at any one time is to be burnt in a single heap.
- (3) That burning be carried out only between the hours of 1 p.m. and 3.30 p.m., Mondays to Thursdays inclusive.
- (4) That one Council Employee, with fire truck, be in attendance when burning is carried out.
- (5) That a firebreak not less than 20 ft. in width be constructed running north to south, so as to divide the area in actual use from the area not now generally used.
- (6) That the access gateway be reduced to an opening not more than 10 ft. in width so as to reduce the opening through which rubbish may escape.
- (7) That all fires lit on the dump under the conditions stated, be checked for security at 5 p.m. on each day on which a fire was lit.
- (8) That no fire be lit on a day declared by the Bureau of Meteorology in Perth to be dangerous for the area where the burning is to take place.
- (9) That warning signs at present erected at the rubbish dump site be maintained in position during the whole period of this suspension.

### AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS ACT, 1929-1968.

- I THE undersigned Minister for Agriculture being the Minister charged with the administration of the Agricultural Products Act, 1929-1968, acting in exercise of the power on this behalf conferred upon me by section 3D of the said Act and on recommendation of the Citrus Sales Advisory Committee constituted under the Act, do hereby amend the prohibition concerning the sale of citrus fruit published by notice in the Government Gazette on Friday July 2, 1971, and in The West Australian newspaper on Saturday, July 3, 1971 under the provisions of aforesaid section 3D of the Act by-
  - (a) deleting from the schedule the figures 21/8 in all columns opposite the word lemons;
  - (b) substituting therefore the figure 2 in all columns opposite the word lemons.

A person shall not sell except for the purpose of export from the State, any kinds of citrus fruit of which the sale is pursuant to section 3D of the Act prohibited and any person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Penalty: One hundred dollars.

performance in respect of such reserves is satisfactory to take advantage of the benefits of the new legislation.

8. All applications should reach the Under Secretary for Mines, 66 Adelaide Terrace, Perth, by 18th February, 1972, and should incorporate full details of proposed exploration programmes, including expenditure, and of the relationship of those programmes to present mining operations, where appropriate.
