CADETS (FULL-TIME TRAINING) DETERMINATION 1972

THE Public Service Board, pursuant to the power conferred on it under Section 30A of the Public Service Act, 1904–1970, hereby determines that the terms and conditions of employment and service of persons appointed to the cadetships to which this determination applies shall be as specified in this determination.

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as the Cadets (Full-time Training) Determination, 1972.

Commencement

2. This determination shall come into operation on the day of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Interpretation

- 3. In this determination the following expressions shall, unless the contrary intention appears, have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, namely—
 - "the Act" means the Public Service Act, 1904, and includes any amendment thereto;
 - "the Board" means the Public Service Board constituted under the Act;
 - "satisfactory progress" in relation to a course of study and training means diligently pursuing to completion the course of study and training and passing the examinations for a subject, subjects or combination of subjects at a rate and in a manner that satisfies the Board;
 - "the Department" means the Department to which a person who is appointed to a cadetship is allocated.
 - "the Schedule" means the Schedule to this determination.

Application

4. This determination applies to the classes of cadetships set out in column 1 of the Schedule.

Application of Public Service Act, 1904

5. During the whole of the term of the cadetship and during any suspension or extension thereof a person appointed to a cadetship pursuant to this determination is subject to the provisions of the Act, and the regulations made thereunder to the extent to which those provisions are capable of being applied with or without adaptation, but a person appointed pursuant to the provisions of this determination is not an officer for the purposes of the Act and the regulations.

Eligibility for Appointment

- 6. (1) Subject to this paragraph, a person is eligible for appointment to a cadetship specified in column 1 of the Schedule if he—
 - (a) complies with eligibility requirements specified in column 2 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship; or
 - (b) has made satisfactory progress in the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship.
- (2) In addition to fulfilling the requirements set out in subparagraph (1) of this paragraph a person shall only be eligible for appointment to a cadetship if he—
 - (a) is not more than 21 years of age nor less than 16 years of age at his next birthday immediately following his application unless the Board in the exercise of its discretion under paragraph 7 of this determination determines otherwise;
 - (b) passes the medical test as prescribed under the Act and Regulations;
 - (c) produces to the Board satisfactory evidence as to his character; and
 - (d) passes any aptitude test required by the Board.
- (3) An applicant shall not be deemed to have fulfilled any of the requirements set out in this paragraph unless he produces proof of the fact to the satisfaction of the Board.

Age Limits

7. The Board may at its discretion vary the age limits in respect of any cadetship.

Order of Appointment

- 8. (1) Selection committees appointed by the Board shall consider and report to the Board upon applicants for appointment to cadetships.
- (2) The selection committees shall have regard to the applicant's academic record and such other matters as are considered relevant in determining his suitability for the course of study and training specified in respect of the class of cadetship.
- (3) Appointment of an applicant to a cadetship shall be made by the Board and shall be contingent on the applicant satisfying University, Institute of Technology or Technical Education Division requirements for admission to the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule for the class of cadetship for which he has applied.

Course of Study and Training

- 9. (1) The course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule is the specified course of study and training to be undertaken in respect of the class of cadetship in column 1 of the Schedule.
- (2) A cadet shall undertake full-time University, Institute of Technology, or Technical Education courses or Departmental training according to the requirements of the Schedule and if so required a cadet shall work in the Department or other approved establishment during academic vacations and for such additional period required to complete the course of training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship.

Fees

10. Unless the cadet has been suspended by the Board, a cadet shall be entitled to have all compulsory tuition fees paid on his behalf for those subjects which are comprised in the course of study and training as specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship but this entitlement does not extend to subjects which are taken as a repetition of, addition to or substitution for any part of the course of study and training.

Leave

11. A cadet shall not be entitled to any leave entitlements applicable to officers under the Act except an annual leave entitlement at the times approved by the Board.

Term of Cadetship

- 12. (1) Subject to this paragraph, the term of a cadetship shall be as specified in column 5 of the Schedule as being the maximum period of training in respect of that class of cadetship.
- (2) On his appointment to a cadetship a cadet shall be appointed to that year of the term of the cadetship that the Board deems appropriate, having regard to the conditions as to eligibility that the cadet has attained at the time of his application for the cadetship.
- (3) The Permanent Head of every Department shall cause to be submitted to the Board after each examination or whenever the Board so requests a report on each cadet in that Department stating—
 - (a) the examination results obtained by the cadet at any examination attended by him in that year; and
 - (b) his opinion as to the cadet's conduct, diligence and efficiency and his fitness to continue the cadetship.
- (4) If the Board is of the opinion that a cadet has made satisfactory progress and is satisfied as to his conduct, diligence and efficiency in that year and his fitness to continue the cadetship it may allow the cadet to progress from that year of his cadetship to the next succeeding year of the cadetship and the provisions of paragraph 14 relating to any increase in salary will apply to the cadet.
- (5) If the Board is of the opinion that a cadet has failed to make satisfactory progress or is not satisfied as to his conduct, diligence or efficiency or his fitness to continue the cadetship it may suspend the cadet, extend the term of the cadetship or terminate the cadetship agreement or may require the cadet to enter into a new cadetship agreement.
- (6) If the Board suspends the cadet the cadet shall not so long as the suspension remains in force be entitled to any entitlements under this determination unless the Board otherwise directs.
- (7) Where a cadet has been suspended by the Board pursuant to this paragraph the cadet shall remain subject to the provisions of this determination and may be required to complete that portion of the course of study and training that has not been completed on such terms and in such a manner as the Board requires and upon fulfilling those requirements to the satisfaction of the Board the cadet may on the direction of the Board be allowed to progress to the next succeeding year of the cadetship.
- (8) If at the end of the term of the cadetship a cadet has not, in the opinion of the Board, completed the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship the Board may—
 - (a) extend the term of the cadetship for a further period not exceeding two years;
 - (b) require the cadet to enter into a new cadetship agreement; or
 - (c) terminate the cadetship agreement.
- (9) If the Board as the case may be, suspends the cadet, extends the term of the cadetship or terminates a cadetship agreement it shall cause written notification of its decision to be given to the cadet and his parent, guardian or other surety under the cadetship agreement and the notification shall take effect from the date thereof according to its tenor and the provisions of this determination but the suspension or extension shall not relieve or suspend the cadet, parent, guardian or other surety under the cadetship agreement from liability thereunder.

(10) If the Board requires a cadet to enter into a new cadetship agreement pursuant to this paragraph it shall cause written notification of its decision to be given to the cadet and his parent, guardian or other surety under the then existing cadetship agreement and if those parties to the then existing cadetship agreement or any one or more of them refuse to enter into a new cadetship agreement as requested, the Board may, at its option, terminate the cadetship agreement.

Completion of Training

- 13. (1) A cadet of the class designated in column 1 of the Schedule shall be deemed to have completed his cadetship when he has completed and passed to the satisfaction of the Board the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship.
- (2) Where a cadet has completed his cadetship he is eligible, at the discretion of the Board, to be offered an appointment to the office specified in column 7 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship.

Salary and Allowances

- 14. (1) Subject to this paragraph, the salary payable to cadets other than during the academic year shall be in accordance with Scale 1 in Schedule A to the Public Service (General Division Officers) Salaries Agreement No. 84 of 1971 and amendments thereto or any new agreement made in addition to or substitution for thereof and a reference in this determination to "the scale" shall be read as a reference to that scale.
 - (2) The salary of a cadet shall commence—
 - (a) at item 5 of the scale if the cadet commences the cadetship having obtained the Leaving Certificate, Matriculation or equivalent qualification; or
 - (b) at any other item in the scale deemed appropriate by the Board if the cadet commences the cadetship having already made satisfactory progress towards the completion of the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship;

and shall increase thereafter in accordance with the scale for each subsequent year of the cadetship if the Board is of the opinion that the cadet has made satisfactory progress in the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship.

- (3) Where eligibility for appointment to a cadetship as specified in column 2 of the Schedule requires the completion of a graduate or equivalent course of study the Board may fix the appropriate points in the scale for a cadet's salary range at its discretion.
- (4) A cadet who has attained the age of 21 years shall be paid not less than the minimum wage determined from time to time by the Commonwealth Conciliation and Arbitration Commission irrespective of the stage of course and training being undertaken by him.
- (5) A female cadet who has not attained the age of 21 years shall be entitled to a salary which is equivalent to $87\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the salary mentioned in sub-paragraph (2) of this paragraph.
- (6) During the academic year a cadet shall not be paid a salary but shall be entitled to receive a sustenance allowance amounting to 30 per cent of the rate payable under subparagraph (2) of this paragraph but this entitlement shall cease if the Board suspends the cadet pursuant to paragraph 12 of this determination and directs that sustenance payments shall be suspended.
- (7) If a cadet is employed away from his Departmental headquarters, the Board may approve of the payment of an allowance for any extra costs of living involved or for transport expenses necessarily incurred.
- (8) Where the Board considers that in order to undertake the course of study and training, a cadet whose ordinary place of residence is outside a radius of 25 miles from the Perth G.P.O. is required to live away from his ordinary place of residence, the Board may at its discretion approve of the payment to the cadet of an allowance in addition to the sustenance allowance under subparagraph (6) of this paragraph;
- (9) The Board may at its discretion approve of the payment to the cadet of any further allowances to enable the cadet to undertake the course of study and training.

Cadetship Agreement

15. (1) An applicant who is granted an appointment to a cadetship and his parent, guardian or other surety approved by the Board shall, before the applicant commences his cadetship enter into an agreement with the Board in a form approved by the Board.

Required Service

- (2) Subject to this paragraph, a person who has served a cadetship for the term specified in paragraph 12 of this determination and has accepted an offer of appointment to an office specified in column 7 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship shall remain in the Department of the State Public Service to which he is appointed for the maximum period specified in column 6 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship.
- (3) The period of required service under subparagraph (2) of this paragraph of a person who has had the term of his cadetship reduced under subparagraph 12 (2) of this determination and who completes the remainder of the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship without an extension of his cadetship agreement shall be ascertained in accordance with the following equation:—

(where-

- a = term of the cadetship as reduced under sub-paragraph 12 (2) of this determination.
- b = maximum term of study and training as given in column 5 of the Schedule.
- c = maximum period of required service as given in column 6 of the Schedule.
- d = period of service required to be served)

but in no case shall the period of required service amount to less than two years.

(4) Where the Board extends the term of the cadetship pursuant to paragraph 12 of this determination the period of the extension may at the discretion of the Board, be added to the period of required service specified in subparagraph (2) or (3) of this paragraph.

Sum Payable for Breach of Cadetship Agreement

- 16. (1) Subject to subparagraph (2) of this paragraph, the sum of money to be reimbursed to the Board by a person in the event of the termination of the cadetship agreement by the Board shall be a sum of money equivalent to the sum of—
 - (a) all sustenance payments received by him; and
 - (b) all fees and education allowances paid on his behalf.
- (2) If a person has served in a cadetship and has thereafter accepted and has been employed in an office pursuant to paragraph 15 of this determination the amount to be reimbursed to the Board shall be reduced in the following manner:—
 - (a) the sum of money referred to in subparagraph (1) of this paragraph shall be divided by the number of weeks of required service specified in subparagraph 15 (2) or 15
 (3) of this determination;
 - (b) the sum shown as the resultant quotient shall be multiplied by the number of weeks the person has served pursuant to subparagraph 15 (2) of this determination to give a product;
 - (c) the product of the calculation in subparagraph (b) of this subparagraph shall be deducted from the total under subparagraph (1) of this paragraph and the amount of the balance shall be the amount for which the person is liable; and
 - (d) for the purposes of this subparagraph a fraction of a week shall be treated as one week.

Evidentiary Provisions

17. A certificate or notice signed by or on behalf of the Board as to the opinion or decision of the Board on any matter on which the Board may give an opinion or which the Board may determine or approve under this determination or as to whether anything has or has not been done to the satisfaction of the Board or has or has not been approved by the Board shall be conclusive evidence of the matter stated in the certificate or notice.

Service of Notice

18. Any notice, certificate, approval, consent, requirement, demand or other communication to be given by the Board shall be deemed to have been duly given if given in writing signed by or on behalf of the Board or the Permanent Head of the Department to which the cadet is appointed and handed to the person to whom the notice, certificate, approval, consent, requirement, demand or other communication is addressed or posted to his usual or last known place of address.

Student Affiliation

19. Where the course of study and training the cadet is pursuing so requires, the cadet shall obtain student membership with the appropriate professional body.

Application

4. This determination applies to the classes of cadetships set out in column 1 of the Schedule.

- 9. (1) The course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule is the specified course of study and training to be undertaken in respect of the class of cadetship in column 1 of the Schedule.
- (2) A cadet shall undertake part-time Institute of Technology or Technical Education Division courses or Departmental training according to the requirements of the Department in order to complete the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship.

Fees

10. Unless the cadet has been suspended by the Board, a cadet shall be entitled to have all compulsory tuition fees paid on his behalf for those subjects which are comprised in the course of study and training as specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship but this entitlement does not extend to subjects which are taken as a repetition of, addition to or substitution for any part of the course of study and training.

Leave

11. A cadet shall have the same leave entitlements as prescribed under the Act for permanent officers of the State Public Service.

Term of Cadetship

- 12. (1) Subject to this paragraph, the term of a cadetship shall be as specified in column 5 of the Schedule as being the maximum period of training in respect of that class of cadetship.
- (2) On his appointment to a cadetship a cadet shall be appointed to that year of the term of the cadetship that is, in the opinion of the Board, appropriate having regard to the conditions as to eligibility that the cadet has attained at the time of the application for the cadetship.
- (3) The Permanent Head of every Department shall cause to be submitted to the Board after each examination or whenever the Board so requests a report on each cadet in that Department stating—
 - (a) the examination results obtained by the cadet at any examination attended by him in that year; and
 - (b) his opinion as to the cadet's conduct, diligence and efficiency and his fitness to continue the cadetship.
- (4) If the Board is of the opinion that a cadet has made satisfactory progress and is satisfied as to his conduct, diligence and efficiency in that year and his fitness to continue the cadetship it may allow the cadet to progress from that year of his cadetship to the next succeeding year of the cadetship and the provisions of paragraph 14 relating to any increase in salary will apply to the cadet.
- (5) If the Board is of the opinion that a cadet has failed to make satisfactory progress or is not satisfied as to his conduct, diligence or efficiency or his fitness to continue the cadetship it may suspend the cadet, extend the term of the cadetship or terminate the cadetship agreement or may require the cadet to enter into a new agreement.
- (6) If the Board suspends the cadet the cadet shall not so long as the suspension remains in force be entitled to any entitlements under this determination unless the Board otherwise directs.
- (7) Where a cadet has been suspended by the Board pursuant to this paragraph the cadet shall remain subject to the provisions of this determination and may be required to complete that portion of the course of study and training that has not been completed on such terms and in such a manner as the Board requires and upon fulfilling those requirements to the satisfaction of the Board the cadet may on the direction of the Board be allowed to proceed to the next succeeding year of the cadetship.
- (8) If at the end of the term of the cadetship a cadet has not, in the opinion of the Board, completed the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of this class of cadetship the Board may—
 - (a) extend the term of the cadetship for a further period not exceeding two years;
 - (b) require the cadet to enter into a new cadetship agreement; or
 - (c) terminate the cadetship agreement.
- (9) If the Board as the case may be suspends the cadet, extends the term of the cadetship or terminates the cadetship agreement it shall cause written notification of its decision to be given to the cadet and his parent, guardian or other surety under the cadetship agreement and the notification shall take effect from the date thereof according to its tenor and the provisions of this determination but the suspension or extension shall not relieve or suspend the cadet, parent, guardian or other surety under the cadetship agreement from liability thereunder.
- (10) If the Board requires a cadet to enter into a new cadetship agreement pursuant to this paragraph it shall cause written notification of its decision to be given to the cadet and his parent, guardian or other surety under the then existing cadetship agreement and if those parties to the then existing cadetship agreement or any one or more of them refuse to enter into a new cadetship agreement as requested, the Board may, at its option, terminate the cade ship agreement.

Completion of Training

- 13. (1) A cadet of the class designated in column 1 of the Schedule shall be deemed to have completed his cadetship when he has completed and passed to the satisfaction of the Board the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship and has passed the Departmental examination, if any, specified in that column.
- (2) Where a cadet has completed his cadetship he is eligible, at the discretion of the Board, to be offered an appointment to the office specified in column 7 of the Schedule in respect of that class of cadetship.

Salary and Allowances

- 14. (1) Subject to this paragraph, the salary payable to cadets shall be in accordance with Scale 1 in Schedule A to the Public Service (General Division Officers) Salaries Agreement, No. 84 of 1971 and amendments thereto or any new agreement made in substitution thereof and a reference in this determination to "the scale" shall be read as a reference to that scale.
 - (2) The salary of a cadet shall commence—
 - (a) at item 4 of the scale if the cadet commences the cadetship having obtained the Junior Certificate or equivalent qualification;
 - (b) at item 5 of the scale if the cadet commences the cadetship having passed sufficient Leaving Certificate, Matriculation or equivalent qualification subjects deemed appropriate by the Board;
 - (c) at any other item of the scale deemed appropriate by the Board if the cadet commences the cadetship having already made satisfactory progress towards the completion of the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship,

and shall increase thereafter in accordance with that scale for each subsequent year of the cadetship if the Board is of the opinion that the cadet has made satisfactory progress in the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship.

- (3) (a) A female cadet who has attained the age of 21 years shall be entitled to the same salary mentioned in subparagraph (2) of this paragraph;
 - (b) A female cadet who has not attained the age of 21 years shall be entitled to a salary which is equivalent to $87\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the salary mentioned in subparagraph 2 of this paragraph.

Cadetship Agreement

15. (1) An applicant who is granted an appointment to a cadetship and his parent, guardian or other surety approved by the Board shall, before the applicant commences his cadetship, enter into an agreement with the Board in a form approved by the Board.

Required Service

- (2) Subject to this paragraph, a person who has served a cadetship for the term specified in paragraph 12 of this determination and has accepted an offer of an appointment to an office specified in column 7 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship shall remain in the Department of the State Public Service to which he is appointed for the maximum period specified in column 6 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship.
- (3) The period of required service under subparagraph (2) of this paragraph of a person who has had the term of his cadetship reduced under subparagraph 12 (2) of this determination and who completes the remainder of the course of study and training specified in column 3 of the Schedule in respect of his class of cadetship without an extension of his cadetship agreement shall be ascertained in accordance with the following equation—

$$\frac{\mathbf{a}}{-\mathbf{x}} \mathbf{c} = \mathbf{d}$$

(Where—

- a = term of the cadetship as reduced under subparagraph 12 (2) of this determination
- b = maximum term of study and training as given in column 5 of the Schedule
- c = maximum period of required service as given in column 6 of the Schedule
- d = period of service required to be served)

but in no case shall the period of required service amount to less than two years.

(4) Where the Board extends the term of the cadetship pursuant to paragraph 12 of this determination the period of the extension may at the discretion of the Board, be added to the maximum period of required service specified in subparagraph (2) of this paragraph.

Sum Payable for Breach of Cadetship Agreement

16. (1) Subject to subparagraph (2) of this paragraph the sum of money to be reimbursed to the Board by a person in the event of the termination of the cadetship agreement by the Board shall be a sum of money equivalent to the sum of \$500 and all fees and education allowances paid on his behalf.

- (2) If a person has served in a cadetship and has thereafter accepted and has been employed in an office pursuant to paragraph 15 of this determination the amount to be reimbursed to the Board shall be reduced in the following manner:—
 - (a) the sum of money referred to in subparagraph (1) shall be divided by the number of weeks of required service specified in subparagraph 15(2) or 15(3) of this determination:
 - (b) the sum shown as the resultant quotient shall be multiplied by the number of weeks the person has served pursuant to subparagraph 15(2) or 15(3) of this determination; and
 - (c) the product of the calculation in subparagraph (b) of this subparagraph shall be deducted from the total under subparagraph (1) of this paragraph and the amount of the balance shall be the amount for which the person is liable, and
 - (d) for the purpose of this subparagraph a fraction of a week shall be treated as one week.

Evidentiary Provisions

17. A certificate or notice signed by or on behalf of the Board as to the opinion or decision of the Board on any matter on which the Board may give an opinion or which the Board may determine or approve under this determination or as to whether anything has or has not been done to the satisfaction of the Board or has or has not been approved by the Board shall be conclusive evidence of the matter stated in the certificate or notice.

Service of Notices

18. Any notice, certificate, approval, consent, requirement, demand or other communication to be given by the Board shall be deemed to have been duly given if given in writing signed by or on behalf of the Board or the Permanent Head of the Department to which the cadet is appointed and handed to the person to whom the notice, certificate, approval, consent, requirement, demand or other communication is addressed or posted to his usual or last known place of address.

Student Affiliation

19. Where the course of study and training the cadet is pursuing so requires, the cadet shall obtain student membership with the appropriate professional body.

 - (i) the Cadet is by reason of misconduct idleness disobedience non attendance irregular or unpunctual attendance want of interest in work or immoral conduct unfit to retain his appointment as a Cadet;
 - (ii) the interests of the Public Service so require.
- 4.—IF this Agreement is terminated either by the Board as hereinbefore provided or by the Cadet then and in any such event and without the necessity for any demand the Cadet and the Surety shall be jointly and severally liable of pay and shall forthwith pay to the Board by way of reimbursement the sum of money caluclated in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 16 of the determination.
- 5.—Liability of the Cadet and Surety under clause 4 of this Agreement shall not be affected or limited by reason of :
 - (a) the suspension of the Cadet by the Board pursuant to the determination;
 - (b) the granting by the Board to the Cadet of an extension of time for completion of the course of study and training referred to in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of clause 2 hereof;
